VISION FOR 21ST CENTURY CHURCH

After the unprecedented restrictions of 2020, a radical new vision for the 21st century Church is emerging

Even in our democracies, churches have been closed by state edict, numbers attending services limited and protests made illegal. Across Britain, house groups composed of more than two households, the mainstay of church life, cannot currently legally meet.

Now that Christians in the West have seen how quickly things can change, many of us believe that the Church will never be the same again. We have realised that the events of 2020 have been a wake-up call to the Church.

Indeed, for the past few years Christians have been writing about the rebirth of the 'ekklesia', a gathering of 'called out' ones. Our blueprint is now the Book of Acts, because we can no longer rely on the security of a regular programme in a church building. We are seeing the "beginning of sorrows" referred to by Jesus in Matthew 24. The continuing government crackdowns are a pre-cursor, the beginning of another era of the same kind that will bring with it restriction, conditioning and control. Recently I have been impact-

Recently I have been impacted again with a Word from the Lord concerning the Church: "The time of the Church as you know it, is over!"

This is an invitation to be reformed, in our relationship with the Lord, to one another, as well as how we reach people with the good news of Jesus. If we let God reform us, there will be quite a transformation in church life in the next two to three years. In 2018 I believe God showed me new regional centres, gathering points across the nation, where servant-hearted leaders supported the Church in love and unity.

Organisations, church denominations and streams gave way to these new centres.

This would be the last great move of God coming into the UK and Europe.

When the first lockdown was introduced last March, I began to pray over the virus and the pandemic. That was when the word "pre-cursor" came into my mind.

It's not a word I'd use, so I looked it up. It's a person or thing that comes before another of the same kind, a forerunner. It also can be a cell or cellular component, from which another is formed.

I believe this is an accurate message from God; it is affecting the whole world and fits with the biblical description of the "beginning of sorrows" in Matthew 24.

More recently, the other message, "The time of the Church, as you know it, is over!" was accompanied by a very strong sense that if we continue to lead and run church as we know it, we will find ourselves running things on our own, because the Lord has removed his blessing.

I am convinced that this is a message that needs to be heeded. Therefore it's vital that lead-

ers stop and re-evaluate what in on God's heart now. God's passion for his Church is very strong and I am convinced he is calling us back to himself in this season.

I am not the only Christian who has been prompted to rethink how the Church operates in recent years, leading to discussions of a return to the 'ekklesia'.

Back in July 2018, I felt the Holy Spirit was urging me to write down what he had been putting in my heart concerning

his ekklesia – his gathered people – a Church that is truly his. I now realise how timely this was. Like others, I believe God has used this time of closures to challenge our thinking.

I was led to write a short, biblical overview of what God's ekklesia is: the corporate body and bride of Christ. It also explains God's purpose for us and how we as his body should function. It's a man-sized read: you can read it in an evening!

We have a window of time to work in

Much of the current Church needs a reformation in its structure and function. We are still restricted in an "old wineskin" (Mark 2:21-22) and seem to be satisfied, perhaps not realising how far away we as his ekklesia have drifted from God's Word and blueprint. When Jesus said, "I will build

When Jesus said, "I will build my ekklesia and the gates of Hades will not prevail against it", he was using a word that had no connection to religion. It was used by both the Greek and Roman empires, and in the time of Jesus it referred to a secular institution which had a governing role.


What a great description of Jesus' Church and her purpose! It is through his Church that his Kingdom comes into people's lives.

These gatherings were often part of a meal, usually in homes with the breaking of bread and celebrating Jesus' victory over sin and death

God wants to revive households and homes. In particular, he wants to restore open gatherings where everyone comes together and brings a song, a teaching, a tongue, a revelation or an interpretation. This is body ministry, where everyone contributes to the building up of others.

It's the type of meeting that the early Church had more than anything else. These gatherings were often part of a meal, usually in homes with the breaking of bread and celebrating Jesus' victory over sin and death.

We majored on this type of meeting in the first church I led; although we met in a public hall on Sundays, the church's fundamental strength was in the relationships forged in weekly house groups, where we had strong prayer and worship and members were friends outside the groups. Although I brought teaching in our main

meetings, we included "open" times, when members were encouraged to contribute.

We must never forget Jesus' last command before he went up to heaven: to GO into all the world and proclaim the good news and make disciples in his name.

The ekklesia that Jesus is building is to be in the marketplace. We are to govern, especially in the place of prayer; then we can go out into our communities and workplaces with the spiritual authority that brings people to Christ, heals the sick, casts out demons and sets people free.

To do this, we need a fresh encounter with Jesus; we must seek him wholeheartedly and let the Holy Spirit speak to us and change us from within.

Things in our world are changing fast; we have a window of time to work in, because persecution of the Church is coming. But if we do this now, then

But if we do this now, then when persecution comes, we will be reformed and ready to function in the way the New Testament has taught us all along. Paul Taylor is married to Claire; they have four children and eight grandchildren.

With others, Paul pioneered a house church in West Sussex in the 1980s, which grew over the next 14 years. In 1995, he handed it over to other leaders and joined Kingdom Faith Church in Horsham, Sussex, serving as a pastor for 21 years, including working with others to pioneer a church in Crawley.

But having received a clear instruction from God to "Stop, lay everything down and to seek the Lord", it became clear that the Holy Spirit wanted to reform Paul and his ministry.

In 2017 Paul and Claire were led to Bude, Cornwall and have become part of the local Christian community.

Paul says: "Thave been going out, sharing the good news of Jesus with others, knowing there is a 'harvest' of people waiting."

Readers may recall the sudden healing of actress Marianne Gaston.

Now Marianne has made a short film relating how she was miraculously healed from undiagnosed Lyme Disease after ten years of illness

On 25 August 2007 Marianne Gaston suddenly found herself unable to get out of bed.

Finally she managed to struggle to the sofa, which became her home for the next eight years.

Her husband, Leslie, gave up his job as an aircraft engineer to become her full-time carer. "Friends stopped calling due to my sheer exhaustion

after talking for just ten minutes," she remembers. "Next to Leslie, my constant companion was our lovely cat, Smudge, who would sit on the arm of the settee all day next to me."

of the settee all day next to me." The correct diagnosis came years later; at first doctors thought Marianne was suffering from ME.

Unable to eat properly, she existed on health drinks, her weight slowly dropping to just six stone. The illness also caused her hair to fall out. Her only outings were to hospital – in a wheelchair – and she even missed her own mother's funeral.



Overwhelmed by guilt over "failing" to meet normal obligations, she cried out to God, whose response, it seemed, was for her to become a "prayer warrior". Although she couldn't attend services at their local church, Tewkesbury Abbey in Gloucestershire, she was encouraged to know that fellow Christians were faithfully praying for her. "Communion was brought to me occasionally, so I never felt God had forsaken me."

Her weight dropped to six stone and her hair fell out

Now she began praying for others and the nation and even received a vision one night of her own guardian angel.

Marianne's miracle came after a visiting Pakistani bishop prayed for her. "After Bishop Yousaf left, I felt full of the joy of the Lord and couldn't stop laughing. Ten years after my illness began, I was instantly healed!"

