GOVERNMENT CALMS GAY MARRIAGE FEARS

Now that same-sex marriage has been made legal in Northern Ireland, Secretary of State Julian Smith has reassured religious groups that their freedom of speech will be protected.

dom of speech will be protected. Smith promised legislation for free speech after the Christian Institute threatened legal action if religious liberties were not upheld.

According to Premier News, he said that mere criticism will not be regarded as an offence, religious groups will not be sued for refusing to support same-sex weddings and faith-based organisations will be able to sack staff who break their rules by marrying gay partners.

The Christian Institute welcomed the assurances, set out in proposals published by the British government for consultation in January, but said it would be watching to see that faith leaders are not taken to court for refusing to officiate at same-sex weddings.

er for alleged negligence. Quoirin, 15, who had special needs, went missing from the room she shared with her siblings at night in August 2019.

High Court to decide if kids should be given trans drugs

A former transgender patient has mounted an unprecedented legal challenge against the Tavistock Clinic, which helps teens

change their gender medically. The landmark test case at the High Court against the Tavistock and Portman NHS Trust's Gender Identity Development Service (GIDS), will decide whether children are able to give informed consent to treatment for gender reassignment.

The case was originally brought on behalf of Susan Evans, a former psychiatric nurse at the clinic, and 'Mrs A', the mother of an autistic 15-year-old girl who is on the GIDS waiting list. Ms Evans says that puberty blockers for under-18s should be illegal and that children are being rushed into life-altering decisions.

Now Keira Bell, who underwent treatment at the clinic, has taken Ms Evans' place as the lead claimant. She said, "I do not believe that children and young people can consent to the use of powerful and experimental hormone drugs like I did."

WELSH CHAPELS TO RE-OPEN: A retired chartered surveyor has invested £200,000 of his own savings in re-opening a dozen dis-used chapels in the South Wales valleys where a great revival broke out in 1904. Rev Robert Stivey aims to bring the Gospel back to the towns and villages where crime came to a virtual halt through the revival.

He says: "I am intent on attracting new fellowships... and using these chapels, not as museum pieces, but centres of worship."

"LIVELY" PRISON SERVICES: As inmates around the country discover the Gospel and flock to Bible studies and services, one prison chaplain comes back to work on his day off to attend the worship service there, as it's the "best and liveliest one in town".
