eing a soldier for me was everything; it was my very identity, my life. The military came first and my wife and marriage second.

But when I came back from my first tour in Iraq, I was not the same. I was unfaithful to my wife, became dependent on alcohol and made many silly, selfish choices.

Through a chain of events from leaving my wife to multiple relationships to serious drinking binges, I was on a path of self-destruction and trapped by the despair of depression. The internal grenade went off and I had a complete emotional and mental breakdown.



I was medically discharged from the military due to my broken state and serious attempts to take my own life.

I would hide behind the facade of being physically strong

Overnight I had gone from soldier to civilian and trying to fit into normal life was a battle. I would hide behind the facade of being physically strong, but truly I missed the structure and discipline of the regiment.

I missed the structure and discipline of the regiment

In fact, I was British Army born and bred; it was my identity. Born in Iserlohn British Military Hospital, Germany, into what you would call a typically dysfunctional British Forces family, I had followed my father into the RAF Regiment. I served over nine years as an infantry soldier and my job took me from the streets of Belfast to the desert of Iraq – when the trauma hit me.

The years after my discharge were a roller-coaster of trying to find myself. It took me through door security work, bodybuild-ing and truck driving to multiple relationships, all while battling despair, depression, suicidal thoughts and attempts on my own life.

in my mind. The battle was for my soul and my sanity. A lot of days I was losing the battle badly. I hated who I was, what I had done and what I had become.

It was in 2009 when I was at my lowest and on the way out of this life for good that God got hold of me and stepped into my life when I had no desire for him.

I certainly wasn't searching for religion or God

My wife took me to a modern church on an industrial estate near where we lived in Scotland. My only experiences of churches were of old traditional stone buildings and ministers who had the power to put you to sleep with their monotone voices. But this was completely unexpected. I certainly wasn't searching for religion or God, vet I was open to see what this was all about

Sitting there in my own thoughts, something came over me and I became extremely emotional for no reason. I felt wrapped up in a love and acceptance that I had never known before. For the first time in my life, I felt a belonging that

I had ever heard before, and he had my full attention. He told us why Jesus had come to earth, why he went to the Cross and paid for all our sins and how he offers us forgiveness, acceptance and eternal life.

When the pastor finished, he asked if anyone wanted to come forward and receive Jesus's invitation of forgiveness and salvation. Something inside me started to stir. It was as if my heart was encouraging me to go forward, but I wasn't ready to - I was fearful

On 4 October 2009 something happened to change me for ever

But after chatting with a couple called Roy and Ros who went to the church, Ros gave me one of her Bibles, and for the first time in my life I was truly keen to read it. That night I went home, opened that Bible and started to read. The following couple of weeks we both went to church meetings; something was really drawing me in and I couldn't get enough of it. Then on 4 October 2009 something happened to change me for ever.

I was in church, listening to another powerful message, when suddenly I felt Jesus was talking directly to me, as if I was the only person in the room.

He was calling me by name to come to him and receive his acceptance, his forgiveness and his love for me. This time I went forward and gave my life to Jesus. The blinkers had been removed, and for the first time

in my life I felt alive. I couldn't describe the joy I was feeling inside, but I knew it was real.

I came to know that God loves me so much, no matter what I have done, and that through Jesus I am forgiven, loved, accepted and adopted as his child. I was offered another chance - a completely new life. I accepted Jesus' offer of salvation so that I could come into relationship with Almighty God and call him Father and be his child.

Since giving my life to Jesus in 2009 it has not been an easy walk. Although it was my second wife who'd taken me to church, she didn't become a Christian and our marriage fell apart. But despite all the stumbling and blunders I have made, God has been faithful and walked with me each step of the way.

God has given me Julie, a Christian woman who has been my wife now for ten vears, and a stepson whom I love and treat as my own

I was freed from alcoholism and have been sober for over nine years. Through my journey with Jesus, he has restored to me what I lost and threw away.

I have two failed marriages behind me, a string of broken relationships, and the miscarriage of a child. But God has given me Julie, a Christian woman who has been my wife for ten years, and a stepson whom I love and treat as my own. God has also given me a good job; for the past eight years I've worked offshore as a steward on oil rigs.

I am free in his strength to let go of anger and offence

In all my faults and failures, God has used me to reach out to other broken men, speaking of Jesus and what he has done in my life and what he can do in others' lives if they will let him.

Jesus has shown me what it is to love others unconditionally and what it is to be loved unconditionally. But most importantly, he is teaching me to be able to like and love myself again.


God has used me to reach out to other broken men



10 million abortions in Great Britain



An embryo at 10 weeks gestation, still alive, aborted because a 44-year- old woman with six previous children was diagnosed with cancer of the womb

Right To Life UK report that a staggering 9,900,961 unborn children have lost their lives to abortion across England, Wales and Scotland since the practice was legalised in 1967. In 2020, more than one baby was lost to abortion every two and a half minutes.

Over 1 in 4 (25.2%) pregnancies in England and Wales now end in abortion, according to the most recent government statistics.

Right to Life UK spokesperson Catherine Robinson said: "It is a national tragedy that 9,900,961 lives have been lost since the passing of the 1967 Abortion Act... Every one of these abortions represents a failure of our society to protect the lives of babies in the womb and a failure to offer full support to women with unplanned pregnancies."

Conversion therapy saga continues

A ban on conversion therapy was included in the Queen's Speech in May for the second time, but Christian groups warn it could turn into "an LGBT blasphemy law".

After the government flipflopped on plans for the ban – first dropping the idea and then U-turning after a furious reaction from the gay lobby – the proposal was included in the legislative agenda.

The government once again claims that the everyday work of churches will not be affected. However, several Christian groups warn that consensual conversations about identity, Bible studies and prayer could still be outlawed if the ban goes ahead.

Let Us Pray, which campaigns against church work being included in the ban and is backed by The Christian Institute, said the proposed bill could turn into "an LGBT blasphemy law, criminalising the mere expression of opinions".

Let Us Pray spokesman Simon Calvert questioned the need for the ban, since a leaked government memo "confirmed that LGBT people are already protected by existing law". He said: "Pursuing this bill seems to be more about placating angry backbenchers than addressing an actual gap in the law."

The leading Anglican anti-conversion therapy activist, Jayne Ozanne, wants prayer about sexual orientation banned and Calvert says that Humanists UK "even want to widen the ban to include 'repentance' – a core Christian practice".

Conversations about identity, Bible studies and prayer could still be outlawed

A protest against the ban by those who have benefited from changing their sexual orientation, called X-Out Loud, is organised for 28 May in Westminster. X-Out Loud's Dr Elene Haralambous says: "It's so important right now that we keep the pressure on the UK government to understand that there are a group of people who have come out of LGBT lifestyles, and to keep the door open to those who have unwanted same-sex attraction and gender confusion, and do everything to oppose this ideological ban.'

Labour mayor calls Franklin Graham 'hate preacher'

Despite US evangelist Franklin Graham being called a 'hate preacher' by the Mayor of Liverpool, thousands of people attended Liverpool's Exhibition Centre on 14 May to hear him preach the Gospel.

The free event marked the first leg of his God Loves You Tour – a re-launch of the campaign he had originally planned for 2020. In that year, the venues he had been due to speak at cancelled his

en due to speak at cancelled his bookings after activists complained about his past comments on homosexuality and extremist Islam.

However, the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association (BGEA) took legal action, claiming Graham had been discriminated against, and won every case. Reporting on the cancellations in 2020, this paper pointed out

that the same venues were closed by the Covid m e a s u r e s shortly afterwards, thus losing huge amounts of income. This time,

Liverpool Mayor Steve Rotherham tried to ban bus adverts for the tour and called Graham a "known hate preacher". Yet when Blackpool Council removed his bus adverts following similar complaints, the Council had to issue an apology and pay compensation after being taken to court by the BGEA.

BGEA told Premier News that 2,000 churches across the UK are supporting the tour. After Liverpool, Graham was due to visit South Wales, Sheffield and London – unless protests again cause cancellations.

The BGEA won every case

The BGEA said: "Despite efforts to mischaracterise Rev Graham as a 'hate preacher' he has made it clear that he is coming to the UK with one purpose—to share a message of God's love for all people."

Pastor who warned against Pride events wins case

World falling apart or coming together By Tony Pearce

If you put together the current global symptoms of war, impending famine and financial meltdown, we have the signs of the falling apart of society prophesied in the Bible for the last days of this age.

The veteran philosopher and political activist, Noam Chomsky, wrote in April's edition of the Spectator magazine: "We're approaching the most dangerous point in human history... We are now facing the prospect of destruction of organised human life on earth."

World falling apart

The most obvious present threat is the war in Ukraine and the terrible destruction it has brought.

The Russian invasion, and NATO's response, have brought the global security order to the brink of collapse, with a danger of nuclear war.

At the same time it has added to the worldwide food crisis by removing a significant amount of grain from the world market, while droughts, floods, heatwaves and unusually cold weather in places have affected food production around the world. An avian flu plague has been destroying millions of chickens and turkeys, yet globalist planners

yet globalist planners are reducing agricultural production to meet their zero carbon goals. Russia's invasion of Ukraine and NATO's response have brought the global security order to the brink of collapse, with a danger of nuclear war- but it's the fulfilment of Bible prophecy



Prices of food and energy are skyrocketing, driving millions into poverty with a prospect of hunger and starvation in many parts of the world and a breakdown of industrial production in others, leading to social unrest. All this could bring famine to many parts of the world by 2023.