After the High Court decided

that children under 16 can't consent to puberty blockers, the full impact of transgender treatments has been revealed.

On 1 December the High Court ruled against the Tavistock Centre, the NHS gender clinic, after transitioner Keira Bell, who now regrets her treatment, said she was harmed by puberty blockers and cross-sex hormones pre-scribed as a teenager.

has published the "shocking

physicians' testimony" about transgender medicine that led to the High Court ban.

The Mail on Sunday reported in January that Swedish psychiatrist Christopher Gillberg believes the Tavistock treatment is basically "a live exper-iment" on vulnerable children: "We have left established evi-dence-based clinical practice and are using powerful life-altering medication for a vulner-

able group of adolescents and children based upon a belief." Gillberg and other experts said that puberty blockers can damage brain and bone devel-opment and cause infertility.

The medics also criticised the transgender movement for encouraging transition in vulnerable children, including those with autism who simply have "identity issues". A "disproportionate number" of children who identify as transgender are in care, adopted, autistic, anorexic or have psychiatric or mental illnesses.

The court case heard evidence from dozens of women who said their lives had been ruined by their sex change.

American gender expert Professor Stephen Levine testified that "critical and cautious voices are shouted down as transphobic... It is left to those of us at the end of our careers, who have nothing to lose, to voice our concerns.

Baroness Nicholson, a former director of Save The Children, told the Mail on Sunday: "The NHS should never have allowed such unresearched use of public money on irre-mediable surgery on healthy bodies.

The clinic, which was rat-ed "inadequate" by the Care Quality Commission's inspection in January, is appealing the High Court ruling.

Even Poland's government, which wants to fly the man back to Polish care, has been rebuffed. UK judges have banned the Polish Consul General from seeing him and Polish doctors from examining him, causing a diplomatic rift.

An appeal to the European Court of Human Rights failed. The judge used to be a member

Whistleblowing chaplain fights court battle

A prison chaplain banned for ten years was denied a judicial review by the High Court but can take his case to a County Court.

Volunteer chaplain Pastor Paul Song's problems began af-ter exposing Islamic extremism in HMP Brixton.

A High Court judge decided in January that Song can continue his legal fight, one day after the Ministry of Justice published evidence on extremism in Brixton prison that vindicates Song.

The Christian Legal Centre is supporting Song in the hope that the pastor can return to his ministry.

Song says that "tolerance for any religious view other than Is-lam is precluded" in HMP Brixton.

He has served prisoners in Brixton for 20 years, yet in re-cent times has felt threatened and has been assaulted and abused by Muslim prisoners. Some of them took over the prison's Christian chapel and celebrated the terrorist murder of Lee Rigby, yet Song is the one punished.

It's not his first ban, but on the previous occasion a review concluded that his exclusion was "not reasonable" and he was reinstated.

A chilling message to anyone prepared to expose wrong-doing

Andrea Williams, chief executive of the Christian Legal Centre, said: "The decision to ban Pastor Song from all prisons for ten years has sent a chilling message to anyone prepared to expose wrong-doing and corruption in our public institutions... This is a case that exposes the disturbing rise and influence of Islamic extremism and intimi-dation of Christians in our prisons.

A 72-year-old woman's arrest during a peaceful protest by a handful of people in November aroused the anger of Tory MP Sir Charles Walker.

Walker, the vice-chair of the 1922 Committee of MPs, was videoed berating the police as they lifted the woman by all four limbs and bundled her into a van outside Parliament. He repeatedly challenged the officers, asking, "Don't

any of you have mothers?" Calling the incident "an out-rage" and "an absolute disgrace",

he later reported the incident in the Commons, demanding the PM 'sort this out"

A police statement said the woman was arrested "for breaching the coronavirus restrictions' on gatherings, yet anti-racism protests involving hundreds of people went unopposed throughout 2020.

Polish patient being starved to death in **UK hospital**

Citizen Go have organised a petition to save the life of a man having fluids and food withdrawn by a Devon hospital.

The patient, a pro-life Polish Catholic who would have objected to such treatment, is in a coma after suffering a heart attack.

Christian Concern reports that two independent neurologists who have seen videos of the man believe he is recovering, yet the courts have banned future neurological assessments and publication of the videos.

Women and Equalities minister Liz Truss made a speech in December that was welcomed by Intercessors for Britain (IFB) but labelled 'bonkers' by left wingers.

IFB leader David Borlase commented: "After many years of, in particular, LGBT demands being pandered to, there seems to be something of a shift. While we wouldn't endorse everything in the speech... we felt this was encouraging for our pravers.

Truss promised an equality agenda "led by facts not fashion". She wanted to move the focus from groups to individuals and from "fashionable" issues of identity politics to economic and geographic inequalities.

Political correctness had allowed "appalling grooming of young girls"

The speech was labelled "utterly bonkers" by Liberal Democrat deputy leader Daisy Cooper

and condemned by leftist newspapers. Truss highlighted her intention to use "data

and research" instead of "listening to those with the loudest voices", and attacked political cor-rectness for failing "to defend single-sex spaces, hard fought for by generations of women" and allowing "the appalling grooming of young girls in towns like Rotherham".

She announced a ban on unconscious bias training in the government and civil service because it "does not improve equality" and can reinforce stereotypes.

Truss also condemned the idea that "if you are

not from an 'oppressed group' then you are not entitled to an opinion" and announced new appointments to the Equality and Human Rights Commission so that the EHRC will focus on "fair treatment for all, rather than freelance campaigning".

Woman cleared of 'misgendering'

A High Court judgement has upheld the 'right to offend'.

Kate Scottow was arrested at home, in front of her children. after transgender Stephanie Hayden told police she was offended by Scottow referring to her as a man

Judges originally found the mum guilty and, incredibly, she was ordered to pay £1,000 compensation. However, in December the High Court overturned the ruling. The judges said that "free speech encompasses the right to offend" and criticised

right to offend and criticised the previous decision as crimi-nalising mere name-calling. The Daily Telegraph wel-comed the decision, saying police forces must note that "it is now established that being rude on Twitter is not automati-cally grounds for investigation".

VACCINE **CONTROVERSY**

With uncertainty surround-ing the vaccines currently being offered against Covid-19, many Christians have wondered about the ethical aspect of taking a vaccine which is made using foetal cells.

A scientific researcher has told HEART that certain foetal cells are an intrinsic part of generating the Oxford/ Astrazeneca vaccine (even although all the cells are removed before the vaccine is finalised). However, they are not an intrinsic part of the Pfizer/BioNTech and Moderna vaccines.

The cell line is called HEK-293 and was derived from the kidney of a baby girl who was legally aborted on medical grounds or was miscarried in

the Netherlands in 1972.





WHOSE LAND?

PART 1 - FOUNDATIONS

A century after the Balfour Declaration of November 1917 the argument over the land – then known as Palestine – rages on.

