homeless man miraculously had his sight restored after receiving prayer from a local evangelist in Brighton.

This is the latest in a series of healing miracles being seen through a local team of street evangelists from 11 churches who invite strangers to simply sit on a chair and receive prayer.

The 'Prayerchair' ministry has seen countless miracles and people deciding to become Christians since it began in 2007, according to its director, Michael Farkas.

The healing of the man's sight happened when a Prayerchair team member, Clive Humphrys, was walking down St James Street, Brighton, in January 2023. He recognised Eddy, who had previously been healed, sitting with a friend outside a cafe. Eddy had received healing prayer some five years previously, after taunting Clive to pray for a companion suffering from hearing loss. Clive did – and the man heard again. Surprised at the miracle, Eddy had invited Clive to pray for his own gym-related injury and was also healed.

"As soon as I prayed, he could see across the road"

Bowled over by these healings, Eddy had sporadically kept in touch with Clive and called him over to join them. Eddy introduced Clive to his friend Billy, a homeless man who was visiting Brighton from Essex to look for a job.

"Billy started talking about being visually impaired," says Clive. "He said that he was legally blind and received government benefits.

"I asked him if I could pray for him. He said 'Yes' and was amazed at the results! Before I prayed for him, he could just about see the cafe menu close up. But as soon as I prayed, he could see the board in Morrison's supermarket across the road and posters on the wall.

He was blown away by the experience, which I recorded on camera."

In the video recording, Billy testifies that Clive had prayed for him in tongues, and also for him to be reborn and for the forgiveness of his sins.

"I could hardly see before," Billy says. "I am registered blind with an eye condition called RP (Retinitis Pigmentosa) and it's incurable. Minutes after being prayed for in tongues, my eyes are a million per cent better already. My head is clearer too and I feel that a weight has been lifted off my shoulders. I am just so very grateful. Thank you so much."

Prayerchair outreaches mainly take place on Saturdays, and Michael Farkas heads up the ministry after becoming involved in 2009. He says he is passionate about the ministry's success in reaching troubled people who haven't heard the good news of salvation or experienced the healing power of Jesus.

"We reach people on the streets and pray for healing for them, and introduce them to the love of Jesus. We offer a passive form of evangelism by inviting people for a blessing and asking what they need.

"We have seen some incredible things. Our team rely on prophetic insight when we pray and sometimes God will give us messages or words for people and we share that with them. It can often startle them into understanding that there's something God wants them to know."

In 2019, there was a man with blisters the size of footballs on his legs, spotted by the Prayerchair team in Queen's Road, Brighton. He was in a wheelchair and he couldn't walk.

Michael said: "When he pulled up his trouser leg it was grotesque, there was open flesh. The man was on maximum medication and still in pain. He'd been in the wheelchair for two years and his girlfriend was pushing the wheelchair. We prayed for him and the next thing, the guy starts stamping the ground with his foot and saying, 'What have you "It's been extraordinary to feel the energy and presence that has taken away the pain in my ankle"

done? The pain has completely left my leg. It's completely gone!'''

Michael told him the love of Jesus was reaching his need and helped the man to stand up.

"We helped him to walk and he started to hobble a bit and took a few steps around. He was grinning from ear to ear and his girlfriend said she hadn't seen him smile in two years. Then we shared the Gospel and he couldn't wait to accept Jesus in his heart as his personal Saviour. It was remarkable – one of those 'Wow!' moments."

Another miracle happened in 2021 through remote prayer. A woman approached the team in Brighton's Queen's Road and asked for prayer for her elderly mother who was sick in hospital. The team prayed and the following week the daughter returned.

Michael added: "She said her mum was better. In fact, the doctor said it was a remarkable recovery and she was discharged from hospital. The woman came back to share this with us because she felt the prayer to God had made a big difference."

A chartered accountant by profession, Michael is Australian and has been married to his wife, Lyn, for 37 years. They moved to Brighton 23 years ago when they believed that they had a

Tim Keller, Reformed church founder and author

Theologian Tim Keller died on 19 May 2023 aged 72, after a prolonged battle with pancreatic cancer.

Called "the modern-day CS Lewis," he wrote 31 books and founded Redeemer Presbyterian Church, one of New York's largest churches.

He co-founded The Gospel Coalition (TGC), a fellowship of Reformed evan-gelical churches. "There is no pastor I know, in the last 100 years, who did what Tim Keller did to take the Reformed faith to the street, to the Church, and to the academy," wrote TGC's interim president Sandy Wilson. "He will be remembered among this generation's most effective Christian pastors, apologists, and evangelists.'

The event hosted around 900 traditionally minded, politically homeless voters, including many Christians, at Westminster's Emmanuel Centre from 15 to 17 May.

Spearheaded by Yoram Hazony, an American-Israeli philosopher and father of nine, the conference sought to push the small-c conservative values "faith, family, flag and freedom" back into the mainstream ahead of the next general election. The audience was surprisingly youthful, with many under-30s queuing up to ask the panellists questions.

FIRST 'THREE-PARENT' BABY BORN IN UK

"Playing God" destroys embryos, risks generational damage

The UK's first baby to have the DNA of three parents has been born, using mitochondrial DNA replacement technology.

The child's third DNA contribution was from a female donor, which only comprises 0.1 per cent of the total ge-netic material, but there are serious ethical implications.

It is believed that no more than five 'three-parent' children have been born since 2016, using this new technology, but the process may involve the destruction of a donor embryo, and the

SUNAK BACKS PROTECTING WOMEN PM SUPPORTS WOMEN'S SAFE SPACES

Prime Minister Rishi Sunak has con-trasted his own position on transgender-ism with that of Labour leader Sir Keir Starmer

Starmer said in April: "For 99.9 percent of women, it is completely biological... and of course they haven't got a penis.

In response to questions, Sunak responded that he had a "slightly different point of view" to Starmer, confirming that he believed 100 per cent of wom-en do not have a penis, with: "Yes, of course.

He added that we should be com-passionate towards those with gender confusion, but "we need to make sure, particularly when it comes to women's health, women's sports or indeed women's spaces, that we are protecting those rights and those spaces." Sunak has also supported revising the

Equality Act to make it easier to ban men from women-only spaces by chang-ing the wording to "biological sex" instead of "sex."

When Stephen and Joanne Evans discovered what their child would be taught, they asked permission to with-draw their child for the day. The headteacher granted permission but argued the parents were making the wrong decision, and advised them that the CofE's 'Valuing All God's Children' guidance for schools says children as young as five should be affirmed if they want to identify as transgender.