The massive debts built up by western economies since the global debt crisis of 2008 have been added to by the Covid lockdowns and the Ukraine war. This could lead to an economic meltdown in the coming year. There is a worldwide environmental

crisis

with potentially devastating results for people living in the areas affected.

This does not take God by surprise, though. In Jeremiah 25.31-33 we read: "Behold, disaster shall go forth from nation to nation, and a great whirlwind shall be raised up from the farthest parts of the earth. And at that day the slain of the Lord shall be from one end of the earth even to the other end of the earth."

In answer to the disciples' question, "What will be the sign of your coming, and of the end of the age?" Jesus replied: "For nation will rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom. And there will be famines, pestilences, and earthquakes in various places. All these are the beginning of sorrows" (Matthew 24:3.7-8). Wars, famines, plagues and natural disasters are all on the increase, causing us to see the 'beginning of sorrows' period. Another word for 'sorrows' here is 'birth pangs' - and birth pangs only increase in frequency and severity.

Jesus goes on to say that this will lead to the great tribulation: "For then there will be great tribulation, such as has not been since the beginning of the world until this time, no, nor ever shall be. And unless those days were shortened, no flesh would be saved; but for the elect's sake those days will be shortened" (Matthew 24:21-22). If God did not intervene to stop this time it would lead to the end of life on earth. But he will intervene with the return of the Lord Jesus in power and glory to judge

the world in righteousness and bring an end to human mismanagement of the planet God gave us to look after (Matthew 24:29-31).

At some stage in this process the Lord will take true believers out of the world in the event known as the 'Rapture of the Church' (1 Thessalonians 4-5). This is another debatable issue, which I will not get into here, except to say that we need to be ready now for the Lord's return at any time (Matthew 24:36-44) and be ready to suffer for our faith if called to in the days to come.

World coming together

One of the significant developments in current world events is the number of influential voices calling for some kind of world government along the lines proposed by UN Agenda 30 and the World Economic Forum's (WEF) 'Great Reset'.

The world is on the brink of a dramatic change, which will bring an end to the traditional system of money

In his 2019 book 'Covid 19 – the Great Reset', the WEF's Chairman, Prof Klaus Schwab, said: "This pandemic represents a rare but narrow opportunity to reflect, reimagine and reset our world."

He stated that things will never return to normal after the pandemic, but that the world should work for a new order which will "only come about

through some form of effective global governance." He repeated this call for a one

world government as soon as possible in a speech on the opening day of the World Government Summit in Dubai in March 2022, where he called for world leaders to unite to address global issues such as climate change, trade, and economic disruption. The programme required for this must accelerate the changes to 'zero carbon', by reducing, then eliminating, the use of fossil fuels. Coupled with this is a proposal to bring in something called 'ESG scores' (environmental, social and governance factors) that would monitor and record people's use of energy, with the power to cut off those who use too much.

The keynote session of the summit was called "A new world order".

Goodbye cash

At the same conference, Dr Pippa Malmgren said that the world is on the brink of a dramatic change, which will bring an end to the traditional system of money and accounting and invent a new one. This will eliminate cash and bring in Central Bank Digital Currencies (CB-DCs), a fully digital system connected to blockchain technology run by the world's central banks.

A new report from the Bank for International Settlements estimates that up to 90% of national central banks are at least in the planning stages for launching central bank digital currencies (CBDCs), while work on retail CBDCs – ie how you'll pay for purchases - is now advanced.

This will eliminate cash and bring in a fully digital system

These will be able to monitor every financial transaction we make from buying a house to a cup of coffee, tracked by a new form of digital ID which would include your vaccine status, and would be required for access to bank accounts, social media and internet use, and would also monitor your ESG score. This digitalised system has the potential to be able to identify anyone on earth.

The WHO's proposed treaty

The World Health Organisation (WHO) has launched an international Pandemic Treaty which could impose more restrictive and legally binding pandemic policies on its 194 member nations. This gives them power over the national sovereignty

of member states, and by impli-cation, the civil liberties and health rights of their citizens.

It has the potential to bring in a "new global public health world order", giving the WHO the sole right to declare a global pandemic and thereafter impose restrictions upon trade and travel between nations.

The WHO's powers would include imposing lockdowns, medical surveillance, testing and mandatory vaccinations, also the right to censor and cancel any opposing voices to this programme. This treaty would inject a new supra-national global governance structure on the world in times of what we are being told is an inevitable, future pandemic or declared global health emergency.

Hacking humans

Yuval Harari is an Israeli technology guru who is a key advisor



to the WEF with a great deal of influence in its programmes and a frequent speaker at its events.

He is openly anti-God, stating

that the Bible is fiction, there is no God in the universe and the story of Jesus rising from the dead is fake news. Here are some quotes from his

speeches: "The current global emer-gency is creating the conditions

when people might be willing to accept the changes required. In emergencies people trust scientists. not God.

"During Covid Israel closed synagogues, Iran even closed mosques, and church leaders said 'Don't come to church.'

"Why? Because scientists tell them to. In this time of crisis you have to follow science. It is said you should never allow a good crisis to go to waste, because a crisis is an opportunity to do reforms that in normal times people will never agree to. In a crisis you have no choice so let's do it. The vaccine will help us.

"People will look back in a hundred years and recognise that the coronavirus was a time when a new regime of surveillance took over, especially surveillance under the skin. Governments want to know what is going on under our skin, to col-



lect biometric data and understand people better than they understand themselves.

"The potential of AI is much bigger than any historical revolution. It's really a biological revolution. Now we can give them the tools to start changing or overcoming biology. Humans are hackable animals.

The whole idea that humans have this soul or spirit and free will and nobody knows what's happening inside me so whatever I choose in the elections or in the supermarket this is my free will – that's over. To-day we have the technology to hack human beings on a massive scale. This is the most important development of the 21st century.

"We need some kind of global identity and global loyalty.

"Humans are hackable animals"

"This raises the question, what do we need humans for or what do we need so many humans for? Earth can be populated or dominated by entities that are not organic, that do not breed and don't have emotions. By hacking the organism, science can gain the power to engineer the power of life itself.

"In the coming decades AI and biotic life forms will give us godlike ability to re-engineer life and even create completely new life forms. We are about to enter a new era of inorganic life shaped by intelligent design - our intelligent design. We will be upgrading humans, developing bigger powers, upgrading humans into gods.

Harari admits that this process might enable human elites to "build digital dictatorships... Once human life is hacked, the hackers will maintain control over life itself

Babel and the Second Comina

This sounds like a weird sci-fi script, but very intelligent and powerful people are taking it seriously. It reminds me of the Tower of Babel in Genesis 11 where we read how humanity came together as one, to "make a name for ourselves" and "build a tower reaching up to heaven.

And the Lord said: "Indeed the people are one and they all have one language, and this is what they begin to do; now nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them.

to turn them into 'gods' in our own image is really asking for trouble from the God who made us in his image

This project was done in rebellion against God, so the Lord came down to scatter them and confuse their languages. God sees the danger of AI and the human potential movement, when he says: "Nothing that they propose to do will be withheld from them.'

Hacking humans and trying to turn them into 'gods' in our own image is really asking for trouble from the God who made us in his image. The fact that people are seriously considering this as a possibility is another reason why the Lord has to return soon to save us from ourselves.

All this is a sign of human rebellion against God's created order, as globalists try to bring the world together in a 'digital dictatorship' backed by technology with 'surveillance under the skin.'

In Revelation 13 we read of the world government of the 'Beast', given power by the devil and born witness to by the 'False Prophet' who brings in the 666 system to control people's ability to buy and sell: "He causes all, both small and great, rich and poor, free and slave, to receive a mark on their right



hand or on their foreheads, and no one may buy or sell except one who has the mark or the name of the beast, or the number of his name. Here is wisdom. Let him who has understanding calculate the number of the beast. for it is the number of a man: his number is 666" (Revelation 13:16-18).

At the same time we see forces of destruction causing this 666 system to fall apart in chaos and confusion.

Ultimately both these trends are preparing the way for the glorious event which will bring an end to this age - the Second Coming of Christ. Jesus said: "When you see these things begin to happen, look up, lift up your heads for your redemption draws near" (Luke 21:28).

Maranatha! Jesus is coming.





PREPARING FOR 'THE MOTHER OF ALL ECONOMIC COLLAPSES' WHY WE NEED A JOSEPH GENERATION By Chris Wickland

This is the time to prepare wisely, in faith and expectancy, for economic famine – AND miracles – because they'll be needed



We have all heard plenty of warning prophecies regarding the days ahead.

I too have given such warnings, because over the last 30 years God has given me dreams and prophetic warnings about the time to come – and the mother of all economic collapses. A great depression is on its way, yet God has repeatedly said to me, "It will be the worst of times and the best of times."

One doesn't need to be prophetic anymore to see that the world is heading for a serious financial downturn, crash or depression.

We know that the days ahead will be tough, but it's all too easy to opt out spiritually, thinking that the Church is doomed and we'll just sit this out until Jesus returns.

I believe that God doesn't want his Church to be unaware and unprepared. He wants his Church to be a light to the Gentiles, so we need to be prepared practically for economic famine, but also for miracles.

As a church we have bought food with a long shelf life and I have encouraged our members to start putting by several months' worth of food for themselves and their neighbours. We were also given an acre of land to grow vegetables and reaped an abundant harvest, which seemed miraculous because the only fertiliser we used was prayer! As I sowed, I prayed repeatedly, "God, bless this seed". (See the April/May issue of HEART for the full story and photos).

In fact, when Jesus said, "When I return will I find faith on the earth?" (Luke 18:8), he is not talking about the Christian faith, but about finding believers who are still believing!