Politicians, clerics and school teachers living in the Gaza strip, the West Bank and the Old City of Jerusalem, teach their children, teenagers and young adults that the Balfour Declaration was illegal, and that the whole of the land – now known as Israel – in fact belongs to the Arab people who are today known as the Palestinians. The Palestinian claim goes on to assert that the Jewish people have no historic connection with Jerusalem, that they are in fact trying to Judaize the Holy City and that the Jewish presence there is illegal. Moreover, this claim is now becoming widely accepted among many in the Western world. So what **historic** and **legal** claim do the Palestinian Arabs have over Jerusalem and the Land of Israel?

Do the Jewish people have historic and legal rights? If so, when and where did they originate?

There is no one to tell him that it is God who is shaking the nation through the coronavirus which will go on for a long time yet. But that needn't stop the rest of us repenting before God in humility

Most people are thoroughly fed up with the coronavirus and the succession of lockdowns.

Nearly a year ago, when all this started, nobody thought we would still be in the same position today, fighting to control the virus.

But this is no ordinary flu. We were told it's a plague that is quite capable of wiping out large sectors of the population, which is why health experts called for such tight restrictions on social mixing.

Indecision

We all know this, but we don't like any restrictions on our freedom to live our lives according to our own desires, so we look for any way around the rules and if that is not possible then we want to blame someone. The easiest target is the government, whose policies have been flawed by indecision and many last-minute changes in the rules.

The prime minister has borne the brunt of this criticism and there have even been calls for him to step aside because his leadership is deemed inadequate. Clearly, he does not like being the bearer of bad news. He is a natural campaigner and an irrepressible optimist.

It is against all his inclinations to have to impose restrictions upon the population, so he is reluctant to take the advice of his health experts. This reluctance is transmitted to the nation as indecision, which makes people lose confidence in his leadership.

Lack of spiritual guidance

There is no other natural leader in the Tory Party at the moment who could replace Boris, and a change of prime minister at this stage in the pandemic would undoubtedly create enormous instability, which would do great harm both at national and international levels.

The prime minister's policy is to highlight any items of good news that he can obtain, such as the number of vaccinations being carried out. Their hope is that by the middle of February all the front-line health staff, the over-80s and the most vulnerable will have been vaccinated. But the vaccine will not save the nation.

A change of prime minister at this stage would create enormous instability

The reason for the rapid change of policy in Boris's leadership is because he does not understand what is going on! He has plenty of experts on the scientific facts among his advisers, and there is no shortage of political advisers around him.

But what is lacking is spiritual leadership. For at least the last four prime ministers there has been a 'faith adviser' in Number Ten, and more recently there has been a small group of evangelical intercessors who meet daily for prayer. But the role of the 'faith adviser' is a wide remit covering other faiths as well as Christianity, and the group of intercessors has no direct communication with the PM, other than through the faith adviser.

Absence of strong leadership

There are many individuals in both Houses of Parliament who are strongly committed Christians, but the way the political establishment works means that they have no direct access to the PM. Among church leaders there is no outstanding Bible-believing Christian exercising a notable public ministry in any of the denominations. We have an Archbishop of Canterbury who is 'all things to all men' but exercises only weak leadership, and an Archbishop of York who is notoriously liberal, with a record of antipathy towards Bible-believing evangelicals.

So where does the prime minister receive any biblically -based Christian counsel? The plain answer is that there is no Christian counsel available to him. There is no one to tell him that it is God who is shaking the nation through the coronavirus pandemic which will go on for a long time yet, until God achieves his purpose in sending it, or allowing it to happen, which in biblical terms is one and the same thing.

The God factor

So long as the 'God factor' is left out from this plague we will never learn the lesson it is intended to convey. We should be asking: "What is God looking for?"

Quite simply: God is looking for repentance for all the wickedness that we have committed, and the ungodly laws that we have passed in our Parliament since the end of the Second World War. We have now reached the tipping point of iniquity, the point where God has said: "Enough is enough", and the point where he must intervene in human history for the ultimate benefit of humanity.

We can learn a lot from the history of Israel recorded in the Bible where God has intervened in the past. In the sixth century BC he sent the Babylonians to destroy Jerusalem and the whole land of Judah. This is reported in the historical book of 2 Kings, where it says: "Surely at the commandment of the LORD this came upon Judah, to remove them from his sight because of the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he had done, and also because of the innocent blood that he had shed; for he had filled Jerusalem with innocent blood, which the LORD would not pardon." (2 Kings 24:3-4).

In Britain, we pollute the land with the blood of the innocent by the vast number of babies we burn in the incinerators outside our hospitals and clinics every working day. To date we have killed nine million babies. But there are many other ways in which we all, as individuals, cause offence to God – by our ungodly ways, greed, corruption, injustice, and utter disregard for the Word of God.

It is surely time for examining our ways and coming before God in humility. Repentance has to start somewhere. Like judgement, it should start in the household of God – that means it should start with Bible-believing Christians!



There has been much comment on the unprecedented divisions in our society we have witnessed of late. Particularly in America over the recent elections and in Britain over Brexit and Covid.

What's behind all this? Well, the Bible holds the answer, spelled out by the prophet Joel in the verses immediately following the well-known passage on the outpouring of the Holy Spirit. (Joel 2:28-32)

These passages were initially fulfilled on the Day of Pentecost, but I believe they also apply to the troubled last days in which we are living.

Joel then writes: "In those days and at that time, when I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem, I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel, because they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land." (Joel 3:1-2)

This means, in effect, that the nations responsible for promot-

ing the so-called "two-state solution" to the Middle East conflict are on a collision course with God, who has clearly, and repeatedly, stated that the land of Israel is his, and he has given it to the Jews because they are his special inheritance.

Questions about who owns this much-coveted territory are thus a litmus test for whether nations are for or against God and his purposes. There are other factors causing divisions, of course, but this one is crucial.

After years of stalemate on this issue, the outgoing President Trump, for all his flaws, has dramatically turned things around in Israel's favour, generally backing the biblical position against a turbulent anti-Semitic tide while still leaving the "twostate solution" theoretically on the table.

But his action has been met with a gigantic backlash as the

hordes of hell have risen up in fury against God's plans, effectively aligning themselves with those who would dispossess Israel of their rightful land. After promising to do all in our power to achieve this, we were handed the international mandate to carry it out following the signing of the San Remo Treaty in 1920.

But we subsequently betrayed the Jewish people by favouring Arab aspirations instead and prevented Jews fleeing the Nazi Holocaust from entering the land long promised by God.

(Ezekiel 36:2) But it wouldn't stop Jews coming back to their "own land" (Ezekiel 36:24) and rebuilding the ancient ruins.

Even now, the UK continues to vote in favour of anti-Israel resolutions at the United Nations, including one that referred to the Temple Mount by its Muslim name (as reported by Christians United for Israel on 6 November).

It is surely time the British government changed tack on Israel and made a formal apology for its ongoing betrayal of the sacred trust it was granted to be a blessing to the seed of Abraham. Genesis 12:3

ARE WE BEING LULLED INTO ACCEPTING A 'ONE WORLD RELIGION?'