Andrea Williams, chief executive of Christian Concern, said: "If ever there was a moment in history for those

However, the court did find that banning Montague from the school contradicted the school's own policies and 'could be indicative of a school that was riding roughshod over the parents' rights".

Montague told Fox News: "It has felt like I and my Christian beliefs have been on trial... we will appeal this perverse judgment which has made the evidence fit with the school's agenda.

Christian Concern's Tim Dieppe commented: "The evidence that this school is aggressively indoctrinating young children with LGBT ideology is overwhelming."

Does our <u>new King</u> really believe the oath he <u>made?</u>

"I WILL MAINTAIN THE LAWS OF GOD AND THE TRUE PROFESSION OF THE GOSPEL"

The coronation of King Charles III was outwardly very impressive and contained much that should have warmed the heart of a Christian, as prayers were made in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ and two wonderful Bible readings from Colossians 1 and Luke 4 were broadcast to millions.

And of course the King responded with "I will" to the Archbishop of Canterbury's Declaration of the Protestant Oath:

"Will you to the utmost of your power maintain the laws of God and the true profession of the Gospel? Will you to the utmost of your power maintain in the United Kingdom the Protestant Reformed Religion established by law? Will you maintain and preserve inviolably the settlement of the Church of England, and the doctrine, worship, discipline, and government thereof, as by law established in England?"

However, God is not impressed with outward form but with inward reality.

Does King Charles really believe the oath he made on 6 May? There are three major issues which need to be addressed.

Firstly, what is the Protestant Reformed Religion that Charles has committed himself to? The Reformation was based on a move to reform Christianity, after centuries of Roman Catholic dominance in Europe which brought in multiple errors as far as biblical Christianity was concerned.

It was an attempt to return to the Gospel of salvation through repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, as given in the Bible. Its view of God and salvation was based on the famous three 'solae' – Latin for alone – 'Sola Scriptura, Sola Gratia, Sola Fides' ("only Scripture, only grace, only faith"). Faith in Christ alone as the sole mediator between God and man was the basis of Reformed theology.

Sadly, much of the visible 'Protestant' Church worldwide – the Church of England, Church of Scotland, Lutheran Church, Methodist Church and Episcopal Church – has moved away from this theology. Even as Archbishop Welby asked this question, he would have been all too aware that the Church of England is now facing a split between those who want a biblical Church, based on Reformed Protestant theology (represented by GAFCON – Global Anglican Future Conference), and those who accept the authority of Canterbury and the Anglican Synod, which are becoming increasingly liberal.

So where does King Charles stand on this issue? His mother, the late Queen

Elizabeth, clearly expressed a personal faith in the Lord Jesus. Indeed, after her death Charles told the world that his own faith is "so deeply rooted" in the Church.

Have his views, then, changed over the decades? According to the book 'The Prince and the Paranormal' by John Dale, written in 1986: "There is evidence that deep inside himself the Prince is a super-ecumenist – someone who believes that each of the world's religions including Christianity contains a relative truth rather than an absolute one."

In 1985 Charles said in an interview: "I think Jung makes a great deal of sense in many, many areas and particularly in what is written in the Bible and Indian religions, and in Islam, and many others ... Definitely a pattern develops, where we are all ultimately trying to explore, to go along the same path, to answer the same questions. We all approach from different paths but ultimately the paths meet somewhere in infinity, and that's the important thing" (Sunday Times, 18 August 1985).

thing" (Sunday Times, 18 August 1985). This is basically the multi-faith idea that every faith alongside Christianity contains a path to God (in other words, all gods are equal). How far does King Charles still hold this view? It appears that he wanted to include prayers from religious leaders of other faiths in the actual coronation service. He was not able to do this, because of the legal aspects of the coronation as a specifically Christian ceremony, but he did manage to include them in giving a blessing as he left Westminster Abbey.

An article on fortune.com on 2 May says: "As far back as the 1990s, Charles suggested that he would like to be known as 'the defender of faith', a small but hugely symbolic change from the monarch's traditional title of 'defender of the faith', meaning Christianity.

It's an important distinction for a man who believes in the healing power of yoga and once called Islam 'one of the greatest treasuries of accumulated wisdom and spiritual knowledge available to humanity.'

This way of thinking is the greatest challenge to evangelical Christianity today in countries like Britain as it denies the central message of the Gospel, that there is one way to God through repentance and faith in the Lord Jesus Christ (John 14:6, Acts 4:12).

So how can King Charles defend the truth of the Gospel which teaches the uniqueness of Jesus Christ and the one way to God through repentance and faith in him (John 14:6)?

On the day of the coronation an article appeared in The Spectator by Quanta Ahmed called 'God save our Islamophilic King'. She wrote: "Muslims in Britain and the world over will recognise, in King Charles, a monarch who is deeply Islamophilic.

"He has spoken about his attempts to learn Arabic in order to understand the Quran in its original script. He served as vice-patron of the Oxford Centre for Islamic Studies and has spoken eloquently about Islam and the West, saying the links 'matter more today than ever before'.

"My mother, who grew up in British India, loves to say that Charles III is essentially Muslim – her logic being one must first be a good Christian before one can be a good Muslim. It's an axiom she remembers from the days of empire before we were being told that we are all engaged in a 'clash of civilisations'. As Charles himself put it: 'that which binds our two worlds together is so much more powerful than that which divides us'."

In fact, the teaching of the Quran denies the central Gospel message, that the Lord Jesus is the Son of God, our unique Saviour, who died for our sins and rose from the dead to give us eternal life. As a result, Islam is the main persecutor of believing Christians in the world today.

Secondly, we have Charles's decision to give Camilla the title of Queen and include her in the coronation service. According to Jesus's teaching on divorce and remarriage in Matthew 19:3-9, Charles's present marriage to Camilla is illegitimate on the grounds of his previous adultery. Therefore, she has no right to the title of Queen.

"Weird things" in the coronation

Historian Dr Naomi Wolf has written of "weird things" and "twisted symbols" in the new King's coronation that led her to wonder if it was, surreptitiously, a de-consecration.

a de-consecration. She writes: "Entirely tempering or countering his role as head of the Church of England, at the climax of the Coronation, a half dozen representatives of other faiths surround him. The Greek Orthodox priest, the Roman Catholic priest — the rabbi and others all stand, while King Charles is seated.