So we have to ask ourselves some very important questions for the days ahead:

"Do I believe in a God of miracles?" Because miracles will be needed!

"Do I believe God can and will do miracles?"

"If God is immutable (unchanging) will he no longer be the God of miracles in the days ahead?"

The calling to be a Joseph

In the days ahead we need to thrive, not just survive. Like Joseph, our storehouses must be full both spiritually and practically.

Thirty-seven years ago, before

I was a Christian, I had my first ever prophetic dream which showed me how the hand of God had divinely protected me and how he was leading me to a specific purpose. The dream ended with me being a high prince of Egypt, wearing very ornate clothing denoting rank with a title hovering over my crown which read, 'Master of Dreams.' I knew this dream was very significant, but as I had no religious upbringing, I had no idea who the high prince of Egypt

who the high prince of Egypt was. Many years later I realised the dream was about Joseph and how he would save Israel from a terrible drought.

For many years I have held this dream and other Joseph dreams in my heart, knowing that my primary purpose as a Christian was always to help the Church during a time of severe financial famine by raising a Joseph generation for the days ahead. Well, those days are now here and they are here to stay.

No government can help

Governments will soon fail us; they will not be able to help so many when so much will be lost. Our God is really the only source of help and refuge in a time of need. We need to be full of God's wisdom and faith, not fear or super-spirituality. The super-spiritual claim that God will sort everything out, but don't pray to find out what they need to do practically.

Take courage that in days of famine we shall be satisfied

During the time of Covid many people claimed the promises of Psalm 91 as a source of comfort, but in this new period Psalm 37:18-19 should be our key verse:

"The Lord knoweth the days of the upright and their inheritance shall be forever. They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and in the days of famine they shall be satisfied."

The "Lord knows the days of the upright" has multiple meanings, but one of the primary ones is that God has known what will befall his people throughout history.

God is intimately acquainted with the ways of the righteous. He is aware of all our circumstances long before we are aware. In fact, God knew our days before they even began

(Psalm 139:16).

Knowing that God already has it covered should lead us into his 'shalom' – the place of peace, where we experience a river of joy. But we must access this place by faith, by resting in the fact that God knows our days and has thus pre-determined all our needs before we are even aware of them. Take courage that in days of famine we shall be satisfied.

Romans 8:28: "And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are called according to his purpose."

2 Corinthians 5:7: "For we walk by faith and not by sight."

Jesus rebukes little faith. He's not interested in just enough faith to get you to heaven when you die. He wants and needs his people, his Church, his mystical body on the earth to do great exploits for him.

Our carnal wisdom and intellect are not going to cut it when it comes to believing in God for a miracle, especially in the way of provision. We need to dust off those old books on faith which we put away and start practising living by faith again. I know living by faith is challenging, but it's a lot more fun than boring mediocrity.

Maybe today, as God's holy Church, we can start doing what it says on the tin by being 'believers.' and not 'doubters.'

Fear, doubt and unbelief will cost us dearly in the days ahead. Let's stop being worldly and start being godly and 'imitate God as dearly beloved children.' (Ephesians 5:1). Let's walk by faith and not by sight. Don't let your theology or the world steal your joy, for the Kingdom of God is righteousness, peace and joy (Romans 14:17). In June 2007 an angel came to

In June 2007 an angel came to me in my bedroom as I was falling to sleep. He spoke to me audibly and said, "On 18 September something is going to happen which will be really bad for the UK economy."

As the angel spoke, his words were written across my eyes like a retina burn from a bright light. This was so I wouldn't forget what he said or the date.

Sure enough, on 18 September a series of events took place which caused a chain reaction for the near collapse of Royal Bank of Scotland, Northern Rock, the collapse of the Icelandic bank, plus Bear Stearns and Fannie Mae and Freddie Mac in the US. Then in October 2007 the American stock market crashed by 777.77 points.

It led Britain and the rest of the world into a strong but shortlived recession in 2008. The 2007-8 financial crash was a small blip compared to what is still to come and in-deed it has now already begun in 2022, again on a worldwide scale.

The coming collapse will be of gargantuan proportions. However, the Church is called to thrive in this season. We are to be the solution to the world's problem.

I learned some valuable lessons from the 2007 crash that God revealed to me. When everyone around me was suffering from wage cuts and job losses, I was prospering. As a self-employed

musician, 2007-2008 were the best financial years I had ever had! All my musician friends were losing revenue hand over fist, but I just kept prospering. Psalm 37:18-19 says: "The

Psalm 37:18-19 says: "The Lord knoweth the days of the upright and their inheritance shall be forever. They shall not be ashamed in the evil time, and IN THE DAYS OF FAMINE THEY SHALL BE SATISFIED."

Why did I keep prospering when others didn't? Simple, I live by Kingdom economics. I tithe (give away ten per cent) all my income before tax and I give more on top of that because I know that my God supplies all my needs according to his riches in Christ Jesus (Philippians 4:19).

Now for a vital warning:

Please read that again.

Isaac sowed according to the promise God had given him

And please read Genesis 26:1 and Genesis 26:12-14. Here we see Isaac in a foreign land sowing seed in a time of famine. God blessed his crops and he got a 100-fold return.

However, there are some subtle spiritual principles at play here, because Isaac sowed precious seed which he and his family needed to eat into soil that was bone dry from famine. This would seem insane to

many – why sow good seed into

GOD'S PROVISION

How God provided a church building worth over £1m and gave us our best financial year during Covid

Both as a church leader and personally, I have witnessed the importance of sowing and reaping in the area of God's provision. I believe that some of the results have happened in order to encourage people and make them aware of the miraculous way that God will provide for his Church in the days ahead.

Last year I gave my lovely Peugeot 3008 to my son due to my health issues. However, I knew that if I sowed a car I would reap a car. Because the spiritual law states, "you reap what you sow".

My motive, though, was not impure; I gave my car away as a gift of love to my son – I didn't 'give to get'!

didn't 'give to get'! Six months later, in March 2022, I started praying for a replacement car, simply believing that God would answer my prayer and honour the seed sown.

A week later I met a Christian friend who came up to me and said she wanted to purchase a new car for me.

New church building

Four years ago our church gave a gift to another congregation which needed money to construct their new building. We gave it to bless them, but also as a seed for our own potential building.

Two years later, while meeting another local pastor for coffee, he announced that he wanted to give me his church.

Initially I thought he meant his congregation, but he actually wanted to give us their building which was valued at £1.2million!

So two weeks before the Covid lockdown, the building was transferred to Living Word Church Network. It was a literal Godsend.

Without it, I doubt we would

soil that simply wasn't going to grow anything? However, Isaac was living according to spiritual principles, not common sense or the wisdom of earthly-minded man.

Some Christians do not tithe or give offerings if they are in a bind financially. But Isaac didn't sow according to the natural conditions; he sowed according to the promise God had given him.

In Genesis 26:3-4, the key word to note here is 'seed' (or

have survived as a network at that time. Not only were we given the church building, but they also gave us tens of thousands to put in new heating and fire alarm systems.

This was an outrageous miracle of God's grace and provision. It is also a testament to very godly Christians who entrusted us with their building. It was passed on to them many years previously and now they wanted to pass it on to the next generation.

Best financial year

As a church network we understand that giving is an essential key to our growth and blessing and tithe all our income.

The Covid lockdowns of 2020 and 2021 were a very difficult time for us as a church logistically and relationally, yet God made a way where there was no way. We held church services in an open field on a farm, where we never took an offering and never asked for money. We actually made it difficult for people to give into our network!

Moreover, we lost half of our congregation and gained the same number back.

Yet we had a financial miracle – they were two of our best years financially! What an extraordinary sign of God's goodness!

If we live according to the Kingdom principles of Scripture, then we reap the benefits of doing it God's way. Living a life of obedience to God's Word is the pathway to blessing and miracles.

That's not a great quote, it's a fact. We serve a wonder-working, powerful, miraculous, generous God. Hallelujah, his Name be praised.

offspring in some translations). Obviously we know that 'seed' here refers to offspring – but Isaac is applying it literally to his seed sown in the ground. God promised to multiply his seed and that's exactly what happened.

Let me leave you with this verse from 2 Corinthians 9:10: "Now may he who supplies seed to the sower, and bread for food, supply and multiply the seed you have sown and increase the fruits of your righteousness."

Who closed the churches?

Chris Wickland told the Solent Prophetic Gathering on 6 May that God had forewarned him of the Covid church closures on 28 November 2019: "He told me, 'Something is coming that will shut down every church. It's an attack of the enemy to shut down praise and worship'. Next day, I suffered a cardiac arrest and died."

His wife Tracey mobilised prayer and posted the news on Facebook, which went viral. Chris said: "It went around the world – people recognised that the enemy had overreached himself." (See HEART's Feb/ Mar 2020 issue for the story of how prayer resurrected Pastor Chris and prevented his having permanent brain damage).

Later he was one of 130 pastors who sued the government with Christian Concern over the church closures before the government backed down: "When the Church thought it was being compliant by closing, it was actually illegal."

Nonetheless, Pastor Dennis Greenidge, leader of Worldwide Mission Fellowship told participants at the Dovetailshalom Esther fast in April: "It was God who closed the churches. He'd had enough!"

Similarly, Dave Borlase, when leader of Intercessors for Britain in 2020, wrote in this paper: "God closed the churches because he couldn't think of a single reason to keep them open." Lack of concern over Britain's gruesome abortion statistics was one reason Dave cited.

GARDNER'S WORLD FATHER, FORGIVE US! **Church of England repents over anti-Semitic past**

Much of the blame for the current Middle East conflict should be laid squarely at the door – not Jewish hearts were hardened of Israel, but the Church.

t is wholly appropriate, therefore, that the Church of England held a service of repentance for historic anti-Semitism at Oxford Cathedral on 8 May.