There is an old adage that when God wants to do some farming, he gets the devil to pull the plough! Does God's warning to the Israelites when he had rescued them from Egypt also apply to us?

"If you do not carefully observe all the words of this law that are written in this book, that you may fear (revere) this glorious and awesome name, THE LORD YOUR GOD, then the Lord will bring upon you and your descendants extraordinary plagues – great and prolonged plagues – and serious and prolonged sicknesses." (Deuteronomy 28:58-59)

While Christians are not under the law, the world, in its legalised depravity – like the Israelites – has not obeyed the voice of the Lord. God does not change. (Malachi 3:6)

Whatever the origin of Covid-19, we should remember that we are in a spiritual battle. But God is sovereign and promises us that, "When the enemy comes in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD will lift up a standard against him." (Isaiah 59:19)

Was 2020 a final warning to put away sin? It does seem that God is using the lockdown to remove what distracts us from seeking him.

Yet in apparent ignorance of history and the blood shed for the Gospel, a weak Church has allowed God's Word to be compromised by not standing against secular government and education.

Christianity should not be taken for granted; it prevailed as Europe's religion against Muslim invaders, but now, centuries later, we are entering another Dark Age.

Through ignorance, control and repression by the Church, the biblical doctrine of salvation through faith in Jesus Christ was withheld from the world for a thousand years. For much of this time, Christianity in Europe was also under attack from Islam, firstly by the Arab Saracens and later the Ottoman Turks.

Is Universalism a politically inspired doctrinal trap to persuade the world to adopt the harlot one world church of Revelation 17?

It concerns me that some Christians seem ready to overlook the fact that Jesus shed his blood on the cross to atone for our sins once and for all time.

Hence Jesus warned against deception: "Take heed that no one deceives you. For false christs and false prophets will arise and show great signs and wonders to deceive, if possible, even the elect." (Matthew 24:4 and 24)

What should we do about the delusion that is upon us? Paul said: "The coming of the lawless one is according to the working of Satan, with all power, signs and lying wonders, and with all unrighteous deception among those who perish, because they did not receive the love of the truth, that they might be saved. And for this reason, God will send them strong delusion, that they should believe the lie, that they all may be condemned who did not believe the truth but had pleasure in unrighteousness. (2 Thessalonians 2:9-12) We are warned!

We can be thankful that God used the Roman Church to protect his Word during the Dark Age. If Christian armies had not stopped Islamic invasions, Christianity could have been destroyed.

'The Great Reset' has been written and talked about by World Economic Forum founder Klaus Schwab and is endorsed by Prince Charles for its climate aims. Its slogan, "Build back better", was adopted by Joe Biden for his presidential campaign in 2020. It links to the UN's Agenda 2030 for sustainable development, but critics see it as a means for the "elite" to seize more power and individual rights.

Are the Covid-19 lockdowns trial runs for what is to come?

And is taking the knee to Black Lives Matter another symptom of our being indoctrinated into subservience? People who do so, however well-meaning, are unwittingly giving credence to the Marxist ideology behind it.

From the lessons of Nazi Germany we see how fascism is not much being imposed by fascists, who may be few in number, but by a population that has willingly surrendered its freedom to their lies for the so-called 'greater good'. We know that one day every knee will bow... and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord to the glory of God the Father. (Philippians 2:10-11)

In the Great Tribulation to come, Babylon is portrayed in Revelation 17 in a number of ways: it is the New World Order system combining world government with a universal church, the Antichrist's confederated empire, and a combination of apostate Christianity and other religions.

The Apostle John heard a voice from heaven proclaim: "Come out of her, my people, lest you share in her sins, and lest you receive of her plagues." (Revelation18:4) We are not yet in the Great Tribulation, because that is the time of God's wrath on the world and the true Church will not be part of it. But we have always experienced tribulation from Satan. Jesus said: "In the world, you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world." (John 16:33)

We are indoctrinated by political correctness not to cause offence. For this reason, many churches elevate a social gospel over the Gospel of salvation. We see this particularly on the BBC's Sunday morning services. God's Word upsets many and is a major cause of Christian persecution.

God desires that no-one should perish, but Scripture does not give us the Universalist option that all are eventually saved. Paul made it clear that being and doing good works does not save us. (Ephesians 2:8-10) Isaiah said all our righteous deeds are as filthy rags. (Isaiah 64:6)

At the great white throne of judgement that will take place at the end of the Messianic Kingdom age, the unbelieving dead will be judged for what they have done so that they may receive punishment commensurate to their lives, but no matter how good a life they may have led they are not saved and are cast into the lake of fire Revelation 20:11-15. What the lake of fire is and what happens in it we are not told. (See also Daniel 12:2). It is certainly eternal separation from God.

Jesus spoke more about hell than heaven. He used three symbols: that of everlasting punishment (Matthew 25:46); that of destruction (Matthew 10:28); and thirdly that of exclusion or banishment into darkness, outside of heaven. (Matthew 25:1-30)

Here is a quotation from CS Lewis' book, 'The Problem of Pain':

"In the long run the answer to all those who object to the doctrine of Hell (and thereby presumably adhere to a doctrine of Universalism) is itself a question: "What are you asking God to do?" To wipe out past sins and, at all costs to give every unbeliever a fresh start, smoothing every difficulty and offering every miraculous help and forgive them? But Jesus has done so, on Calvary. They will not be forgiven. Should He leave them alone? Alas, I am afraid that is what he does."

None of us can pretend to understand all of God's ways, they are not our ways (Isaiah 55:8) but it is our job to accept the Gospel's hard teachings by faith and communicate them as they are written.

So, whether 2021 will be increasingly difficult – even catastrophic – or, as many of my neighbours believe, will be a

return to normality, we will have to see. It may well be a return to some sort of acceptable normality for those who believe the lie and have put their trust in science as their saviour through the Covid-19 vaccine, and are prepared to submit to all the increasingly intrusive measures of the New World Order for the greater good, having been frightened into conformity.

But Christians should know the world is being deluded and that night is coming when the true Gospel can no longer be preached. I killed myself, was pronounced dead - then God brought me back to life!

After a life of drug dealing and prison, Richard Stuart thought he was the last person God would bother with

At the age of 24, I was at the end. The pain in my heart and mental problems made my life unbearable.

When the agony gets too bad, you can see only one way out. Ketamine and alcohol could no longer deaden the pain from a bad relationship and my own unstable emotions.

I parked my car in a remote place and started a petrol generator on the back seat. The carbon monoxide fumes, I knew, would soon kill me. That is the last I remember.

I found out later that I was in the car for 14 hours before I was found by the emergency services (ambulance and police) and pronounced dead.

Amazingly, though, I didn't die, but awoke, confused and utterly disorientated in a hospital bed. After a couple of days my brain

function returned.

A wonderful sense of re- peace, purity and glory vas enveloped me

> But something had happened while I was "dead" that changed my view of the world. I remember a light beaming down on me, while a wonderful sense of peace, purity and glory enveloped me. This was my first encounter with God.

Later I discovered that a Christian friend had been "told" by God to pray for me. I'd known him for ten years – he used to tell me about Jesus and I thought he was insane. My friend told me he'd had a real sense of danger – he knew something was wrong.