"They do not appear as subjects, in a tableau of inclusion, which would be less odd. Rather they surround King Charles from positions of dominance — in a faintly intimidating display of participation in this ritual, or even of religious assertiveness.

"I like inclusion as much as the next person, but this is not the Church of England officiating to consecrate the new Governor of the Church of England in one of the holiest sites for the Church of England.

We note that once before Charles made a solemn vow before God and millions of people, at his wedding to Lady Diana Spencer in 1981. On that occasion he promised to be faithful to one wife, Diana, "till death us do part".

Even at the time of his wedding to Diana, he was seeing Camilla and wanting to be with her. This led to the subsequent marriage breakdown, because there were "three people in that marriage, so it was a bit crowded," as Diana put it in her famous TV interview.

Thirdly, we have to ask about the new King's climate change agenda that has got him involved with WEF (World Economic Forum) and UN plans to work for world government. In her book 'Prince Charles – the sustainable Prince', Joan Veon writes: "Prince Charles has adopted a very radical environmental agenda that calls for a planned society, using the environment and sustainable development as the reason for the change in governance and freedoms."

In 2020 as Prince Charles, he endorsed the pivotal WEF conference where its Chairman Klaus Schwab, whom Charles has known for years, launched the 'Great Reset' agenda, calling for a total reorganisation of our society in order to resolve global crises, in particular the Covid pandemic and the threat of climate change.

Then at the COP 26 UN summit in Glasgow in November 2021, Charles urged world leaders to take urgent action to combat climate change, saying that time is running out. He called for "a vast military style campaign to marshal the strength of the global private sector, with trillions at his (or its) disposal far beyond global GDP, and with the greatest respect, beyond even the governments of the world's leaders. It offers the only real prospect of achieving fundamental economic transition."

Some have interpreted this as Charles making a reference to the coming Antichrist as the one who will bring this to pass. Whether this was what he meant is debatable, but it is clear from this statement that he favours the investment of trillions of dollars in a programme to ef-

fect the fundamental economic change of the present world system, as advocated by the WEF and the UN.

Critics of this programme say it will result in the impoverishment of millions of people, the end of freedom and democracy and lead to a world government along the lines of Revelation 13 (and will do nothing to change the weather). Now that Charles is King, the constraints of his position as constitutional monarch may make it difficult for him to continue to campaign publicly on such matters. But it is unlikely that he will give up his involvement in the programme and he has said that, now he is King, he has a short time in which to achieve much.

In an article for The British Church Newspaper, Tony Bennet wrote: "Charles admires Klaus Schwab and the WEF, [and supports] its one world government agenda. But an increasing number of his subjects wholeheartedly reject that agenda. The Bill of Rights is clear; our sovereigns must ensure that 'no foreign prince, person, prelate, state, or potentate hath, or ought to have, any jurisdiction, power, superiority, pre-eminence, or authority, ecclesiastical or spiritual, within this realm'.

"Will King Charles use his position of influence to defend our nation from foreign powers that seek to destroy us, or collaborate with them? Your Majesty! Where are your loyalties? To us? - or to Klaus Schwab and his WEF friends?"

Good question. I gave a full length talk on this subject the day after the coronation. Perhaps the words, "God save the King", have never been uttered so fervently by Christians in these days.

The Kigali Commitment, signed in 2023, includes these statements:

The current divisions in the Anglican Communion have been caused by radical departures from the Gospel of the Lord Jesus Christ. Such a failure to hear and heed God's Word undermines the mission of the Church as a whole.

The Bible is God's Word written, breathed out by God as it was written by his faithful messengers (2 Timothy 3:16). It carries God's own authority, is its own interpreter, and it does not need to be supplemented, nor can it ever be overturned by human wisdom.

As if presiding over the first royal coronation for 70 years was not enough. the Archbishop of Canterbury is facing a schism in his Church

fter over 1,300 Anglican leaders met in Rwanda in April, they de-cided to reject the Rt Rev Justin Welby's authority as the leader of global Anglicanism.

lowship of Anglican Churches (GSFA) are deeply unhappy about the Church of England's decision to bless the partners in same-sex marriages.

A statement issued by GAFCON said: "We have no confidence that the Archbishop of Canterbury nor the other Instruments of Communion led by him... are able to provide a godly way forward that will be acceptable to those who are committed to the truthfulness, clarity, sufficiency and authority of Scripture.

Premier reports that the Church of England Evangelical Council (CEEC) has welcomed GAFCON and GSFA's decision to work together to "reset" the Anglican Communion. The CEEC also called on the Church of England's bishops to "to step back from the brink" and change their mind on the same-sex issue, to "prevent the unity of the Church of England being torn apart in the same way that the Communion has been"

The bishops' guidance on blessing those in a same-sex relationship will be presented to the General Synod in July

Meanwhile the decision to separate from the compromised Western churches has been welcomed by campaigners such as Dr Lisa Nolland, CEO of the Marriage, Sex and Culture Group, London. After attending the landmark event in Rwanda, Dr Nolland told The Christian Post: "I am rarely optimistic. However, this GAFCON was a game-changer. Majority (Developing)

WHAT IS GAFCON?

GAFCON's first meeting in 2008 saw over 1,000 primates, archbishops, bishops, clergy and lay leaders gather in Jerusalem.

According to GAFCON's website, "moral compromise, doctrinal error and the collapse of biblical witness in parts of the Anglican communion had reached such a level that the leaders of the majority of the world's Anglicans felt it was necessary to take a united stand for truth."

GAFCON's Primates Council represents the majority of the world's Anglicans who meet every five years

After meeting in Kenya in 2013 and again in Jerusalem in 2018, those delegates who could not travel to Jerusalem for political reasons gathered a year later in Dubai for 'G19', a conference for "faithful Christians in 're-stricted situations'." Their final state-ment "spoke powerfully of the sense of betrayal they have experienced when the very Gospel for which they are suffering is being undermined and denied in other parts of the Anglican Communion.²

GAFCON members are bound by their 2008 Jerusalem Declaration.

Key statements include:

We acknowledge God's creation of humankind as male and female and the unchangeable standard of Christian marriage between one man and one woman as the proper place for sexual intimacy and the basis of the family. We repent of our failures to

maintain this standard and call for a renewed commitment to lifelong fidelity in marriage and abstinence for those who are not married.

We reject the authority of those churches and leaders who have denied the orthodox faith in word or deed. We pray for them and call on them to repent and return to the Lord.

HATE OFFENCES BILL 'MOST RADICAL IN HISTORY²

A bill that jeopardises free speech was easily passed in the Dáil Éireann, the lower house of the Irish parliament, in May.