In 1222 humilitating anti-Jewish laws were passed

For it was at the Synod of Oxford in 1222 (800 years ago) that humilitating anti-Jewish laws were passed which ul-timately led to the expulsion of Jews from England in 1290. Nearly 400 years passed before they were welcomed back by Cromwell.

The move to hold the service follows the Anglican Church's 2019 document, 'God's Unfail-ing Word' which acknowledged the Church's role in fostering anti-Semitic feeling, especially timely amidst an exponential rise in this shocking form of racism.

Another significant step forward has been the recent launch in Rochester Cathedral of a new form of liturgy for Jewish followers of Jesus which fully acknowledges the context of their culture. The expectation that such believers should deny their traditions and be absorbed into a Gentile 'Christian' environment has at last been cast aside.

Anglican mission CMJ (the Church's Ministry among the Jewish people) has clearly had a hand in this development, having already followed this policy for over 200 years.

The cause of Church-based anti-Semitism was not just our sinful, hateful hearts, but bad theology going all the way back to the second century, now acknowledged in part by the established Church.

It was shortly after the Apos-tles died that the so-called 'Church Fathers' began the process of disassociating Christianity from its Judaic foundations by marking the Sabbath on a different day and separating Passover from Easter.

Yes, the Jewish leaders did conspire to crucify Christ, but the other side of the same coin is that it was meant to happen, as Jesus was the ultimate Passover Lamb sacrificed for the sins

of both Jew and Gentile (see Isaiah 53:10). In that sense, we are all responsible for nailing him to the Cross.

for a time so that Gentiles too could taste the sweet salvation of sins forgiven

St Paul explains how Jewish hearts were hardened for a time for our sakes so that Gentiles too could taste the sweet salvation of sins forgiven. (Romans 11:25)

But God, as a loving Father, still loves his ancient people (see Jeremiah 31:3) and there is coming a day when "all Israel" will acknowledge their Messiah (Romans 11:26).

Indeed, there is coming a time when Jerusalem will no longer be trampled upon by Gentiles in fulfilment of Jesus' prophecy (Luke 21:24). There are parts of the city - particularly the Temple Mount – still under Gentile

(Jordanian) control. But this will soon end, which is why there is such a furious battle over this piece of real estate.

It is, after all, God's 'holy mountain' (Psalm 48:1, Ezekiel 43:6f) – but the devil, the 'prince of this world', is holding on to it for as long as he can. However, King Jesus is coming to reign from this mount and idolatry will cease as he sets up his Kingdom for a thousand years.

The distancing from Judaism encouraged by the likes of Constantine and the Church Fathers went hand in hand with the heretical notion that Christians had replaced Israel in God's affections. This effectively meant that wherever we read 'Israel' in the Bible, we should think 'Church'.

Such denial of the Father's love for Jews spread like cancer through Christ's 'body' on earth and also infected much of the political realm. Luther was an obvious example of this, with his anti-Semitic writings providing the religious defence for Nazism 400 years later.

Julius Streicher cited Luther's book 'The Jews and their Lies' as part of his defence at the Nuremberg Trials, declaring: "Dr Martin Luther would very probably sit in my place in the defendants' dock today if this book had been taken into consideration by the prosecution

But as in all things in God's world, there is a strong correlation between the physical and the spiritual. Denying God's favour for the Jewish people will inevitably lead to denial of their right to the land, which is the default position of so many churches today. God's plan in spite of the plethora of Scriptures referring to it.

Jeremiah, who repeatedly castigated his people for their idolatry, nevertheless prophesied that their return from the far corners of the earth would be a greater miracle than the crossing of the Red Sea (Jeremiah 16:14f).

Charles Spurgeon, John Wesley and Bishop J C Ryle were among the great evangelical preachers of the past who clearly saw this.

If you are a Bible believer, Jewish entitlement to the land of Israel is surely a given. And

when they are back in the land, according to Ezekiel, they will also turn back to the Lord as they are given a 'new heart' (Ezekiel 36:24-26).

The Good Samaritan parable could well apply to organisations today such as Christian Friends of Israel who are busy dressing the wounds of the

injured victim on the roadside while many religious people walk by on the other side.

We have also been slow to follow the example of the Germany-based Evangelical Sisters of Mary who have led services of repentance since the end of World War 2.

Britain has yet to formally apologise for the 1939 White Paper that severely restricted Jewish immigration to the Holy Land (then under our jurisdiction), thus preventing their escape from the Nazi death camps. That was a truly shameful period of British history. It's time we returned the

It's time we returned the favour the Jewish people lavished on us with their precious Scriptures, their patriarchs, their prophets and their Saviour. For everything we do, or fail to do, hinges on our response to a Jew, whose name is Jesus.

ful and shameful" history, with the synod's decision shaping the entire medieval Church in Europe in contributing to the teaching of contempt for Jews.

As Christians, he said, they were there to remember and to repent, adding: "As Christians and Jews together, we are here to rebuild."

In a very moving ceremony liberally infused with powerful music, along with choral renditions sung in Hebrew, the bishop made it clear that the God of Israel is the one "whom Christians also believe to be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ".

Jewish scholar and author Rebecca Abrams, who outlined the decisions of the historic synod, noted how "unimaginable" this service would have been in medieval England.

Leading the 'Act of Penitence', Rt Rev William Kenney

(Roman Catholic bishop emeritus) pointed out how Jesus often quoted the Torah (the first five books of the Bible, foundational to Judaism) in his teaching, and acknowledged with shame and penitence" the synod's decrees. Rabbi Dr Jonathan Romain read a passage from Leviticus 19 in Hebrew

and said afterwards: "I think the Jews of 1222 would have been astonished to hear Hebrew ring out in this cathedral."

And Archdeacon of Oxford, Ven Jonathan Chaffey, spoke of the "profound significance" of a ceremony dealing with "penitence for all acts of anti-Semitism and religious persecution".

This service, along with the 'God's Unfailing Word' report which also addressed this issue, had been strongly advocated in recent years by Love Never Fails, an umbrella organisation for a number of support groups like Christian Friends of Israel, Ebenezer Operation Exodus and the Church's Ministry among Jewish People (CMJ).

After the repentance service, a prayer gathering in Blue Boar House nearby was led by Pastor Phil Herklots on behalf of the Oxford churches. More than 100 believers from all over the UK prayed for

blessing and healing upon the Jewish people, and for further repentance for replacement theology in the British Church.

ISRAEL "WILL CEASE TO EXIST" ON 8 JULY

Many Muslims are convinced that the state of Israel will cease to exist on 8 July, 2022, which is leading to a spate of murders and stabbings in Israel.

According to Israeli Messianic commentator Amir Tsarfati, Iranian mullahs are inciting violence in Israel because they believe that this year saw the last Ramadan before Israel is eliminated.

Security in Israel now is much weaker than it was under the Netanyahu government, with 11 Israelis murdered by Arab Muslims in terror attacks in just over a week.

The perpetrators had been told this was their last opportunity to win the Muslim martyr's reward of 144 virgins in 'paradise'.

What's more, Naftali Bennett, the new Israeli Prime Minister has advised all Israelis who hold gun permits to be armed whenever they leave the house.

Knife-wielding man was'looking for a Jew to kill'

A £10,000 reward has been offered for information that could lead to the conviction of a knife-wielding man who attacked a Jew in London.

After threatening his victim with the words, "You are Jewish; I am going to kill you," the attacker fled and the police only arrived when it was all over.

The incident took place near West Hampstead tube station during the Jewish festival of Chanukah last year. The culprit was tearing down a Chanukah display and screaming anti-Semitic abuse when he saw the victim and said he was "looking for a Jew to kill" in an apparent reference to a saying of Muhammed that the end times will not come until Muslims kill Jews.

Those who have been warning about the possible impact of this tradition have been denounced as 'Islamophobes'. But now the Campaign Against Anti-Semitism is offering a reward in the hopes of catching the perpetrator.

Robert Spencer, of the Front Page Magazine, said: "We were trying to alert the world to this risk nearly 15 years ago. And in the near future, there are certain to be many other examples of how right we were to call attention to this and how short-sighted and ultimately suicidal for the West the Left's approach has been and continues to be. But the suicide of the West may be what Leftists have wanted all along."

Death chants go unpunished

Not a single arrest has been made (by 24 April) in connection with seven anti-Israel demonstrations held in Britain last year at which death threats were chanted against Jews. But police have admitted that criminal charges could be brought. At each of the protests – over Israel's response to the indiscriminate launching of some 4,000 rockets by terror group Hamas – people were heard to chant (in Arabic) "Watch out Jews, remember Khaybar, the Army of Mohammed is returning".

The cry alludes to a series of seventh century battles in which a Mohammed-led Muslim army defeated Jews.

"We've been tracking this for years," said a spokesman for the Community Security Trust, committed to Jewish safety in the UK. "But the police remain deeply reluctant to make arrests in the middle of a demo and, so far, have only investigated after the event."

Yet the police and Crown Prosecution Service both admit that the use of this blatant threat constitutes a crime of incitement to racial hatred under Section 18 of the Public Order Act.

London University, meanwhile, is to host an event in July called 'Marxism 2022'. Its Queen Mary College will welcome speakers who have been embroiled in anti-Semitism scandals including former Labour leader Jeremy Corbyn.

'SILENCE' OVER SIZER

Controversial vicar Stephen Sizer is facing a new Clergy Discipline Measure, thought to relate to ongoing issues over his views on Israel.