How could someone like me, with my criminal past, have been allowed to cheat death?

Drug dealing had been my way of life from 14 when I started selling cannabis. I was pretty naive and certainly learned my 'trade' the hard way.

At 15 I was sent to juvenile prison for the attempted rob<u>b</u>ery of a post office

At 15 I was sent to juvenile prison for the attempted robbery of a post office and over the next five years I was in and out of prison like a yo-yo. In fact, juvenile prison was worse than the adult prisons I was in later – there was much more bullying.

From the age of 20 to 24 I had what I thought was the party life, until my insecurities wrecked my relationship with a lovely girl. Suddenly my party life was powerless to stop the mental torment, which was what drove me to that remote place with a petrol generator.

Yet it seemed God hadn't allowed me to die! Unbelievably, while I knew that something spiritual had happened, I was too hard-hearted to believe in him and continued to try to run my own life.

The next seven years saw my descent into heroin addiction. I no longer cared if I was caught and sent to prison; I had a lot of enemies in my home town and felt safer in prison. It provided a stable life and my laundry got done!

My frequent visits to prison were strange, though. I kept being put in cells with Christians!

My frequent visits to prison were strange, though. I kept being put in cells with Christians! They all told me about Jesus, and my previous experience of God's light and glory occupied my mind – it wouldn't leave me alone. I slowly came to realise that God's hand was on my life.

Finally, at the age of 32, I cried out to God, "If you're there, help me – I can't take any more."

I suddenly had the thought, "Recovery House Rehab". It was a Christian rehab that I'd heard about two years earlier in prison.

I told my grandparents and they contacted the rehab, who accepted me straight from prison with no interview. A miracle!

At this stage, from years of drug addiction, I was barely human. I could only scream aggression at people. I slowly became aware of all the terrible things that I had done in my life. As soon as someone explained the death of Jesus – how he died so that I could be cleansed of sin and also healed, I couldn't say "Yes" to him quickly enough!

From that time God really was at work in my life. I was free from drug addiction, God found me somewhere to live and sent kind-hearted Christians to show me love.

I was increasingly aware that other people were free and I needed that freedom

Then I was told about a Bible college and felt strongly I was to go. I gave up my flat and slept in my car while I waited for accommodation to become available at the college. Once there, enjoying the worship times, I was increasingly aware that other people were free and I needed that freedom.

God didn't let me down; as my emotional and mental freedom grew, renewing me from the inside, it was wonderful. All this from just sitting at Jesus' feet and waiting on God. In many ways, Covid has been a blessing because it enables me to do just that.

When I look back at my pitiful state in that prison cell just four years ago, I am so grateful to Jesus for rescuing me and giving me a new life. I would love to see others receiving Jesus the way I have. My desire is to shout from the mountain top: "God loves you and can change your life beyond recognition."

The way we can receive new life as we die in Jesus, and then are reborn in him, is, in my life, a fact that cannot be denied. 'Happy clappy' is the usual derogatory term for people like me. That's fine – I've got a lot to be happy about!

God reached out to me even when I was killing myself. I am utterly convinced that he loves you, too – with the same intensity!

Timeless truths in the Bible have brought Richard his freedom

Pastor Les Potter says he hasn't been to a doctor or dentist for 40 years.

According to Pastor Les, he simply decided to believe the Bible's promises about healing and the miracles that Jesus and others did.

He and his wife Joan had already been married for 19 years before they became Christians. "I was on the verge of suicide," he recalls. "I just called out to God – and he rescued me. My wife got saved a few days later."

Many people misunderstand evolution, and this is partly due to the way that evolutionists tell their story.

It goes something like this: "Evolution is change; therefore, change is evolution."

This is very misleading. Evolution is supposed to explain how all life — pelicans, palm trees and people — evolved from a singlecelled ancestor which lived around 3.5 billion years ago.

For one kind of creature to evolve into something quite different would have involved a massive amount of change, but the examples we are given are simply small, limited variations known as natural selection. No new genetic information has been added and in some instances it has actually been lost.

In 2008 The New York Times reported "one of the biggest evolutionary shifts ever documented in a living population of wild animals."

What was this amazing evidence? In 20 years "the outer tail feathers of barn swallows had lengthened by almost half an inch (11.4 mm), an increase of 10 per cent."

This change is said to make the males more attractive to the females, but they are still swallows – and always will be! Their tails





won't keep growing indefinitely, or natural selection would eliminate them since it would hinder their flight.


Did you know that some elephants are losing their tusks? One African national park estimated 38% of elephants are born without tusks. This is thought to be partly due to poaching. Elephants with small tusks, or no tusks at all, are less likely to be killed for their ivory, so human actions are helping natural selection, and tusklessness is being passed on. Well-known evolutionist Richard Dawkins claimed this is "rapid evolution taking place before our very eyes."

Human actions are helping natural selection

But this is not true. Firstly, they are still elephants, and secondly, they have actually lost some genetic information.

Australian skinks are losing their legs. They have gone from having five-fingered claws to tiny, stubby legs — or no legs at all.

This is advantageous, since they spend a lot of time either swimming or wriggling through sand. This

has been described as "evidence of rapid evolution", but this is not the kind of change evolutionists need. When visiting the Galapagos Islands off South America, Charles Darwin noticed that there were several species of mockingbirds on the islands, and that they were similar to mockingbirds on the South American mainland. He concluded that they all had a common ancestor.


This was logical, but he was wrong to suggest that this meant that all life on earth had evolved from some common ancestor. This was natural selection, not evolution.

If the best evidence that evolution is happening now is swallows growing longer tails, elephants losing tusks, and skinks losing legs, there is really no evidence at all.

The Bible records that God created things "according to their kinds." (Genesis 1)

There was scope for wide variation within each kind, but one kind could not change into another. Both the fossil record and the living world support this; natural selection, yes — evolution no!

Nigeria 2,200 NIGERIAN CHRISTIANS MARTYRED IN 2020

WESTERN MEDIA STILL "FALLING FOR THE PROPAGANDA"

Islamist murders of Christians in Nigeria totalled 2,200 last year, and 34,400 since 2009, according to a civil liberties organisation.

Nigeria's International Society for Civil Liberties and the Rule of Law also reports that the Nigerian government massages the figures by listing many of the deaths as due to banditry or tribal clashes, rather than Islamic fundamentalism.

The Society's leader and founder, Emeka Umeagbalasi, told The Christian Post that Nigeria's government tells foreign media that herdsmen from the Fulani tribe are moving south because of desertification and as a result clash with local farmers. The truth is that the Fulanis are radical Islamists looking for Christians to kill, but Western media fall for the government's propaganda because they prefer to avoid Islamic violence narratives.

Umeagbalasi claims that the Nigerian government in fact supports radical Islamists, and this explains why the Nigerian military has failed to defeat the terrorists, and in some cases is complicit in the attacks.