David Thunder, a commentator for Australian news site Mercator, called it "the most radical hate speech law in the history of the Irish state, a law so radical that it could potentially criminalise material in your 'possession' that you have never made public, if that material is deemed by a judge to be liable to incite hatred and you cannot prove it was exclusively for personal use.

If it is not altered by the Seanad (Senate), any speech against "protected catego-ries" could result in prosecution. The vague definitions in the bill mean it is open to varying interpretations by the police and justice system.

The Criminal Justice (Incitement to Violence or Hatred and Hate Offences) Bill 2022 lists the "protected characteristics" as race, colour, nationality, religion, national or ethnic origin, descent, gender, sex characteristics, sexual orientation and disability.

This potentially allows the state to punish citizens who dissent from the prevailing political opinion

The bill means that if the Irish have any wording on their computers that a pros-ecutor believes is "likely to incite violence or hatred' toward one of the protected groups, they may end up with a criminal conviction because it is assumed that the material will be published. The onus is on the defendant to prove to a judge that he or she did not intend to publish the text.

This potentially amounts to making thought a crime and allowing the state to punish citizens who dissent from the prevailing political opinion.

Persecuted politician re-elected

A Finnish politician prosecuted for criticising the Evangelical Lutheran Church of Finland's participation in LGBT Pride events has been re-elected.

Päivi Räsänen was prosecuted for 'hate speech' for tweeting a Bible verse on homosexuality, but won her case in a district court. The judgement stated that "it is not for the district court to interpret biblical concepts". However, the Finnish state prosecutor has launched an appeal



to prosecute Päivi Räsänen for defending biblical orthodoxy

against her acquittal and she will have to appear in court again in August.

Despite all this, Räsänen retained her seat as a Christian Democrat MP in Parliament in the April election. The former Interior Minister has won eight terms (28 years as an MP) in a row, representing the Häme constituency.

She told Evangelical Focus: "We need Christians to defend life and foundational freedoms and rights."

Jessica Bates believes she has been discriminated against because of her opposition to gender ideology

orientation, gender identity, [and] gender expression" of a child in her

ADF Senior Counsel Jonathan Scruggs said Oregon's policy was discriminatory because "people who hold secular or 'progressive' views on sexual orientation and gender identity are eligible to participate in child welfare programs, while people of faith with religiously informed views are disqualified because they don't agree with the state's orthodoxy.

Bates told the Oregon Department of Human Services

(ODHS) that she would "happily love and accept any child" but could not compromise her Christian beliefs.

The organisation which advocates grooming toddlers wants to take control of global health

By HEART staff — Just one man would have the power to over-ride governments and declare a global health emergency if the World Health Organisation's latest proposals are passed at a meeting taking place from 21-**30** May as we went to press.

Campaigners say the proposed Pandemic Treaty would give this UN agency unprecedented power to override na-tional laws and individual rights during "health emergencies"

The proposed treaty has been made more draconian, with the latest version making the regulations legally binding for nations. Worryingly, a clause stating that the regulations should be implemented "with full respect of the dignity of human rights and fundamental freedoms of the person" has been removed. This could lead to forced medical treatments such as vaccinations.

Moreover nations would grant the WHO power to develop new, worldwide surveillance and data-sharing mechanisms, and counter "misinformation and disinformation". Dr Byram Bridle, a Canadian professor pilloried for questioning the Covid

Under common law and Magna Carta Parliament does not have the authority to give British sovereignty to an alien entity

The WHO's Director General could declare a pandemic, enforce lockdowns and make richer countries pay for abortions, sterilisation and vaccinations in less 'developed' nations.

Each nation would have to appoint a 'National Competent Authority' to carry out the WHO's dictates. This entity would be "held accountable" for the "delivery of IHR obligations (International Health Regulations)". The UK has already set up the Health Security Agency during Covid. The WHO's ultimate aim is to adopt the Pandemic Treaty by 2024.

WHO's guidance sexualises children

The World Health Organisation (WHO) recommends guidance for schools which encourages toddlers to "gain an awareness of gender identity" and "enjoyment and pleasure when touching one's own body

Its guidance document states:"From birth, babies learn the value and pleas-ure of bodily contact, warmth and intimacy. Soon after that, they learn what is 'clean' and what is 'dirty'

The Daily Telegraph reported that the Shadow Minister for Education in Wales, parents' organisations, and MPs have expressed outrage. This guidance, first published in 2010, has apparently been rejected by the UK Government who said they do not recognise the WHO guidance or agree with its recommendations.

It has been said that such guidance 'sexualises children and pushes them to engage in sexual discussions.

However, a WHO spokesman told The Telegraph that the organisation "stands by its guidance.

The WHO's guidance was cited in a 2017 report commissioned by Welsh ministers and there is a fear it has informed RSE in schools.

EXCESS DEATHS FROM HEART PROBLEMS IN YOUNGER AGE GROUPS

Dr John Campbell, the professor of nursing whose regular 10-minute video bulletins attract over two million subscribers, quotes the Daily Mirror where from May-December 2022 there were 32,441 excess deaths (non-Covid) among the "Brits

The figure from the ONS (Office for National Statistics) for the week ending 21 April (week 16) is 14,024 deaths which was 22.1% above the national five-year average.

On 28 April (week 17), the figure fell to 13,690 which was 12.9% above the fiveyear average.

According to the Office for Health Improvement and Disparities, these excess

deaths were across ALL age groups: 0-24, 25-49, 50-64, 65-74 and 75-84. The question that has to be asked is why death rates increase in the younger and young working age groups. It was not because they were not taking their statins!

The causes for these deaths were increased in cerebrovascular, ischaemic heart, heart failure and liver disease. Cancer was unchanged.

We know the spike proteins (produced by the vaccine) can have devastating effects on clotting, vascular damage, heart muscle damage and have been associated with liver disease.

MP BRIDGEN CONTINUES TO WARN ABOUT VACCINE HARMS

MP Andrew Bridgen led an adjournment debate in Parliament on 17 March on vaccine harms, deaths and costs.

Although expelled from the Conservative Party for likening the damage from the Covid injections to the Holocaust, he has continued to voice his concerns over the current excess death rates and those whose post-vaccination suffering is not being publicised.

Bridgen asked the House why more is not being done in the UK to investigate and publicise the adverse effects of Covid-19 vaccines that have made billions for 'Big Pharma'. He quoted the unprecedented levels of Yellow Card reports (the updates of which will no longer be publicly reported) and the 63,000 excess deaths in the last 12 months in England and Wales.