He has vehemently denied repeated accusations of anti-Semitism, claiming that 'anti-Zionism' is not the same thing. But a full-page article in Evangelicals Now reflects the view of some that many 'conservative evangelical' leaders and bodies are largely silent on Israel's place in the world and have consistently failed to address concerns about Sizer's views and behaviour.

In 2015, Sizer apologised for posting a link on social media to an article claiming Israel was behind 9/11, later denying that he himself thought this was the case.

Matthew Mason, tutor in Christian ethics at the Pastors' Academy, has said that "ongoing silence simply will not do... Of course this is a Gospel issue. For if Jews do not count, there simply is no God, no Christ, no Gospel, no Church that is worthy of the name."

Heavily-armed Arabs pose serious danger

Retired army general Effi Eitam says Israel is facing a violent uprising among its Arab citizens ultimately aimed at dismantling the Jewish state. He said hundreds of thousands of weapons stolen from IDF bases and police stations are now in the hands of tens of thousands of Arabs, and that Israel is struggling to manage a hostile fifth column with enough firepower to pose a serious danger to national security.

Palestinian leaders 'the real criminals'

A former terrorist has exposed the Palestinian leadership as the real criminals in the conflict over Israeli territory.

In a letter to Israel Today, 47-year-old peace activist Mohammed Arif Massad said he had fought fiercely against Israel from the age of 13, but soon discovered that the Palestinian leadership wanted neither peace nor freedom because they profit from the war and destruction in their midst.



Miracle of Bucha - 120 Christians sheltering in a church spared

AS THE WAR IN UKRAINE GRINDS ON, STORIES ARE COMING OUT OF THE HAND OF GOD **POWERFULLY AT WORK AS PRAYERS ARE ANSWERED AND BELIEVERS REACH OUT**



I have just returned from visiting Ukraine in May, in order to gather Christian leaders from our network from across the country

Over the years it has been my privilege to travel literally the length and breadth of Ukraine teaching the Bible and building a national network of Christian and Messianic Jewish leaders from many different denominations. Today the One New Man Network includes hundreds of ministry leaders in every part of Ukraine, but I never thought for a moment that it would be used to bring the Kingdom of God to the front lines of a war.

They responded to the fighting by opening their homes, their churches, their fridges and their wallets to complete strangers

Yet God is never surprised, so when he spoke to one of our trustees in a dream to prepare for war, that is what we did. As soon as the war started on 24 February, we mobilised prayer

and support for Christian leaders in Ukraine who responded to the fighting by opening their homes, their churches, their fridges and their wallets to complete strangers. This is the Kingdom of God at its best in the face of unimaginable evil.

Pray for leaders like Rabbi Sergei whose home in Kyiv was completely destroyed by shelling and yet arranged for more than 100 believers to escape from Mariupol where they through the prayers of the saints miraculously passed unharmed through Russian checkpoints. Then Pastor there's Vadim whose team risk their lives rushing frontline into villages during pauses in the fighting to bring refugees out There's also Pastor Volodymyr, whose city is occupied by Russian troops and

despite other leaders being kidnapped by Russian troops still sneaks out to distribute aid to his community.

On my recent visit I met Pastor Alexi from Bucha, who told me that 120 people were hiding in the basement of his church when a Russian commander found them. This commander told them he would return and they would all be killed. Through the long weeks of

occupation, they waited and prayed, but nobody came. When they shared their stories and the name of the commander with the war crime investigators, these hardened men were shocked. This same commander had been

FROM EAST SUSSEX TO UKRAINE...VIA HOLLAND By Robin Benson

A small port on the Sussex coast is being used by God to benefit thousands of desperate people hundreds of miles away in the former Soviet Union

Within days of the Russian invasion, the Christian char-ity HRIF (Humanitarian Resources International Foundation) was in action sending containers across Europe on an almost daily basis to Ukraine and the surrounding nations, which have been taking in the millions of Ukrainian refugees.

This was nothing new for HRIF; its first shipment went to Ukraine in 1997. At the local level, aid is then distributed mainly through churches and synagogues.

Early on, the Polish government made an empty palace available to HRIF to assist with refugee support and onward processing.

HRIF was founded by Max Veenstra in Holland and partners with Christian business-

man Nevill Smith of Newhaven, East Sussex. Nevill and his late wife, Val, also established The Shekinah Legacy Trust, which supports Israel practically and in prayer. He has worked with Max since 2009 to support people suffering hardship, particularly Jewish people in Eastern Europe, as well

What in particular is in the booklet that you think non-Christians really need to know?


Andrew: I think there are some things in the booklet that even most Christians need to know.

as in Israel itself through a local partner organisation in the land.

As of May 2022, HRIF is distributing aid from Borislav (close to Lviv, in the west). Kiev and Zitomir have also been receiving containers, but due to the ongoing conflict less aid is currently able to reach these areas. Another hub has been opened in Tarnopol, enabling help to reach the Charkov region.

Similar distribution hubs are operating in the countries north, west and south of Ukraine, all supplied by containers driven from Holland on a daily basis, to provide much needed aid and comfort to the hundreds of thousands of traumatised Ukrainians who have fled their homes with little more than the clothes on their backs.

THE ROYAL FAMILY

The nation's Platinum Jubilee celebrations of Her Majesty's 70 years on the throne will inevitably highlight the Queen's physical frailty. Pray for her health; she

Pray for her health; she will be succeeded by a King who has endorsed the Great Reset (previously reported in this paper) and its environmental goals. Whether King Charles will be ready to "own nothing and be happy" is not known...

In 1952 the coronation service was Christian, with songs based on Scripture. While Prince Charles has, according to Christian Concern co-founder Ade Omooba, been misquoted over his desire to be 'Defender of Faith' (apparently the heir to the throne took 15 minutes to explain to Rev Omooba what he had actually meant), the clear adherence to Christianity as the state religion has already lapsed. A subscriber has pointed out that on 1991's Commonwealth Day, the Queen gave permission for the Koran and other books sacred to other religions to be read as part of the act of worship in Westminster Abbey.

The Queen has often referred to her own Christian faith in her Christmas messages; pray that her children and grandchildren will come to realise their need of a personal Saviour.

THE CHURCH

Pray for the Church in Britain to focus on the Great Commission: to seek and save the lost and to have faith to see people healed, rather than abrogating responsibility for healing to the authorities. May churchgoers recognise the lateness of the hour; prophet Tobi Arayomi said in 2021 there were nine years left of Church freedom; that would coincide with the UN's Agenda 2030 succeeding. Pray that Christians will re-

Pray that Christians will remember they are citizens of heaven and be ready to stand up for biblical values and not compromise out of fear: "The fear of man is a snare."

Author and house church planter Jason Carter is one of those who anticipates a Chinese-style 'State Church' emerging in Britain where politically correct preachers avoid addressing biblical morality. He also urged believers to ensure they have their own supply of 'oil' – a deep relationship with God, born out of full surrender and Bible knowledge – not just rely on their pastor.

He told a meeting on 21 May: "This is the time to build community as per the New Testament model across the UK and the world, to have a lifestyle of evangelism. Print and hand out your personal testimony."

EVIL LAWS AND TREATIES

"Forbid evil laws and treaties to be signed. Decry the evil actions of those in power. Do not be afraid. Stand together, for there are more with you, and more with me, than you can imagine...Cry out for justice together."

From a prophetic message received by Kathleen Mitchell on 19 May 2022 in Jerusalem, sent out by Pastor Jeff Daly of National Day of Repentance (www. repentday.com), three days before the WHO (World Health Organisation) met in Geneva to vote on the Biden administration's proposed amendments to the IHR (International Health Regulations), "which would essentially hand over sovereignty to the WHO."

Boris Johnson is among leaders who have already indicated their approval. Mat Staver, a lawyer and one of the US's National Prayer Assembly presenters, has warned: "The WHO, like the United Nations, has sovereign immunity from lawsuits. This means you cannot take the WHO to court when it infringes on your freedom, or when its "directives" (like mandatory jabs) injure you. The WHO has 194 member countries that control 99.94% of the world's population. The WHO launched international vaccine passports in March 2022; giving it sovereignty would globalise vaccine passports."

ISRAEL PUTS IRAN ON NOTICE

Iran is just "a few weeks" away from a bomb

Benny Gantz, Israel's defence minister, has effectively put Iran on notice, saying that Iran is just a "few weeks" from being able to make a nuclear bomb.

With Iran's mullahs openly calling for the annihilation of the Jewish state, Israel has always said it will not allow them to develop a bomb. Moreover, whereas President Trump pulled out of President Obama's 'deal' with Iran to limit its nuclear production, President Biden is offering a new deal which is said to be "far, far worse" than Obama's 2015 deal.

A statement from 49 US Republican senators on 14 March 2022 said: "By every indication, the Biden administration appears to have given away the store.... What is more, the deal appears likely to deepen Iran's financial and security relationship with Moscow and Beijing, including through arms sales."

The Gatestone Institute reports that the European Union appears "excited" that the nuclear talks have reopened again to revive the nuclear deal that will bring nuclear weapons to Iran, the "world's largest state sponsor of terrorism," and additional billions of dollars. In the meantime, its says, the Biden administration and the EU have remained silent in the face of the Iranian regime taking more politicial hostages on trumpedup charges, such as happened to Nazanin Zaghari-Ratcliffe until Britain's Foreign Secretary Liz Truss settled an unpaid debt for tanks of nearly \$400 million.