He added that last year five of Nigeria's major Islamic groups made an alliance to attack Christians, in a concerted strategy to impose Islam on Nigeria. Seven Christians were killed near Chibok on Christmas Eve, reportedly by Islamist terror group Boko Haram, and the massacre of 100 villagers just after Christmas in neighbouring Niger was reported by the BBC.

Last year five of Nigeria's major Islamic groups made an alliance to attack Christians

Also in December, a video released by Islamic State showed the execution of five Christians in northeast Nigeria, which took place after the kidnapping of 11 Christians on Christmas Day. The video states that the killings are "a warning to Christians in all parts of the world".

Release International's Nigerian partner Hassan John says: "The government, by design or omission, is turning a blind eye to the carnage."

On 10 December the prosecutor of the International Criminal Court, Fatou Bensouda, called for an investigation into crimes against humanity in Nigeria.

India

Pastor killed after baptising new believers

Three men shot a pastor in the Indian state of Jharkhand as he was returning home with his wife after a baptismal service.

Pastor Salim Stephen Surin, a part-time evangelist, was killed on 8 December, according to International Christian Concern.

Local churches told ICC that Christians had been threatened several times. Despite the threats, Pastor Surin continued his ministry in the area.

Christians in Jharkhand have seen an increase in attacks in recent months, after a rise in radical Hindu groups.

Meanwhile, the first arrests under a new 'anti-conversion' law have taken place in Uttar Pradesh.

On 19 December, South Korean Christian Mi Kyung Lee and three others were accused of attempting to convert people while distributing aid to the poor. The organiser of the distribution, Raj Kumar Masih, says: "We have... names and phone numbers of our beneficiaries, who can testify that we have not asked any of them to change their faith or religion."

Hong Kong



DEAF-MUTE GIRL GANG-RAPED

A deaf-mute Christian teenager was raped and tortured for two months by five men, after she was forced into a sham Islamic marriage in Pakistan last year.

Pakistan

The parents of 17-year-old Komal accuse the police of negligence in the investigation and the local Muslim community of acceptance of the crime.

The British Asian Christian Association (BACA) report that an uncle of the abductor informed police that the teenager was legally married and produced a sham marriage certificate, a certificate of conversion to Islam and a forged birth certificate that stated she was 18 years old.

As a result the police denied permission for Komal's parent to take her home, despite the fact she had told her parents through sign language that she had been abducted and repeatedly raped by five Muslims. But after a local politician demanded the police investigate further, it was discovered in June that Komal had indeed endured physical and sexual abuse, and she was returned to her family.

The Central Investigation Agency is investigating the rape allegations.

BACA Chairperson Juliet Chowdhry said: "This young woman has suffered the most vile and horrid attack... and yet despite her young years, she has shown a strength and faith in God that is remarkable."

UK MPs have launched an inquiry into forced marriage and religious conversion of Christian girls in Pakistan. The All Party Parliamentary Group (APPG) for Pakistani Minorities aims to identify the weaknesses in Pakistani law and its implementation, and recommend solutions.



SCHOOLBOYS STILL NEED SAVING

One of the few stories about Islamist attacks in Nigeria to reach international news headlines last year was the kidnapping of hundreds of boys from a secondary school in Kankara.

It made TV news bulletins again when security forces rescued 344 of the students from terrorist group Boko Haram on 18 December. However, it is estimated that around 500 boys were taken captive, and government forces made the rescue without fighting the jihadist group, raising suspicions that some captives were not released.

A persecution watchdog has urged President Muhammadu Buhari to rescue the remaining boys.

Dede Laugesen, executive director of Save the Persecuted Christians, told The Christian Post that Nigeria receives international money to help it fight terrorism but does little to tackle the problem. Allowing the Islamists to carry on means the cash continues to flow to the government.

The attack bears similarities to the kidnapping of 276 Nigerian schoolgirls in 2014 which gained global attention.

CHRISTIAN ACTIVIST ARRESTED AGAIN

Christian democracy campaigner Joshua Wong has been charged with another offence while in prison, where he is already serving a 13-month sentence.

The re-arrest of the leading democracy activist in Hong Kong took place on 7 January – the day after 53 other activists and Democrat Party members were arrested for arranging an unofficial election.

Wong, 24, jailed in December for organising and participating in an unauthorised protest in 2019, now faces a new charge of breaking the National Security Law which China forced on Hong Kong last June.

The introduction of the controversial law triggered months of protests last year. It carries a maximum punishment of life imprisonment.

UK foreign secretary Dominic Raab said: "These arrests demonstrate that the Hong Kong and Chinese authorities deliberately misled the world about the true purpose of the National Security Law, which is being used to crush dissent and opposing political views."

POLITICIANS CONDEMN BIG TECH' TRUMP BAN



Big Tech power: if a US President can be deplatformed, anyone can

BIG TECH IS "ONE OF THE THREATS" TO DEMOCRACY

Leaders from around the globe condemned Twitter and Facebook for censoring President Trump after the Capitol building riot in January.

Even those who denounce Trump see the 'Big Tech' move as an attack on democracy.

German chancellor Angela Merkel called Twitter's permanent ban on Trump a breach of the "fundamental right to free speech". She believes governments should follow Germany's lead in devising laws against online incitement, rather than leaving social media platforms to take power into their own hands.

Faithwire reports that French Junior Minister Clement Beaune was "shocked" by the censorship. He argued: "This should be decided by citizens, not by a CEO. There needs to be public regulation of big, online platforms."

French finance minister Bruno Le Maire said the state should regulate the internet, not "the digital oligarchy", and that Big Tech is "one of the threats" to democracy.

Mexican President Andrés Obrador – no friend of Trump – mocked Twitter and Facebook as "the judge of the Holy Inquisition" and asked: "Where is the regulation? ... This is an issue of government. This is not an issue for private companies."

Russian opposition leader Alexei Navalny called the ban "an unacceptable act of censorship... Don't tell me he was banned for violating Twitter rules. I get death threats here every day for many years, and Twitter doesn't ban anyone."

"Why don't Twitter's community standards apply to the Ayatollah?"

Meanwhile, a right-wing alternative to Twitter called Parler has been suspended from Amazon's hosting service and by Apple and Google, allegedly for allowing users to incite violence. Parler describes itself as a free speech platform promoting equality and religious freedom. Parler CEO John Matze said: "This was a coordinated attack by the tech giants to kill competition in the market place."

Conservatives point out that



Various US states have imposed bans on churches meeting physically for worship during the pandemic, but Californian

churches have taken defiance of the measures to a new level. The Christian Post reports that two California megachurch pastors have temporarily registered their churches as strip clubs. The state has closed places of worship under Covid-19 regulations, while allowing strip clubs to stay open, so the pastors of Godspeak Calvary Chapel and Awaken Church removed their ties during their services in order to qualify.

Godspeak Calvary Chapel Pastor Rob McCoy said: "It's ridiculous to say that people are safer in a strip club than they are at church."

Many US churches have been fined thousands of dollars and taken to court for defying bans, while secular institutions have been allowed to remain open.

EU DEAL "SPITS IN THE FACE OF HUMAN RIGHTS"

An EU investment deal with China has been denounced by former Hong Kong governor Chris Patten.