One in 800 vaccine boosted people face death or serious injury and to prevent

eted for £8.3 billion. The final cost to the taxpayer of the Government's efforts to purchase and deploy vaccines is uncertain.

After being expelled from the Conservative Party on 12 April he has joined the Reclaim Party founded by Laurence Fox. Bridgen said that he has not lost his conservative values but finds the current Conservative Party has lost its way and is completely unrecognisable.

Bridgen believes that he will be vindicated as further evidence emerges about the harms, lack of safety and efficacy of the Covid jabs.

The psychological and emotional trauma for Israelis and many innocent Arab civilians in the Gaza Strip will linger far longer

It's "all quiet on the Gaza Front" once again.

From 9-13 May Israel's military defence forces had another go at "mowing the grass"... This is the euphemism coined by someone in the military or political echelons some years ago for when Israel uses deadly force to stop the latest barrage of missiles coming from the Gaza Strip, where the Hamas terrorist group rules the roost.

This recent Islamist terrorist escalation actually started on 2 and 3 May when Palestinian Islamic Jihad (PIJ) – with Hamas' backing – fired 104 rockets towards southern Israel from the Gaza Strip. This was in response, PIJ claims, to the death in an Israeli prison of a hunger striking security prisoner and PIJ leader, Khader Adnan.

As always, Israel did briefly respond to this missile attack, but it was limited in scope. This did not go down well with some of the more vocal members of Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu's coalition, who called for a much stronger military response. Many Israelis were also not impressed, especially those who lived in the path of these incoming projectiles and had spent the best part of more than 24 hours in bomb shelters. On 9 May Israel initiated "Operation Shield and Arrow" against PIJ. Precision missile strikes straight away eliminated three senior PIJ leaders, responsible for key aspects of the terror group's activities in the Gaza Strip, but also for their growing influence in Judea and Samaria. By the end of the operation, a further three senior PIJ leaders had been taken out, along with at least 11 other PIJ operatives, and four members of other Hamasaffiliated terror organisations.

Over 1,400 projectiles were fired at Israel

During the five-day operation, over 1,400 projectiles were fired at Israel. Of those, over 1,100 crossed into Israeli territory, and 440 of those were intercepted by Israel's air defence system, which had a 96% success rate. A few missiles evaded the Iron Dome defence system, and there were Israeli casualties – including two fatalities – and property damage as a result. The other projectiles out of that 1,100 fell in unpopulated areas, where actual damage would be minimal.

While not in any way downplaying the loss of life and damage, all these statistics sound wonderful. Israel's air defence system is a marvel of modern warfare and the envy of many other nations.

But what the numbers do not convey is that well over two million Israelis – including, for the first time in a long time, citizens of Tel Aviv and Jerusalem – lived in constant dread of Red Alert sirens and warnings on their smartphones, with many holed up in bomb shelters for the duration of the conflict. The psychological and emotional trauma for them, as well as for many innocent Arab civilians in the Gaza Strip, will linger far longer.

However, in addition to this latest flare-up, there is now in Israel a much deeper awareness that behind PIJ, Hamas and all the other Islamist terror entities in both the Gaza Strip, and increasingly in Judea and Samaria, is the Islamic revolutionary regime in Iran. Iran finances, supplies weaponry, and in many ways directs much of this terror activity against Israel and all its citizens: of that fact there is now no doubt.

Iran is the puppet master pulling the strings of terror groups

So as Prime Minister Netanyahu and his coalition try to get their proposed budget through the Knesset – a necessity by 29 May or the government falls – they must contend with the stark reality that not only is Iran well on the way to nuclear weapons capability, but at the same time it is the puppet master pulling the strings of most of the terror groups in all the nations that surround Israel and want to wipe her off the map...whatever the cost.

The God of Israel promises multiple times in his Word that such a thing will never happen, and he stays true to his Word...no matter what. We will have to wait and see how he fulfils those promises.



CIVILIAN LIFE — AND DEATH

Not all civilians managed to reach their bomb shelters in time to escape rocket fire.

An 80-year-old grandmother in Rehovot in southern Israel was killed when a terrorist rocket struck her apartment building. Mike Evans of the Jerusalem Prayer Team reported: "She was trying to get her paralysed husband into the reinforced room that serves as their bomb shelter, but the ceiling collapsed, leaving him injured and her dead." He adds: "Every day new attacks are

He adds: "Every day new attacks are being launched against innocent Jewish men, women, and children. Sometimes it is rockets raining down death from the skies. Sometimes it is a gun or a knife. Sometimes it is a car being driven into a crowd."

While residents of Jerusalem and Tel Aviv experienced attack for the first time, it is commonplace for the inhabitants of towns like Sderot in southern Israel where many are poor Russian immigrants.

Repentance for our neglect will not necessarily be widespread but in the words of Jude in his letter to the churches: "Let us contend earnestly for the faith entrusted once for all to the saints" (Jude 1:3).

Jude, whose letter inspired me to write, exhorts us also in our endeavours for the Kingdom: to keep ourselves in the love of God as we await the mercy of our Lord Jesus Christ to bring us to eternal life; to have mercy on those who doubt, save others by snatching them from the fire, and to still others show mercy tempered with fear (Jude 20-23). This earnest warning from Jesus's

This earnest warning from Jesus's half-brother, is for us to reach as many as we can in these final days and hours of history, with the Good News of salvation through our risen Saviour and the prophesied coming of the Kingdom of God. The imminence of the tribulation and the anticipated revealing of the false Messiah emphasises the urgency of the message to those who are deceived into putting their faith and hopes in the New World Order, whether their sustainable Utopia or a new political and even religious reformation! Maranatha!

BRITAIN'S BETRAYAL

<u>As the 75th anniversary of Israel's rebirth approaches, let us</u> not forget that while British Bible believers prepared Israel for statehood, we then stopped listening to God

The rebirth of Israel 75 years ago clearly showed the hand of God at work, but it could not have happened without Britain's involvement.

Looking back to the century preceding the rise of the Jewish state, Britain had gained such worldwide influence that it was said the sun never set on our empire.

Certainly not everything we did historically was good, but we did succeed in spreading the Gospel of the Jewish Messiah far and wide, and there is no question that it had a civilising and hugely beneficial effect.

And just as proclaiming the Gospel was a key factor in blessing China, Africa, India and elsewhere, so our determination to facilitate the restoration of Israel was cut from a similar cloth.