Gantz said in a speech at Reichman University in Herlizya in May that Iran is working on 1,000 new advanced uranium centrifuges at new underground sites being built near its Natanz nuclear plant, providing figures that appeared to extend beyond those published by the International Atomic Energy Agency. And Israel knows exactly how long it is going to take the Iranians to prepare, effectively putting Iran on notice. At the beginning of his speech, Gantz linked the defence of Ukraine, where he said Israel was in the right place "ethically and strategically," to the Iranian threat, saying it was "correct to mobilise economic, diplomatic, and if necessary, military might, as soon as possible, to perhaps prevent war."

He called for a multi-pronged regional and global pressure campaign against the Islamic republic to stave off possible war. The King of Jordan has warned that Iran and its proxies are filling a vacuum left by Russia in southern Syria as Russia withdraws its forces to bolster its Ukraine invasion, according to The Moscow Times. King Abdullah II has stressed that Russia's presence in southern Syria was a "source of calm". Speaking at Stanford University's Hoover Institution in May, he said: "Unfortunate-ly we're looking at maybe an escalation of problems on our borders.

According to a report on 20 May in the Dutch press, several bases abandoned by the Russians have been transferred to Iran's paramilitary Revolutionary Guards Corps, as well as the Lebanese terror group Hezbollah. Jerusalem and Moscow have in recent years maintained a so-called deconfliction mechanism that works to prevent Israeli and Russian forces from clashing in Syria. The new development could be problematic for Israel, which has sought to prevent Iranian entrenchment in Syria. Israel has waged a years long campaign of airstrikes aimed at pro-Iranian fighters located there and at preventing the transfer of Iranian-supplied weaponry.

It was also reported in late May that Israeli planes flying over Syria in operation against Iranian-backed targets had been fired at, which is a very unwelcome development.

100 killed in Nigeria in one month

Two attacks on predominantly Christian villages in Nigeria killed around 100 people in April.

Islamist gunmen attacked ten villages in Plateau State on 10 April, killing at least 80 people and abducting 60, according to **Release International.**

Later, Muslim Fulani herdsmen attacked four villages in Kaduna state on 26 April, killing 18 Christians and burning down 92 houses.

Release International is urging the Nigerian government

to take urgent action to protect Christians who are suffering violence "on an almost daily basis".

Gunmen killed at least 80 people and abducted 60

human experiences, allowing us to connect on the basic levels of desire and emotion. "Printing truth on a page has power! The

multiplication and impact that comes from written words of God's truth on a printed page have changed lives, given hope to the hopeless, love to those who felt devalued, and instruction on how to live a righteous life and receive God's blessings."

When asked about his literature vision, George Verwer (left), founder of mission organisation Operation Mobilisation, says: "My guess is that over a quarter of a billion books in about 50 languages have been distributed. In my meetings alone way over two hundred thousand have gone out."



"You are what you read", says Ron George, director of the Eurasia Education Foundation. "The power of the printed page has been used by evangelists, dictators and advertisers all over the world. During my 17 years in Operation Mobilisation I have seen how powerful

literature can be. Every church should share the printed gospel with those within it, building them up in the faith, and also with those outside it, facing the challenges of secularism, materialism and hopelessness."

Years ago Ron George met Don McCurry at the Glen Eyrie Conference on Islam and out of that meeting came many papers on Islam's history, culture and strategies. Don, now 93, has retired and handed over his books to make them more available. EEF is now translating these masterly works into all the Central Asian languages. US COMMISSION WARNS OF INCREASING PERSECUTION IN INDIA, NIGERIA AND AFGHANISTAN

The United States Commission on International Religious Freedom (USCIRF) is calling for India, Nigeria and Afghanistan to be added to the USA's list of countries of 'particular concern'.

The Commission, which advises the President and the US State Department, is calling for 15 nations in total to be included on the list of countries with severe religious intolerance: Nigeria, India and Afghanistan join China, Eritrea, Iran, North Korea, Pakistan, Russia, Burma, Saudi Arabia, Tajikistan, Turkmenistan, Syria and Vietnam.

Paul Robinson, CEO of Release International, said: "We welcome this report. Release International has long been reporting on the widespread violence against Christians in Nigeria, as well as India and Afghanistan. These other countries have also earned their places on the list." Kyrgyzstan



Oppression of Christians is on the rise in Kyrgyzstan, reports Open Doors.

The charity, which supports persecuted Christians, gives the example of a Christian man who wasn't allowed to attend his mother's funeral because of his faith. After the funeral, the man tried to enter the cemetery to mourn his mother – but the mullah (Muslim leader) and other villagers threw him out, saying his presence would "desecrate the holy place", and forced him to leave the village.

The same mullah had previously prevented him from burying his brother in the village, because of the family's faith, and the ceremony had to take place in a Christian cemetery nearly 100 miles away. In many places there have been death threats, violence and abuse.

Some converts are locked up for long periods by their families and beaten

An Open Doors spokesperson for Central Asia says: "For many Christians in Kyrgyzstan, persecution is a daily occurrence. They face discrimination – be it in their local community, workplace or army. Some converts are locked up for long periods by their families and beaten. Local Islamic teachers preach against them and may cause them to be expelled from their communities."



The European Court of Human Rights (ECHR) has saved a Christian man from being returned to Pakistan. By doing so it has recognised that Pakistani Christian converts from Islam face danger in their homeland.

The ex-Muslim, known as 'MAM' fled to Switzerland in fear of his life, yet a Swiss court denied him asylum. While the Swiss accepted that MAM's conversion was genuine, they ruled that he was not in danger. MAM was due to be returned to Pakistan, but appealed to the ECHR with the help of the European Centre for Law & Justice (ECLJ).

He was due to be returned to Pakistan

After the ECLJ provided evidence of the risks that ex-Muslim converts face in Pakistan, the ECHR ruled on 26 April that MAM was in danger if he was expelled from Switzerland.

The ECHR concluded: "The

[Swiss] Federal Administrative Court did examine the situation of Christians in Pakistan but did not specifically examine the situation of converts to Christianity... the Court considers that... the Swiss authorities have not made a sufficient assessment of the risk that the applicant would face because of his conversion, if he returned to Pakistan."

It is unlikely that the Swiss will now expel MAM and the case reinforces the ECHR's case law on Christian converts from Islam.

LEFT TRIES TO OVERRIDE SUPREME COURT ON ROE V WADE

After a leak revealed that the US Supreme Court might overturn the 1973 Roe v Wade judgment which allowed abortions nationwide, pro-abortionists have reacted with protests, death threats against pro-life organisations and an attempt to bypass the Supreme Court.

The Democrats tried to bypass the Court by mandating unlimited abortion nationwide in the Senate, but failed to do so by a vote of 49-51 on 11 May. The Democrat bill would have forced all states to allow the practice by enshrining abortion on demand in federal law.

The leak from the Supreme Court was a ten-

tative position, not a final j u d g ement, but just the possibility of losing Roe v Wade was e n o u g h to spark vehement p r o t e s t s and death threats. Large barricades had to be erected around the Supreme Court building in Washington DC to ensure security.

After the Supreme Court Justices' personal addresses were maliciously published online, protestors attempted to intimidate the judges and their families by demonstrating outside their own homes, in violation of federal law. The Senate even had to pass a bill to allow the Supreme Court to provide 24-hour protection to the families of the justices.

A pro-life organisation in Wisconsin had its offices attacked with fire and a Molotov cocktail, as well as receiving abusive voicemail messages wishing death and suffering upon its staff.

Jay Sekulow of the American Centre for Law and Justice says: "The pro-abortion Left worships at the altar of abortion. They're engaged in an intimidation campaign to sway [Supreme Court] justices to change their minds."

More than 20 states currently have laws on the books that would effectively ban abortion within their borders, and more than a dozen states, plus the District of Columbia, have laws that legally safeguard abortion. If Roe v Wade falls, all these laws would be activated.

President Biden has called on the elected branches of government to take over the preservation of abortion on demand if Roe v Wade goes, and at the federal level he said he would work to adopt legislation that codifies the right to abortion.

EU POLITICIAN WARNS OF WHO POWER GRAB

Unelected billionairefunded body could take power over populations

German MEP Christine Anderson has warned that a planned EU agreement with the World Health Organisation (WHO) would allow the WHO to seize governmental power in the event of a pandemic.

"A non-legitimised body, into which the richest of the super-rich buy their way through donations"

Anderson said on her You-Tube channel: "A democratically non-legitimised body, into which the richest of the super-rich buy their way through donations, is to decide in the future whether a pandemic situation exists, in order to then directly take over governmental power."

Since 1 March, an intergovernmental task force has been revising the treaties between the WHO and the EU member states, for acceptance in the EU by 2024. The WHO confirmed this in a press release last December. The EU Council justified the WHO takeover by saying: "Next time, the world must be prepared."

In her video, Anderson argued that allowing the WHO such power would be a "direct attack on the rule of the people by the people... the most elementary principle of any democracy." She asked the [EU] Commis-

She asked the [EU] Comm sion how it would ensure that people's rights would be respected. She said: "The answer I received is... not at all! The Commission could have simply stated that it is very important not to bypass citizens... But it didn't."

The MEP believes that WHO decision-makers will be able to "issue instructions to you but are not accountable to you and cannot be held politically responsible by you."

Canada secretly hacked citizens' phone data

The Canadian government tracked the movements of 33 million people by their mobile phone data during the Covid crisis – without their consent or knowledge.

Health officials monitored shopping trips and when people travelled out of their city

Health officials obtained detailed information on personal behaviour, including shopping trips, family gatherings, how long was spent indoors, and when people travelled out of their city or province. Life Site News reports that the secret surveillance programme conducted by Justin Trudeau's government was revealed to MPs by Canada's House of Commons ethics committee, which made the announcement in May.