International human rights think tank the Gatestone Institute claims that "European leaders have sacrificed their professed concern for human rights on the altar of financial gain."

Soeren Kern of the Institute says: "Precisely one week after the deal was signed, China launched a massive crackdown on democracy activists in Hong Kong."

The Comprehensive Agreement on Investment (CAI), agreed on 30 December, was negotiated by an EU elite of Angela Merkel, Emmanuel Macron, Ursula von der Leyen and Charles Michel of the European Council. Other EU countries were not involved.

Former Hong Kong Governor Lord Patten said: "It spits in the face of human rights and shows a delusional view of the Chinese Communist Party's trustworthiness on the international stage."

leftist organisations and extremist regimes have posted threats of violence on Twitter, yet Twitter took no action. Writing in Christianity magazine, David Robert-son said: "The tech companies state Trump and Parler were both banned because they do not meet 'community standards'. And yet Ayatollah Khamenei is still allowed to tweet 'Israel is a malignant cancerous tumour in the West Asia region that has to be removed and eradicated ... it will happen.' Why don't these 'community standards' apply to him?

HUNGARY DEFINES MARRIAGE AS HETEROSEXUAL

The Hungarian Parliament has changed the country's constitution to maintain marriage as the union of one man and one woman.

It is now expected that gay couples will not be allowed to adopt children, according to The Christian Post.

The amendment, passed by a majority of 134-45, reads: "Hungary protects the institution of marriage as the association between a man and a woman and the family as the basis for the survival of a nation."

The Parliament also defined gender as "biological sex based on primary sex characteristics and chromosomes".

Amnesty Hungary condemned the new laws as homophobic and transphobic.

Norway bans transgender 'hate speech' - even in your home

In a worryingly authoritarian move, Norway has expanded its law against criticism of transgenderism to private comments at home.

Reuters reports that Norwegians saying anything in private that is deemed to be hate speech against transgender people are liable for a fine or a year in jail. Public comments can be penalised with a three year sentence. Since 2016, Norwegians can

Since 2016, Norwegians can legally change their gender without a medical diagnosis.

NEWS NETWORK SMEARS Christian Charity

NBC, the oldest major radio and TV broadcaster in the US, has labelled a Christian pro-life charity a 'hate group', while defending a website which has carried child porn.

child porn. LifeSiteNews reports that NBC included the Ruth Institute among "anti-gay hate groups" in two reports in December. The Institute's President, Dr Jennifer Morse, said: "NBC's hypocrisy is sickening. While it smears the Institute and other pro-family organisations as 'hate groups', it defends PornHub, a major distributor of paedophilia videos."

Spain legalises euthanasia

Spain's parliament voted in December in favour of a bill allowing assisted suicide and euthanasia.

The law applies to those suffering from incurable diseases or unbearable permanent illnesses.

Neighbouring Portugal approved similar legislation in February 2020, and assisted dying is also legal in Belgium, Canada, Colombia, Luxembourg, Switzerland and the Netherlands.

Spanish law does not currently force health workers to participate if they conscientiously object.

IRISH TV SKETCH 'DEEPLY OFFENSIVE'

A comedy sketch has outraged Ireland's most senior Catholic priest.

Archbishop Eamon Martin said the mock news report on New Year's Eve was "insulting to all Catholics and Christians".

The satirical sketch depicted God being arrested for raping a "young middle-eastern migrant" and "impregnating her against her will".

The Archbishop condemned national broadcaster RTÉ for broadcasting something so "deeply offensive and blasphemous". RTÉ later apologised.

PARENTS, YOU CAN DO THIS!

Over recent decades Christian parents have become trying to address the urgent need in churches and alarmed at what their children are being taught in school. The intensity of secular humanist influence in the teaching profession has increased, whilst teachers who stand for traditional Christian values have been intimidated and marginalised. More recently, even the right of parents to remove their children from inappropriate lessons has itself been removed. But the fact he is now endorsing the World Economic Forum's (WEF) 'Great Reset' initiative, working with Klaus Schwab, the founder, brings him into another league. Does the heir to the throne have any real idea about what he is involved with?

Does Prince Charles have any idea what he is really involved with?

In his speech to an online WEF meeting on 5 June 2020, Prince Charles seems to be reading from a script as he exhorts us to understand that exhorts us to understand that "the pandemic has given us a chance to think big and act now". He says: "We only have a narrow window of opportunity." A narrow window of opportunity for what?

It is far more than noble measures to tackle climate change. I have been studying this for years and believe that the Great Reset involves nothing less than the complete reorganisation of the whole world's monetary system. In fact, this was confirmed by the managing director of the International Monetary Fund (IMF), Kristalina Georgieva, who said this is a "new Bretton Woods moment".

She is referring to a meeting of world leaders in Julv 1944 in a hotel in Bretton Woods, New Hampshire, who prepared to implement a new world monetary policy after World War 2 with the US dollar as the world's reserve currency.

With the impending failure of our current monetary system, now drowning in debt that can never be repaid, a new system is once again being prepared. But this time it is in line with the move towards a fully digital, Utopian world envisaged by Central Banks, the United Nations and the WEF.

The WEF, more widely known simply after its Swiss host town, Davos, has been meeting for over

50 years and is now attended by around 3000 participants from over 100 countries. This includes over 50 heads of state, major world leaders, the World Bank, the IMF, United Nations and the World Health Organisation. It also includes about 800 of the world's richest corporations, with Bill Gates from the Bill and Melinda Gates foundation and CEOs from Amazon, Microsoft and other major high-tech players.

Have you heard the slogan, "Build back better" recently? Joe Biden adopted it as his

campaign slogan and it has been repeated by world leaders including our own Prime Minister, Boris Johnson. This mantra is in line with the Utopian vision of the United Nations 2030 agenda, 'Building a more sustainable future', supported by the Pope.

It appears that the Covid-19 crisis has been very useful as far as the WEF is concerned. Indeed, Klaus Schwab has published a book this year called 'Covid-19: The Great Reset'. For some of us, it's quite a scary read.

Schwab asserts that the world will "never" return to normal, despite also admitting that coronavirus "doesn't pose a new existential threat."



E vangelist, speaker, and author David Hathaway has had many opportunities to trust God and he describes a few of them in his latest book, based on a series of messages he recorded during lockdown, specifically for the British Church.

He describes an occasion when he was invited to speak to Russian Holocaust survivors in Israel. They put a condition on him coming: "We will listen to you, if this Jesus will heal our sickness today". And by miracles, he did. This has been a hallmark of his 70 years ministering around the world.

And as a man of faith, Rev Hathaway is horrified at the way he sees the British Church acquiescing to defeatism. At the beginning of the book he challenges the Christians of Britain with the statement: "Never before in Britain have... people been ordered to spy and report their neighbours for breaches of the law! Never for more than 1000 years, even during two world wars, has there been an order from the government to close the churches. Incredibly, this order did not just come from the government, it also came from Church authorities.'