Evangelical preachers and politicians were the prime influence on British government policies leading to the Balfour Declaration and the subsequent internationally-backed Mandate to prepare the Jewish people for statehood.

But we soon broke our pledge and betrayed Israel, as a result of which we have lost our moral moorings. The miracle of modern Israel came about anyway.

But after doing so much to promote her restoration, we subsequently moved in precisely the opposite direction.

Appeasing Arab opposition to Jewish immigration most likely led to the death of hundreds of thousands, if not millions, of Jews who could have escaped Hitler's concentration camps through emigration to Palestine, as it was then known.

In addition, post-war Britain went out of its way to ensure the new state would not survive, even appointing a British officer, Lt Gen Sir John Bagot Glubb, to command the Jordanian Arab Legion.

In her disobedience to God long ago, Israel was sold into the hands of her enemies (Judges 2:14), and it appears that Britain is suffering the same fate today. We own few of our major industries or football clubs, for one thing; and we have presided over a steep decline in churchgoing while Islam – the antithesis of Christianity in so many



The 'gates of hell' at Caesarea Philippi to which Jesus may have referred when challenging his disciples over his authority (Matthew 16:18), which remains at the heart of the battle of Middle Eastern politics. For Israel belongs to God. Pagan culture at the time of Jesus saw this giant cave as the entrance to the realm of the dead. Interestingly, the huge earthquakes which shook Turkey, Syria, and parts of Israel's Mediterranean coast in March 2023 stopped at the 'gates of hell'

ways, particularly with regard to freedom – has established an extraordinarily strong foothold in the nation.

Hugely respected Bible teacher Derek Prince in 2003 saw "very little hope for Britain" and repeated his warning that "the nation not serving Israel would perish" (Isaiah 60:12).

The British Government's response to the latest outrage – the brutal murder by Palestinian terrorists of a British-Israeli rabbi's wife and two of their daughters – is indicative of no real change in our attitudes with a spineless, lily-livered call for Israel and Hamas to 'de-escalate tensions' as if the fault runs equally both ways.

We soon broke our pledge and betrayed Israel, as a result of which we have lost our moral moorings

We stopped listening to the evangelicals, who believe in the authority of Scripture. Now, instead of spreading the Gospel around the globe, we have become leading exporters of degrading morality as stable society and family life collapses around our ears. And our priests, like those who brought Jesus to trial, are spitting in his face and crucifying him all over again.

In the words of Rev Calvin Robinson,

our bishops are promoting the idea of 'sacramental sodomy', referring to the Church of England's decision to bless same-sex marriage.

The murky moral quagmire into which Britain has sunk can, I suggest, be traced back to the time when we began treating the people who gave us the Bible with contempt.

But instead of supporting Israel through our politics, our prayers and our goodwill born of a Christian ethos, we have exported our rebellious ways, encouraged rainbow flag-waving and pushed anti-God propaganda wherever we can. Now it seems that believing the Bible, as a strong contingent of Israel's new government do, has become the ultimate blasphemy.

There is a flicker of light on the horizon, however. In Britain, as in Israel, Bible believers are fighting back with forthright faith.

Rev Robinson, in an Oxford Union debate, said: "Our purpose as clerics is to lead people away from sin, not embrace it... Sin is the problem, not the sinner."

We were once a great nation sending missionaries around the world to share the nation-changing good news of Jesus. Yet now we have thrown out our most precious possession. Jesus told us to build on the rock. But we have built on sand.

<u>'DOUBLE STANDARD'</u> <u>ON ANTISEMITISM</u>

Home Secretary Suella Braverman is concerned that a 'double standard' exists when it comes to antisemitism, which must not be treated as 'racism-lite'. She added: "Racism that would be called out if it were directed against any other minority is explained away or ignored when it comes to Jews. We need to be really clear. Antisemitism is not racism-lite. It's racism."

BEREAVED RABBI SPEAKS OUT AFTER BRUTAL MURDERS

Britain's Jewish community was in profound shock after two sisters and their mother were brutally gunned down by Palestinian terrorists in Israel.

Rina and Maia Dee, aged 15 and 20, died at the scene after being shot at point-blank range and their mother Lucy later succumbed to her injuries in hospital.

Father and husband Leo Dee, who witnessed the shocking scene as he was following in a separate car, was formerly a senior rabbi at Radlett United Synagogue in Hertfordshire and assistant rabbi in Hendon, north London. The family moved to Israel in 2014.

In a statement following the tragedy, Leo referred to the anti-government protests in Israel.

"Some people think a religious government will suppress minority rights and become totalitarian," he said. "But this is not a risk in Israel as religious Jews simply believe in balancing love and justice."

He said humanity has lost the ability to differentiate between good and evil as a "small minority" has peddled moral relativism, which he compared to a cocaine addiction where the addict keeps magnifying the problem.

"Let's reverse this negative loop," he said. "We will never accept terror as legitimate... There is no such thing as moral equivalence between terrorists and victims. The terrorist is always bad."

He was referring to calls from politicians for both sides of the conflict to reduce tension as if blame for the atrocity went both ways.

DOCTOR JOKES About Gassing Jews

A junior doctor who joked about gassing Jews has been suspended from his executive post on the British Medical Association pending an investigation.

Dr Martin Whyte, a paediatrician and deputy chair of the junior doctors' committee, is reported to have found videos about the Holocaust being a hoax "pretty convincing". The committee has been coordinating recent strikes in pursuit of a 35 per cent pay rise.

LIFE AND DEATH CONTRAST

Israel's Economy Minister Nir Barkat, meanwhile, noted how the Dee family's decision to donate the mother's organs further accentuated the difference between the values of Jews and those of the terrorists who try to murder them. A Palestinian was among seven recipients.

Palestinian was among seven recipients. Speaking to CNN, Barkat said: "That's the difference between living as Jews, seeking life and making a better life for other people, and the terrorists, who all they seek is death."

Lucy Dee's organs offered life-saving hope to critically ill people while the terrorists (or their families) can expect to receive a million dollars from the Palestinian Authority for killing innocent Jews.

In the wake of these shocking murders, which also included an Italian tourist on the same weekend, calls were made for the sacking of a UN official who claimed that Israel had no right to self-defence against Palestinian terrorism. Francesca Albanese, the UN Special Rapporteur on the Occupied Palestinian Territories, has a long history of antisemitism.