The reason given was to understand the "public's responsiveness during lockdown measures". Commentators worry that the surveillance many governments are using to combat Covid could be used for other purposes.

AMERICAN STATE PUTS TAMPONS IN BOYS' TOILETS

The US state of Oregon is forcing all schools, even infant schools, to put menstrual products in boys' toilets.

Female-avoiding phrases like "students who menstruate"

The state's new Menstrual Dignity Act, approved by the Democrat Governor last year, says that feminine hygiene products should be available in "every student bathroom", along with instructions on how to use them. Oregon's advice for implementing the law is filled with female-avoiding phrases like "students who menstruate".

Meanwhile, Wisconsin State Representative Francesca Hong, a Democrat, has been lambasted by conservatives for calling pregnant women "birthing bodies" rather than women, while discussing the potential overturn of the Roe v Wade abortion judgement.

"We have a name," women's magazine Evie complained. "Birthing bodies doesn't even make sense since women getting abortions are literally not birthing."

Bible-Tweeting Finnish MP acquitted in "hate speech" trial now faces appeal



Päivi Räsänen still faces jail if found 'guilty'

Päivi Räsänen, the Finnish MP who was cleared of all hate speech charges for expressing her biblical beliefs on marriage, now faces further uncertainty as her prosecutor is appealing against her victory.

A three-judge panel on the Helsinki District Court had unanimously acquitted Ms Räsänen of all charges on 30 March, arguing that it was "not for the district court to interpret biblical concepts."

Justice Samuel Alito, whose home was surrounded by about 100 demonstrators after his leaked draft opinion indicated the Supreme Court is prepared to overturn the landmark Roe v Wade abortion ruling

In a 28-page judgement, the court reasoned that statements made by the former interior minister and Christian Democratic Party leader didn't constitute hate speech even though they may have offended mem-bers of the LGBT community. The court had ordered the

prosecution to pay Räsänen more than 60,000 euros in legal costs, but the prosecution has now publicly stated its intentions to appeal the decision.

The former minister of the interior was facing at least two years in prison for tweeting a Bible verse describing homosexuality as shameful in 2019 and for sharing her traditional Christian view on marriage in a TV debate and in a 2004 pamphlet written with the bishop.

Paul Coleman, chief executive of ADF International, the legal organisation representing Ms Räsänen, told Premier that by appealing the ruling, the prosecutor seems to be wanting to protect her reputation over the way the case had been communicated to the media.

"The Helsinki court didn't just find in Päivi's favour and in on the side of the bishop, [it] also had issue with how the prosecutor had set up and framed the case, this is highly unusual.

Reacting to the news, Ms Räsänen said: "This case has been hanging over me and my family for almost three years. After my full exoneration in court, I am dismayed that the prosecutor will not let this campaign against me drop. Once again, I am prepared to defend freedom of speech and religion not just for me, but for everyone.'

Revisiting the outstanding David Watson

The Writings of David Watson

ook reviews always tend to be about new books, K hot off the press

But I decided to take a few days away from work and reflect on the Lord and his work.

Searching my bookshelves for inspiration, I selected David Watson, a Portrait By His Friends', and two of David Watson's books: 'You Are My God', and 'Fear No Evil' (his diary of his final year with cancer).

For those of us who lived in the UK through the 70's and early 80's, David Watson was very much the man of the moment as far as the Church was concerned. He demonstrated real faith as he took a near redundant Anglican church in landmark church attended by as many as 700 people.

The congregation then moved to an even larger venue, St Michael's, by York Minister and saw as many as 2,000 congregating.

As well as a being a Church of England pastor and skilled preacher, David had an evangelist's heart and innovated with drama, dance, music and living in community, as he sought to communicate the Gospel.

He demonstrated real faith as he took a near redundant Anglican church in York and transformed it into a landmark church attended by as many as 700, later 2,000

His ministry extended to

York and transformed it into a university missions and then festivals (he did not call them crusades or missions) in city centres around the UK, and to other parts of the world.

Suddenly in the prime of his ministry, he was diagnosed with cancer. The doctors gave him at best a year to live.

Thousands prayed. His men-tor, John Wimber, flew from the States to pray with him for his healing.

Thirteen months later he was dead. The books tell us: "On the Friday evening, 17 February 1984, he said to his wife Anne, 'I'm very tired; let's go home'. She was in no doubt what he meant. She went to bed leaving her mother to stay with him, but praying that God would wake her up to be with him before he died. She woke at midnight. He died 15 minutes later.'

The books about David that I re-read were about his life, his work, his love for the Master and his sickness. David was a skilled writer. If you have never read any of his writings, I suggest you start with one of his two autobiographies, 'You are My God', and 'Fear No Evil' (his diary of his final year with cancer). They are all still available on the internet or order them from a Christian bookshop

The man who put a million children into families

As Many as The **Stars**

ccasionally I come across a book whose story needs shouting from the rooftops. This is such a book.

It tells of how one man and his family transformed the lives of hundreds of thousands of children in South-east Asia in obedience to one prophetic 'word' from God

"I sense you are going to be a father to as many children as there are stars in the sky"

Ever since Robert Glover befriended a boy from Hong Kong who came to his Norfolk school, the Chinese people had been on his heart. He had also read the stories of the great saints who went to China, such as Hudson Taylor.

After he married, he and his wife had six children and Rob-

ert made his career in social work in the UK and then on the island of Guernsey. One day a visiting pastor from the New Frontiers alliance of churches came to speak at Robert's church in Guernsey. As the visitor prayed for people at the end of a service, he came up to Robert and declared: "I sense you are going to be a father to as many children as there are stars in the sky". After the service Robert and

his wife talked about this. They already had six children and didn't want any more! Could he have been talking about the youth work in their church? But there weren't many young people on Guernsey!

I don't want to spoil the story for you. But let me tell you that there came a time when Robert moved with his wife and SIX children to Shanghai. Robert never hid his Christian faith but persuaded the Chinese government that placing orphans in families was better than letting them languish in institutions.

Moreover, he managed to persuade the British and Chinese governments to agree to fund the programme, which expanded from one city to one state, then all over China. Other South-east Asia countries became interested and the programme moved on to Thailand, Cambodia, and Vietnam. I really became excited when I read that North Korea approached him to introduce his scheme there.

In October 2018, a Pan-Asia family placement conference was held in Shanghai, marking 20 years since Robert Glover's programme began. One of the speakers, Professor Qu of the Beijing Bureau of Statistics, declared: "Today in China, 85 per cent of the children in care are living in families'

Robert reminds readers that when he started there was not even a word in Chinese for 'family-based care'. The Professor also said that, at an educated guess, the number of children moved from institutions to family care - all because of one man's vision and passion - would be more than one million children. The prophecy from all those years ago when Robert was prayed for in his Guernsey church had been fulfilled.

The book does not have an ending as the work isn't over. Robert tells us at the end of the book: "Our goal, our passion is to help hundreds of thousands more children across Asia to find their place in a family".

The work of Robert Glover and his charity Care for Children has been recognised by the Queen, who awarded him an OBE for his work among children. It is time for the Church to be shouting from the rooftops what God can do through a family who are obedient to his vision and calling.

An important book for our time

Ruler of Kings - Towards a **Christian Vision of** Government

By Joseph Boot

t is confession time! I speedread this book and was disappointed with it. If like me, sometimes, when you pick up a book, you are looking for one that 'does not engage the brain too much', and is a 'feel-good bed-time read, you will be disappointed with it.

 few days later I sat down and started to read through it again. My attitude to it totally changed. This is an important book for our time. It grapples with what a Christian vision of civil government should really look like.

Here is the challenge of the book: What should a Christian proposal for social order be? Get ready for some serious study!

Joseph Boot (usually known as Joe) is the founding pastor of Westminster Chapel in Toronto and founder of the Ezra Institute for Contemporary Christianity. He paints a picture of a world where the 'cult of the (so

called) expert' rules.

He quotes Thomas Sowell: "Intellectuals have seen themselves not simply as an elite - but as an anointed elite with a mission to lead others ... towards better lives'

Joe Boot explains that we have allowed these 'experts' to encroach on cultural and social issues where they don't belong. Quoting H Evan Runner, he writes: "The Western world has rapidly become post-Christianity pagan... humanism has been the dominant cultural driving force... in modern Western civilisation.

The author reminds us there must be a Christian response and it must be biblically rooted.

While I was reading the book, the results of the French presidential election were coming through. The author writes about Western democracies, including France, where "the absolute sovereignty of the people or state is confessional and practical atheism'

He contrasts it to the situation in the UK (and Canada) where "the Head of State swears an oath, under the absolute sov-ereignty of Christ the King, to uphold the law and Gospel of Christ, and to defend that faith once for all delivered to the saints". We might not always see that in the UK, but it is the foundation of our country.

Is it possible to have a distinctly Christian view of politics, the book asks? A resounding 'yes' is the response.

Where does wisdom come from? Joe Boot reminds us the Bible tells us: "The fear of the Lord is the beginning of knowl-edge". (Proverbs 1:7, 2:6).

He shows it is God who gave wisdom to his servant Joseph, in the time of the Pharaohs.

'the end times'. This book sets out to help readers comprehend what lies ahead for Israel. and the world - and sets the scene for 'the time of Jacob's trouble', as anticipated in the Old Testament.

To understand the end times. we have to understand Israel

Rosamund Weissman is a Jewish Christian. She grew up attending a Reformed synagogue and came to faith in Christ while a law student at Nottingham University. Now married with three sons and a grandson, she brings an understanding of the end times particularly from her deep understanding of the Old Testament and Israeli society.

