Now that same-sex marriage has been made legal in Northern Ireland, Secretary of State Julian Smith has reassured religious groups that their freedom of speech will be protected.

Smith promised legislation for free speech after the Christian Institute threatened legal action if religious liberties were not upheld.

They will be able to sack rule-breakers

According to Premier News, he said that mere criticism will not be regarded as an offence, religious groups will not be sued for refusing to support same-sex weddings and faith-based organisations will be able to sack staff who break their rules by marrying gay partners.

The Christian Institute welcomed the assurances, set out in proposals published by the British government for consultation in January, but said it would be watching to see that faith leaders are not taken to court for refusing to officiate at same-sex weddings.

FAMILY SUES OVER DEAD DAUGHTER

The churchgoing family of London teenager Nora Quoirin, who was found dead after she disappeared from a Malaysian resort last year, is suing the hotel's own-

er for alleged negligence. Quoirin, 15, who had special needs, went missing from the room she shared with her siblings at night in August 2019.

High Court to decide if kids should be given trans drugs

A former transgender patient has mounted an unprecedented legal challenge against the Tavistock Clinic, which helps teens change their gender medically.

The landmark test case at the High Court against the Tavistock and Portman NHS Trust's Gender Identity Development Service (GIDS), will decide whether children are able to give informed consent to treatment for gender reassignment.

Children are being rushed into life-altering decisions

The case was originally brought on behalf of Susan Evans, a former psychiatric nurse at the clinic, and 'Mrs A', the mother of an autistic 15-year-old girl who is on the GIDS waiting list. Ms Evans says that puberty blockers for under-18s should be illegal and that children are being rushed into life-altering decisions.

Now Keira Bell, who underwent treatment at the clinic, has taken Ms Evans' place as the lead claimant. She said, "I do not believe that children and young people can consent to the use of powerful and experimental hormone drugs like I did."

LONDON OUTREACH SEES HUNDREDS TURN TO CHRIST

Rev Alex Afriyie, London Baptist Association Moderator and leader of The Turning in London

in ten boroughs "saw 1,144 people make responses to the Gospel" in one week. There were also instances of "instant relief of symptoms after prayers of healing".

The Christians involved came from a wide range of denominations including Baptist, Anglican, Methodist, Pentecostal, Catholic, New Church and Brethren churches.

Rev Afriyie commented: "I realised that we have not believed that the Gospel alone is truly powerful enough to bring salvation to all who believe... and the simple sharing of it will generate faith in people to make a response."

He added: "I saw that when churches unify in an area for the work of evangelism there is truly an anointing of eternal life."

'The Turning', a simple evangelistic initiative, has been reaping a harvest in London.

Rev Alex Afriyie of the London Turning Team reports that after just "one hour of evangelism over 100 people responded to the Gospel in prayer".

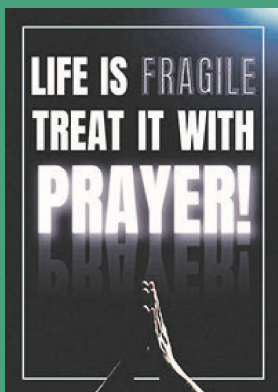

THE POWER OF A PRAYING WIFE

PASTOR 'RESURRECTED' AFTER PRAYER

A week after HEART Partner pastor Chris Wickland warned his church's leaders about key Christians being "taken out", he suffered a cardiac arrest. His wife Tracey told HEART about his miraculous recovery

"Sitting beside my husband's bruised and swollen body, the situation looked bleak. Chris was in an induced coma following a sudden cardiac arrest (SCA).

His heart had stopped beating for 15 minutes. The doctor told me that since he was fit and only 47, he probably wouldn't die, but would probably suffer brain damage because less than 10 per cent of SCA patients return to normal.

Picking up a Gideons' Bible, it opened at Hebrews 11:1: "Faith is confidence in what we hope for and assurance about what we do not see."