The Guardian and Times newspapers also came under fire for their skewed reporting of these attacks. And Lee has since called on The Guardian to fire cartoonist Martin Rowson, accused of fostering antisemitism with his caricature of departing BBC chairman Richard Sharp, a Jew.

She heads this year's Forbes billionaire list of the world's richest women, with handbag and perfume magnate Bernard Arnault knocking Elon Musk off the men's list, meaning the world's richest man and woman are both French for the first time.

SWASTIKA CUT INTO BOY'S BACK

The FBI is investigating a shocking crime involving a large swastika cut into an autistic boy's back in a Nevada school.

The mother of the 17-year-old, who does not speak and attends the Clark High School in Las Vegas with both a service dog and a shadow, said: "My son is the only student I know of who wears a kippah at the school," adding that his assistant is apparently still working there. "Her job is to be with my son. If she did not do [the etched mark], I believe she knows who did."

A spokeswoman for the Anti-Defamation League pointed out: "Not only was this student targeted for his identifiable faith, but he was particularly vulnerable due to his disability."

Initial complaints generated no response and the FBI got involved after the Israeli American Council intervened. They have a website called School Watch monitoring the growing number of anti-Jewish incidents and reporting that a startling 75% of Israeli-Americans encounter antisemitism in school. to hold in the cosmetics firm, which she inherited as sole heiress upon her mother's death in 2017.

Raised a strict Catholic, she is a respected Bible scholar and has written books on topics ranging from Greek mythology to Jewish-Christian relations.

She is married to Jean-Pierre Meyers, grandson of a rabbi murdered at Auschwitz, and they have two children. Her marriage caused controversy as her grandfather, a pharmacist who invented a hair dye called L'Oreal in 1907, was put on trial for 'economic and political collaboration' with the Nazis during World War II, but was later cleared of the charges by a Parisian post-war court.

Her socialite mother and former Cabinet minister father Andre Bettencourt were known for throwing exclusive parties. But Françoise does not indulge in the same glamorous lifestyle, preferring to play the piano or write. She has been labelled a 'serious minded intellectual' by Time magazine and pledged £160 million to repair Notre Dame Cathedral after it was ravaged by a fire in 2019.

TV PRESENTERS GLORIFY TERROR

Two exiled Egyptian television presenters are using their 'safe haven' in Britain to glorify terror and broadcast anti-Israeli propaganda, a Jewish Chronicle investigation revealed.

revealed. Osama Gaweesh defended Hamas as "the resistance" while his colleague Moataz Matar called the murder of former Radlett Rabbi Leo Dee's wife and daughters "an operation by the resistance". Between them they regularly

Between them, they regularly reach millions of viewers via satellite TV and their social media channels.

ANTISEMITIC 'MASS MURDER' WARNING

Antisemitism will only ultimately be beaten when Jesus returns, a spokesman for Chosen People Ministries told a Zoom meeting in Britain.

Speaking from the United States, Olivier Melnick, a Jewish believer originally from France, warned Christians that "we could be inches away from mass murder of Jews," which is where things are headed due to worrying factors such as apathy, misinformation and people getting away with outrageous insults.

A particularly worrying factor was that antisemitism was not on the radar of most Christians as they did not consider themselves affected by it. "But silence is complicity," said Ol-

"But silence is complicity," said Olivier, reminding participants of German pastor Martin Niemoller's famous quote, suggesting that if we did not stand up for others, there would be no-one left to speak for us.

Melnick cited a recent case in France where a man has walked free for throwing a Jewish woman out of the window to her death on the basis that he was high on cannabis, whereas French law dictates that you can be imprisoned for simply throwing a pet out of the window.

He further warned that some may soon be forced into civil disobedience when the law no longer protected Jews, citing the case of Anne Frank in Nazi-occupied Holland. "Those who hid Anne Frank were breaking the law; those who killed her were following the law."

Antisemitism, he said, would "only be fully dealt with when Jesus returns. But we must fight it; we must be vocal against it."

Doing so also enables us to build bridges with the Jewish people and earns us the right to speak to them about Jesus – many Jews are still under the impression that the church was complicit in antisemitism over the centuries.

ISLAMIC WORLD CALLED TO UNITE AGAINST ISRAEL

Turkish president Recep Tayyip Erdogan has called on the Islamic world to unite "against Israel's attacks in Palestine" in a message to his Iranian counterpart Ebrahim Raisi. It came in the wake of clashes on the Temple Mount followed by missiles and rockets launched by Hamas from Israel's northern and southern borders.

Nonetheless, Dr Chapman is a humble man, who clearly loves his call and purpose, which is to help married couples simply fall in love with each other afresh every day. Based on the simple concept that

Based on the simple concept that each of us has a primary love language, which when 'spoken' – or, more often, acted upon – fills up our emotional "love tanks," in his book Dr Chapman helps couples identify, understand, and speak their spouse's primary love language:

- quality time
- words of affirmation
- gifts
- acts of service
 physical touch

Written to address the complexities of relationships in today's world, 'The 5 Love Languages®' book and website provide a love language quiz for a couple that pinpoints their primary love language, what it means, and how it can be used to connect with their spouse to bring intimacy and fulfilment.

While serving with his wife as Associate Pastor in Calvary Baptist Church over five decades, Dr Chapman counselled married couples and produced small booklets with ideas which came from the difficulties these couple underwent in their relationship. This is how Dr Chapman discovered the five 'love languages'.

The entire human race speaks these five love languages

He believes that we develop our primary and secondary love language very early in life, and you can tell a child's primary love language by the time they are four by just observing their behaviour. However, Dr Chapman is unsure what part is nature and what part is nurture, because parental responses can influence a child.

Our primary and secondary love languages typically remain constant over a lifetime, but there are seasons and circumstances in life where another love language may become more important.

"In every child and adult, there is an emotional love tank, and when the love tank is full, life is beautiful but when empty, life looks pretty dark", says Dr Chapman, who suggests a game for married couples. On a scale of one to

ten, how full is your love tank? If they say a low number, the partner asks,

What can I do to help to fill it?" The chances are the partner will give away their primary love language throughout this game. If your partner will not play, you can observe their behaviour to discover his or her primary love language on your own, or you can listen to what they complain about or request most of the time.

Although couples may apologise to each other, some spouses do not believe they are truly sorry

Dr Chapman admitted he was surprised at requests to print the book in over 50 different languages, because his study of anthropology had shown him a myriad of social and cultural differences. As they all went on to become bestsellers in those countries. it confirmed to him that the entire human race speaks these five love languages, for what is appropriate for them in their respective dialects.