David Hathaway is now 88 and still preaching. His aim is to remind Christians that the apostle Paul wrote: "For the kingdom of God is not in word but in power." (1 Corinthians 4:20)

There was the time when he was diagnosed with throat cancer. The surgeon told him one Friday he would have to operate on his throat the following Monday.

The cancer had disappeared

When he went to the hospital on the Monday, and they did their final checks, the cancer had disappeared. The surgeon said to David he could see knife marks and wanted to know who cut the cancer out! David's answer was: "His name is Jesus".

David describes standing on God's Word when he was smuggling Bibles into Communist countries, when he was arrested and put in prison, when an assassination attempt was made on his life. Each time he saw God's power at work.

Any moans about the book? Only about the presentation

God is enforcing a Sabbath rest on the UK. The important thing about the Sabbath is that we each should have a regular day of rest every seven days, which should be included in shift patterns for essential and emergency workers who may have to be on duty at weekends. However since the

relaxation of Sunday trading rules on Friday 26th August 1994 and the start of major Covid restrictions on Monday 23rd March 2020, there have been 1335 Sundays (and 1335 Saturdays).

Saturdays). In 2 Chronicles 36:21, the Sabbaths denied set the duration of the punishment of Israel, 70 years, but not its nature. I believe a similar principle is applying at present. God is teaching us many things during this lockdown, which is an enforced Sabbath. I believe the duration of the discipline (but not necessarily its nature) has been set by the 1335 Sabbaths denied since the relaxation of Sunday trading law. The Methodist Church is no longer following the Wesleys

A preacher on upcoming changes to her church's doctrine on marriage

I foresee 2021 as a turning point for the Methodist Church in the UK.

Even before the coronavirus took hold, membership was in decline.

In 2019 a task group, appointed by the Methodist Conference, published a report entitled 'God in love unites us', containing recommendations to the Conference to change the definition of marriage, sanction cohabitation of couples, and encourage samesex marriage services to be held in our places of worship.

Many passages in the Bible will have to be reinterpreted to accommodate these changes, which will require the doctrines of the Methodist Church to be rewritten.

Such changes will inevitably cause division within congregations and their ministers, personal grief, anxiety and ultimately loss of membership. These farreaching changes have the potential of placing the future of the Church at risk. The government is not forcing the Church to take these steps, so is there a 'hidden agenda'?

Bible-believing Methodists will have to decide whether they believe the Bible is the Word of God or whether it can/should be reinterpreted to accommodate the 'modern' world. I attended a meeting where we were encouraged to embrace these recommendations. There, I realised the Methodist Church was no longer following the tenets laid down by the Wesley brothers of scriptural holiness, but was embracing what seemed to be more of a social/political gospel.

John Wesley wrote these words towards the end of his life: "Here I am; I and my Bible. I will not, I dare not, vary from this book either in great things or small. I have no power to dispense with one jot or tittle of what is contained therein."

Having studied the 'God in love unites us' report carefully, I knew I should write and



publish my own response. As a Bible-believing Christian I do not believe I have the luxury of being able to have my own opinion on these matters.

Ordained ministers who are unable to affirm this likely new doctrine will their livelihood, lose their accommodation and their pensions could be affected, their which is not an easy place to find oneself when there is a family to support. Local preachers may have to stand down.

Lessons for the C of E from Jeremiah

What would Jeremiah say about watering down Scripture?

In mainstream churches, we have seen a strongly fought battle over same-sex relationships and surrender to the sexual revolution.

And just as in Jeremiah's day, the secular and spiritual leadership have been cutting up bits of Scripture (Jeremiah 36)

When the C of E lectionary (the set readings for the church) did Revelation, it left out the sections warning readers as to the dire consequences of subtracting from that book! Who has the authority to leave out bits of God's Word?

So I was very disappointed when the Bishop of Manchester, speaking recently about forgiveness, failed to mention Jesus forgiving people, how he won forgiveness for us and how knowing how much we have been forgiven helps us forgive others, despite these points being in the C of E's set readings for that week! (Matthew 18:21-35)

We also see persecution of God's true spokesmen (Jeremiah 38:4). Stories are now circulating of clergy who hold orthodox views on sexuality, being told they are unwelcome in certain dioceses or being unfairly removed from positions. Where God's Word is faithfully preached, we very often see life and growth, as various surveys have shown.

Jeremiah called the people to repentance – when do we hear that in public today?

Jeremiah spent time in the counsel of the Lord (Jeremiah 23:18). One of the biggest changes I have seen in the past 40 years is the decline in prayer among


Beware deception in 2021

Jeremiah warned about judgement, but the religious establishment insisted no judgement would come (Jeremiah 23:16-18)

In one of his other books 'Shaping the future of the Fourth Industrial Revolution: a guide to building a better world' - Schwab speaks of 'stakeholder capitalism', which encompasses changing all the systems we take for granted today, from the way we produce and transport goods and services, to the way we communicate, the way we collaborate, and how we experience the world around us.

Schwab also hails the arrival of "implanted devices (that) will likely also help to communicate thoughts normally expressed verbally through a 'built-in' smartphone, and potentially unexpressed thoughts or moods by reading brain waves and other signals." Ostensibly useful for apprehending criminals, this has been interpreted as a future where people have their every movement tracked and every thought read by an implantable microchip.

"You'll own nothing and you'll never have been happier"

In other words, it's the management of the masses by a privileged elite, under the guise of knowing what's best for you better than you do. You may also have heard the

slogan, "You'll own nothing and you'll never have been happier", from an article written by Ida Auken, a young globalist leader and member of the Global Future Council on Cities and Urbanisation of the World Economic Forum. (Forbes magazine, November 2016)

Forbes magazine also reported on 14 January that Bill Gates is now the biggest owner of US farmland; he and other billionaires such as Amazon's Jeff Bezos are buying up huge swathes of farmland while preparing millions to own nothing.

It is clear that the WEF is guiding and leading the world towards a dystopian future and there is a need to seriously study their future plans.

Firstly, the plans of Klaus Schwab and others working with those in the high-tech world like Elon Musk and Ray Kurzweil, the chief engineer at Google, who are intent on fusing the physical, digital and biological world together. Some fear this will lead to transhumanism.

Secondly, Schwab's plans in working alongside the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation where, together, they staged a high-level pandemic tabletop exercise, 'Event 201' (18 October 2019). It was designed to 'play out' how to manage a real worldwide coronavirus epidemic just a few weeks before the real Covid-19 crisis hit the world.

Thirdly, to consider the involvement of the Bill and Melinda Gates Foundation and GAVL the Global Alliance for Vaccines and Immunisation, which Gates founded. He recently stated that the best investments he has ever made have been in the pharmaceutical industry and he is very keen to promote worldwide take-up of vaccines.

Fourthly, to consider the com-plexity of the WEF website's 'Strategic Intelligence Planner", which could only have been created over years of planning for worldwide influence. I believe it reveals the sinister intentions of those who believe they can reshape the world. Identity, 5G and artificial intelligence feature in the Fourth Industrial Revolution section. The fusion of your personal, financial and health identities are being trumpeted as a benefit, but of course the strings attached will be pulled by faceless high-tech entities.