On 29 November, Chris had taken three of our five children to a local theme park. Finding it closed, they headed instead to Flip Out trampolining centre in Eastleigh. But Chris felt sick and dizzy and sat on the side, breathing heavily. Our 11 year old, Serenity, saw him walk into the locker room, lie down on a bench and be sick.

Friends prayed over him during the night

I believe God put Chris in the right place at the right time that day, because he had instant access to CPR and a defibrillator! When the Flip Out staff phoned me, I asked them to tell the children to pray for Chris immediately.

It took four shocks with the defibrillator before his heart start-

ed beating and he was rushed to the heart hospital of the south, Southampton General.

The ambulance driver said he had never seen anyone come back after a fourth shock during 24 years on the job. Over 90 per cent of SCAs result in death, as no-one is around to do CPR.

As soon as I got to Chris's bedside, I prayed and read Scripture over him. I decided I wasn't going to be a grieving widow; I was going to stand on the Word of God and believe God was going to heal him. When I needed sleep, friends sat and prayed over him during the night.

Even people Chris had offended prayed fervently for him!

Thanks to social media, Christians from churches across the world were praying for Chris, day and night. Even people Chris had offended over the years put aside differences and prayed fervently

for him! The NHS staff in intensive care were also amazing.

Two days later, on Sunday morning, they began to lift the sedation as churches around the country continued to pray.

As he started to move, I read aloud Psalm 91, the hymn 'Rise up O men of God' and Romans 8:11, "He who raised Christ from the dead will... give life to your mortal bodies through his Spirit who dwells in you."

I rang our church to tell them he'd woken up, prompting tears of joy and relief from the congregation. In fact, Chris looked truly awful, his eyes rolling as he writhed on the bed, but several hours later they could remove the breathing tube and he started to speak.

Less than three weeks later,

Chris was discharged in time for Christmas with a clear and sound mind. Doctors could not believe that he had been

dead for so long with no permanent damage. I'm absolutely convinced Chris is alive and well because the Church got on her knees and God heard her and 'moved the mountain'.

If Chris had died, then God would still be good and faithful, but he chose to return him to us and I'm beyond thankful.

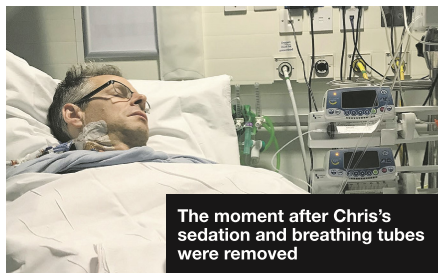
Chris says: "The week before it happened, I had told our church leaders, 'All around the world, it seems like the devil is taking out key leaders,' because I think the Church is on the cusp of something brilliant. The UK Church has experienced spiritual barrenness, but I'm starting to see radical answers to prayer - even my own 'resurrection' is a sign of that."

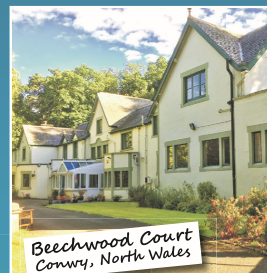

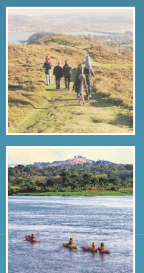

FOR SUCH A TIME AS THIS

The Church has remained silent on Israel for too long

This March presents a perfect opportunity for the Church to step into the breach on behalf of God's chosen people. The feast of Purim, celebrated this year on 9-10 March, recalls the time 2,500 years ago when a beautiful young orphan queen saved her people from annihilation in ancient Persia.

Esther's Jewish identity was a secret at the time of her accession to the throne, as the potential for anti-Semitism was so great. But when her guardian, Mordecai, alerted her to Haman's genocidal plot against all the Jews in the empire, she was challenged: "If you remain silent at this time, relief and deliverance for the Jews will arise from another place...who knows but that you have come to royal position for such a time as this?" (Esther 4:14).

Esther knew it would be dangerous to approach the King without being summoned but bravely bit the bullet, declaring: "If I perish, I perish" (Esther 4:16).