Rosamund believes that to understand the end times we have to understand Israel. To her Israel is the key

She tells readers they cannot understand the magnitude of what is ahead for Israel, without considering the country's past and present suffering. The book declares: "The future 'times of Jacob's troubles' will be worse than anything that has gone before".

A glance at the chapter headings show some of the important subjects tacked in the book: the 70-week prophecy of Daniel, the invasion of Israel. Armageddon, the statue in Nebuchadnezzar's dream, es-chatology in the Psalms, God's judgement, the Millennium.

For many, the Bible, espe-cially the Old Testament is full of mysteries. I wonder how many of us know that each letter of the Hebrew alphabet has a numerical value?

Rosamund Weissman explains that Jewish scholars have a fascination with numbers and applies this knowledge to the biblical understanding of what a day, a week, Daniel's 70 weeks and the 1000-year millennial reign really mean in Scripture.

There is so much more in the book. For instance, Rosamund explains why she believes a third temple will be built, and how it will come into being.

Above all Rosamund wants to encourage Christians to pray for Israel as we enter the end times. She reminds us that Isaiah says the duty of a watchman is to watch and pray, and not slack. In biblical times, if a watchman was slack, the entire city was at risk. She challenges her readers:

"Let us prepare ourselves for the task of watching, by growing in understanding of the fast ap-proaching time of trouble ahead for Israel⁷

Reading and studying this book will certainly help you to do that.



She added: "Despite an abundance of psychological studies concluding that children exposed to sexually explicit content at an early age are more likely to develop disorders and addictions, there are many articles online that encourage parents to bring their children to Pride parades.'

Church of England considers gay marriage

Church of England members have been consulted for their opinions on same-sex marriage in advance of the next General Synod – the Church's 'parliament'.

The Living in Love and Faith consultation, which closed at the end of April, is part of a process questioning whether gay mar-riage should be allowed in the national Church.

Coalition for Marriage reports that the consultation has "been muddying the waters" by giving individuals' feelings the same importance as biblical teaching.

Meanwhile, the Church of Scotland is set to approve samesex weddings after a majority of the Church's 41 regional presbyteries indicated their support ahead of the General Assembly in June.

A new perspective on the end times

he recent lockdowns and recent retirement from my career with the police meant I could at last study end-time Bible prophecy in

depth. The result was a book but much more than that. It was the realisation that all four major views of Rapture timing have merit, but all mainly miss the same point.

The Bible is a book written primarily by Jews for a Jewish audience. Yet, by the grace of God, we Gentiles can avail ourselves of the promises to Israel – if we are grafted into the Olive Tree (Romans 11).

This led me inevitably to Leviticus 23 and the Lord's appointed times - designated dates that the Lord has set to meet with his people (the 'olive tree') corporately. The central tenet still causes me

to marvel at how God works out his plans.

If the first four (springtime) 'appointed times' were all fulfilled by the Lord Jesus at his First Coming – all on their exact dates and all in the same year, then, could it just be that the last three (autumnal) appointed times might all be fulfilled by him at his second coming, all on their exact date and all in the same (as yet unknown) year.

The seven events are: Crucifixion (Passover), burial (first day of Unleavened Bread), Resurrection (Firstfruits), pouring out of the Holy Spirit (Shavuot), Rapture of the Olive Tree (Day of Trumpet Blasts), return of King Messiah (Day of Atonement) and regathering of Disapora Jews to Israel plus full pouring out of the Holy Spirit on all surviving believers (Tabernacles).

With this framework and the

help of Revelation's 'three woes' and the Greek phrase 'meta tauta' ('after this'), endtime chronology falls into place simply, elegantly and wonderfully – including all of Daniel's time periods.

The future is much simpler than we think

One implication is that the Rapture occurs on the first of Tishri (Jewish month equivalent to September/October) in that final year followed by Messiah Jesus' return on the tenth of Tishri with the Seven Bowls occurring during the nine days in between.

What God is saying about Ukraine

I suggest what God is saying to us re Ukraine includes the following:

1. God is shaking all the nations and their institutions (Haggai 2:6-7) including Russia and Ukraine.

2. God is giving us an insight into what a secular society is like, founded on atheism, where the Church simply justifies the attitudes of the current elite, and where "might is right". He is warning us what will happen if we let go of our Judeo-Christian foundations.

3. The Book of Revelation warns us of plagues, wars, famines, death and financial collapse; given so much personal and international debt, the latter must be close. What Revelation describes may well occur in cycles, but get more severe as the end times approach. 4. The spiritual battle: Ukraine had been experiencing a revival with David Hathaway playing a key role. The Russian Orthodox Church is allegedly led by a former KGB agent (Kirill) and persecutes all non-Orthodox Christians. This is an attack on the revival, but seems to have drawn many Ukrainians to seek the Lord (Romans 8:28).

Ukraine has a history of severe anti-Semitism

5. The poverty of idolising man-made things: many have put their trust in international bodies such as the UN and EU, who have proved useless in stopping this war; others have trusted education, yet very educated people have launched this war; others trust in the might of weaponry, but it seems the spirit of the Ukrainians has been the crucial element, even from the viewpoint of secular commentators.

6. The policy of pandering to bullies to "buy" them off has been shown to encourage more aggression. We failed to heed the warnings of Putin's previous campaigns in Chechnya and Crimea and of the Russia he was creating. God defeats his enemies and chastises the penitent; he does not reward bad behaviour in the hope it will go away!

7. Ukraine has a history ofsevere anti-Semitism, as illustrated in Elinor Burkett's biography of Golda Meir's and statistics from World War 2. Genesis 12:1-3 and other curses need to be taken seriously by all peoples and nations and repentance on all levels is necessary. 8. War could spread to other nations – let us heed Jesus' warnings in Matthew 24 and call others to seek eternal security in him!

But not only that, we now have laptops, notebooks, tablets, smartphones. Youtube, Instagram,WhatsApp, livestream, Facebook, Twitter, internet games played on anything – every minute can be occupied! In my early childhood we had no TV to take control of our eyes and ears.

Unless I am watching a Christian programme, I don't feel I can hear God when the TV is on and would welcome the TV being shut down from 11:30pm till 6:30am.

Fifty-one per cent of the population have said that they don't believe in God, and this figure will increase until we officially give God a proper place in our society. We need to regain an official weekly Sabbath, a day of rest like we used to have (and some places like Germany, still do have; most shops were closed from 2pm on Saturdays until Monday). That could help our nation return to thinking about God, and give God a chance to speak to us.

Of course sport is played on Sundays, and sports people get enormous salaries. If sport is played on Sundays I don't think they should do it for money.

Perhaps retailers could be discouraged from opening on Sundays by introducing a Sunday trading licence, varying according to how long the trader wanted to trade for, and size of premises.

CREATION CORNER

M ammals come in many different shapes and sizes, and have colonised almost every part of our planet. Although most live on land, some are aquatic, and one kind (bats) can fly.

Evolution tells us that mammals evolved from reptiles. What does the evidence tell us?

1. No evidence that mammals' body hair evolved from reptile scales

Mammals have body hair (or fur). Many evolutionists claim that mammals evolved fur to keep them warm.


It is true that hair is an excellent insulator, but they have a problem explaining how mammals got their hair. They claim it evolved from reptiles' scales, possibly starting as sensitive whiskers, but there is no evidence for this.

There are important differences between reptilian scales and mammalian hair. Scales are rigid plates, and when reptiles moult the whole sheet of scales is discarded. Mammals' hairs (like birds' feathers) are rooted in the skin as individual follicles, and are lost singly when moulting. Both scales and hair have been found in the fossil record, but no evidence of hair evolution, despite more than a century of searching.



beaver-like Castorocauda, had fully developed hair

The oldest fossil mammal, a beaver-like creature named 'Castorocauda', had fully developed hair. According to BBC News online (24 February 2006), this discovery "could challenge some current-



ly accepted ideas on mammal evolution," partly because it is alleged to have lived "164 million years ago", yet it had hair, a beaver-like tail, strong arms for digging, and teeth like modern river otters.

The report continued: "Such advanced features have surprised many scientists. The mammals of the time were once thought to be largely primitive shrew-like creatures, scuttling at the feet of dinosaurs, and only flourishing when the dinosaurs died out some 65 million years ago."

In other words, the first mammals were

much like mammals are today, including hair.

2. No evidence for bones moving

Evolutionists also have "ear problems". All reptiles, living and fossil, have several jaw bones and only one ear bone, but all mammals, living and fossil, have only one jaw bone and three ear bones. How could a transitional creature eat or hear properly, while its bones were migrating from the jaw to the ear?

Another serious objection to evolution

is the fact that all mammals have an amazing and essential hearing organ known as the 'Organ of Corti', a delicate spiral structure in the cochlea. Mammals couldn't hear without it, yet reptiles don't have it, and there is nothing in the reptilian ear that it could have evolved from.

3. No evidence for sweat glands evolving into milk-producing mammary glands

Reptiles don't have mammary glands, so what could they have evolved from?

Inner hair cells Tectorial membrane Outer hair cells Basilar fiber Spiral ganglion Cochlear nerve

Reptiles don't have the Organ of Corti, an essential hearing organ found in all mammals



Mammals' hairs such as in the raccoon are (like birds' feathers) rooted in the skin as individual follicles

Evolutionists have suggested they are adapted sweat glands, but this is just a guess — there is absolutely no evidence.

Sweat is actually a waste product, so how could sweat glands gradually evolve into mammary glands which produce milk, full of rich nourishment, and essential to the young mammals' survival? In any case, reptiles don't have sweat glands either!