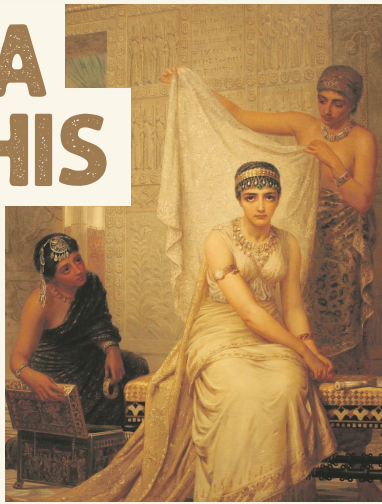
Is it not time for the Church to stand up for the Jews as Esther did? The Church in Germany was mostly silent as Hitler's anti-Semitic cancer spread. Thankfully, today, para-church organisations play the part of Mordecai in alerting Christians to dangers threatening Israel's existence – and by extension that of the Jewish people – as Hamas and Hezbollah follow in the footsteps of Haman, Herod and Hitler. At the same time, a harrowing new wave of anti-Semitism is sweeping Europe and America.

The British Church, as a whole, has badly neglected the Jewish people. Do we really think God has reneged on his promise of everlasting love for them (Jeremiah 31:3)? Do we realise that such misguided belief gives carte blanche to the sort of unbridled hatred for Israel we are

seeing increasingly today? It's time to make amends for our indifference by taking on the role of Esther – intervening on behalf of an endangered people in prayer and action.

In modern Persia, the ayatollahs are determined to wipe Israel off the map. But the tables were turned on the anti-Semites of ancient Persia. Haman literally made a rope by which to hang himself and his evil scheme came back on his own head. Similar devastation awaits those who touch the apple of God's eye today (Zechariah 2:8)!

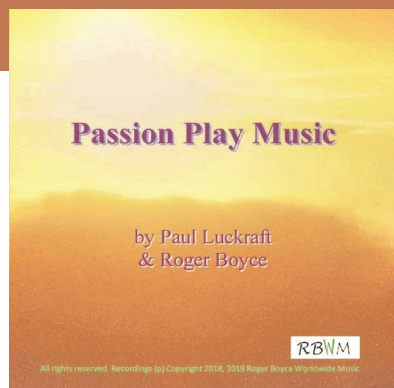


INTRODUCING 'PASSION PLAY MUSIC'

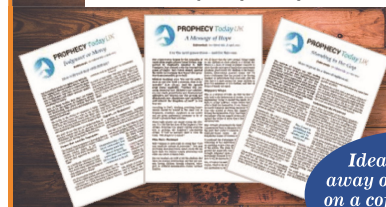

Horrified by the needs but encouraged by changed lives, Lisa Nolland reports on how Kenyans are resisting the pressure to adopt the West's LGBT agenda

Kenya is publicly standing against the West's financial pressure and propaganda, by refusing to adopt its agenda of sexual minority/reproductive rights, but this stand has a cost.

Organisations such as the Clinton Foundation use their funds to further LGBT rights through financial sponsorships.

As many daily struggle for basics like food, clean water and shelter, refusing such offers is incredibly hard. Another aspect here is the lucrative nature of transactional gay sex: prostitutes can earn 5,000 Kenyan Shillings (around £38) per act. Given such temptation, it is a miracle any manage to get out.

Thankfully, other aid is being found but daunting challenges remain.

The three key African states targeted by big western players are South Africa (which has gone under), Nigeria (still holding its own), and Kenya. Activists realise Kenya's strategic importance for the continent and continue to target it.

Still Christian-ish

I spent a week there at the end of 2019 and was horrified by the needs, but encouraged by the positives.

In the main, churches are thriving, though not without their issues. I at-

tended a Roman Catholic mass (with several hundred others) and heard a biblically based, applied sermon. I noted many wearing T shirts with the emblem, 'Come Oh Holy Spirit'.

Listening to Michael W Smith on the Kenyan equivalent of BBC One/Two was a highlight, as was browsing Christian books in the airport shop and watching Christian entertainers on television.

For the most part, Kenyans still understand and support heteronormativity and are pro-life, keeping their babies despite the daily struggle to survive. The various professionals I spoke with were appalled by the LGBT 'education' now being foisted on UK youngsters. They could not believe it.

Good news

There are some excellent developments, though, and God is at work.

I was particularly impressed by Life Choices, a programme

run by once gay Peter Mulinge. He has been able to help many with unwanted same-sex attraction, and that with virtually no outside support.

Peter does Christian and secular counselling, and meets physical needs of food, clothing, shelter and medical treatment (some of his lads have been diseased and/or needed to wear nappies after repeated homosexual activity). Activists have beaten him up twice and he has received death threats, but he continues in what he calls God's work with these 'least, last and lost'.

God is transforming these guys

And lives are being changed! I met lovely guys and heard for myself how God has transformed and is continuing to transform them. They are part of the future for Kenya! We know how important 'once gay' figures are in the West - activists are doing all they can to shut them down - and it is just the same there.

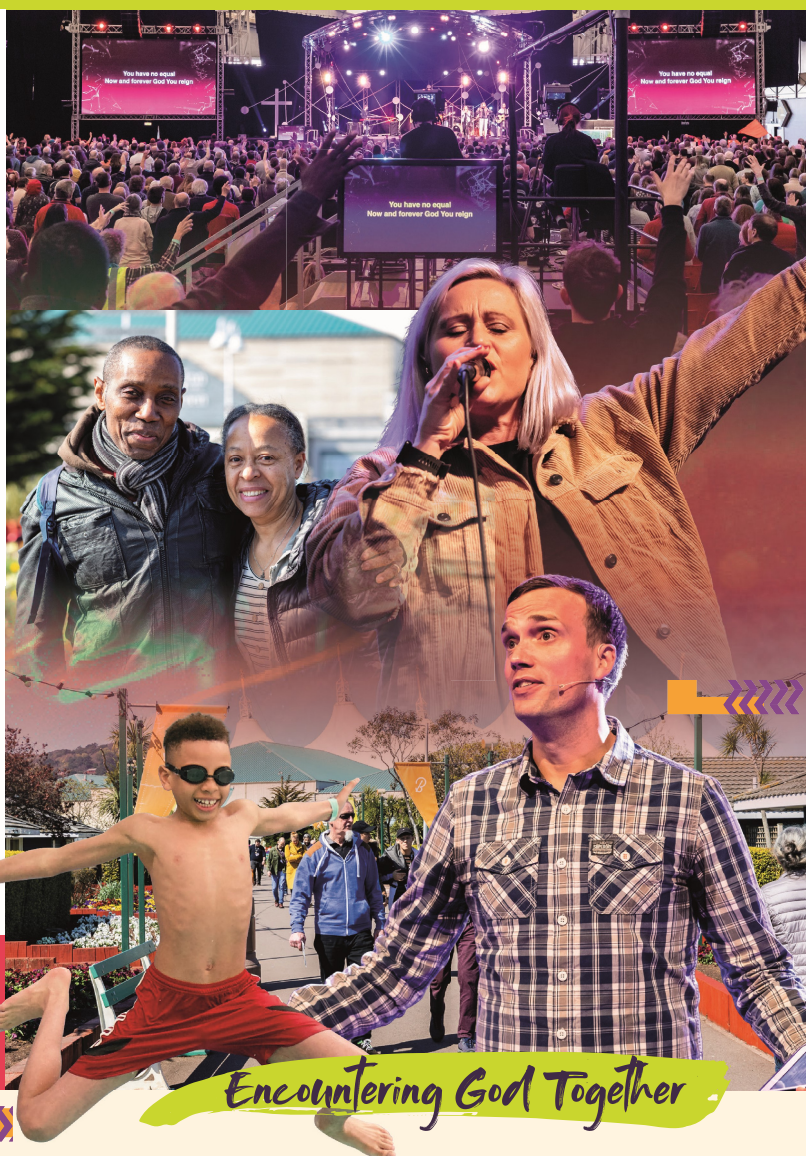