When Dr Chapman wrote his bestselling book, it was specifically to attract non-Christians.

"Moody Publishing, being a Christian publishing house, did not mention God on purpose, knowing Christians already knew God is love and were aware about where the proverbs mentioned in the book came from the Bible'

He went on to write a book called, 'God Speaks your Love Language' which he ends with, "I have given you how to love, but I can't give you motivation." Then he reveals how

the love of God motivated him to love others, through the power of the Holy Spirit.

I was amazed and very moved at how creative Dr Chapman is and the extra miles he still goes to help married couples in every situation. For a husband and wife separated by work, Dr Chapman helps them put physical touch into practice by asking them to draw around their hand on a piece of paper, send it with a note to their spouse, saying, "put your hand on my mine, I want to hold your hand."

A soldier serving away from home did just this and told Dr Chapman that he

felt his wife's hand (emotionally). Also, it is much easier today to watch the same film with your spouse over face-time.

Many young people struggle in the area of love and most do not want to get married these days, as they may have grown up feeling unloved; not necessarily because their parents did not love them, but they did not communicate their love language to them. Also, many have experienced the pain of divorce either observing their parents or someone else's. Dr Chapman said, "Loneliness is a huge factor in our culture today."

His latest book, 'The Five Apology

Languages', was first titled, 'When Sorry isn't Enough,' but they later changed it to complement 'The Five Love Languages'. It was inspired by a female counsellor, who suggested that although couples may apologise to each other, some spouses do not believe they are truly sorry.

Dr Chapman and his team worked with married couples to ask what the spouse actually wanted to hear their spouse say when they apologise and broke it down into five segments. Typically, we learn to apologise through our parents, so we grow up with what we have learnt. In the US, about 90% do not apologise and most were men and they learnt it through their fathers, who told them, "Real men do not apologise". Dr Chapman went on to state, "Real men DO apologise."

new report says that Russian forces are repressing churches in the occupied areas of Ukraine.

According to Release International, the Institute for the Study of War (ISW) report states: "Russia continues to weaponise religion... Since Russia's fullscale invasion of Ukraine in February 2022, Russian soldiers or occupation authorities have reportedly committed at least 76 acts of religious persecution in Ukraine.'

The attacks include closing or taking over places of worship, looting, desecrating and destroying other churches, and the capture or murder of 29 religious leaders.

The report claims the repression is "part of a deliberate campaign to systematically eradicate 'undesirable' religious organisations in Ukraine and promote the Moscow Patriarchate".

The campaign is an extension of the situation in Russia, where churches are restricted by the state unless they are Russian Orthodox.

Release International CEO Paul Robinson says: "The report describes of ล campaign state-sanctioned religious systematic religious persecution, targeting Ukrainian Orthodox, Baptists, persecution, Evangelicals and others.

UGANDA **PASTOR AND** STUDENT KILLED

astor Adinani Bulwa was taken from his home in eastern Uganda in March and killed by Muslim family members because of his faith.

Morning Star News reports that Pastor Bulwa, 42, had fled northern Uganda because of Muslim opposition and returned home to Muterere village in Bugiri District in January, but was killed on 10 March in his own village.

In April, a Christian college student was killed in northern Uganda for sharing his faith with Muslims, after receiving death threats. Jeremiah Mwanga, a second-year student at the Uganda Christian School of Professionals in Lira, Northern Region, was killed in his room at the school. He was 24.

It is strange that Nigeria is not already declared a CPC. The USCIRF has been highlighting persecution in Nigeria since 2009, and has criticised the State Department for leaving Nigeria off its list.

Release International shares USCIRF's concerns, but points out that the USCIRF report overlooks the horrendous attacks on Christian villages by Fulani herdsmen.

The USCIRF decision to call for India to become a CPC is supported by Release International's own findings, which are outlined in its annual Persecution Trends report. USCIRF states: "Religious freedom conditions in India continue to worsen. Throughout the year, the Indian government at the national, state, and local levels promoted and enforced religiously discriminatory policies, including laws targeting religious conversion.'

And in May, an outbreak of communal violence in India's northeastern state of Manipur saw as many as 35 churches burned down in a tribal dispute. A source in the country told Premier: "Inflammatory remarks made by a Meitei Christian pastor have sparked religious tensions, resulting in the burning of churches belonging to both Meitei and Kuki communities.

HUNDREDS MORE MASSACRED

The deadly attacks on Christians in Nigeria are continuing unabated.

In March, Fulani herdsmen and other terrorists killed around 30 Christians in Kaduna State. In April, Islamic extremists killed a pastor in Borno State. Rev Yakubu Shuaibu of the Church of the Brethren in Nigeria was shot dead in his house, and his pregnant wife wounded.

Also in April, terrorists from the Islamic State West Africa Province (ISWAP) killed 134 Christians in the country's middle belt state of Benue, and over 11 days Fulani herdsmen killed 18 people and wounded others in the predominantly Christian villages of Plateau State. On 16 April, Fulani herdsmen killed 12 Christians in Nasarawa State, central Nigeria. A pastor's house was among at least 86 homes burned down.

UK-based Release International has been told that the Nigerian military has been turning a blind eye to the attacks. They have heard reports that Nigerian troops are standing by while Christian villagers are slaughtered in plain sight of the soldiers. The charity is offering churches a resource pack which includes information and stories to focus prayer.

SUDAN CHRISTIANS IN PERIL

he civil war in Sudan has had a disastrous impact on the civilian population, and as a minority group Christians are in a more perilous situation than most. The Open Doors charity reports

that Christians are facing starvation as well as bombs and bullets, and that "most believers are day labourers and have no emergency funds to fall back on... Some believers have been caught in the crossfire. More widely, years of division and persecution combined with most believers living in poverty - have left the Church in Sudan in a fragile state.'

The charity called on churches abroad to pray for "the provision of food and medical aid to all those in need, and for the safety of all people. That Christians will unite and grow in faith during this time, and that God will use them as instruments of peace across the country.

There is also a fear that Islamists will take advantage of the chaos to take charge and impose Sharia law, which will add persecution to poverty.

Maureen Martin was "treated appallingly" for declaring that marriage between a man and woman is best

Christian politician has been victorious in court after being sacked by her employer for her Christian beliefs.

Maureen Martin - mayoral candidate for Lewisham in 2022 – was dismissed by London & Quadrant Housing Trust (L&Q) following complaints of "hate speech". In April 2022, the ordained minister was lambasted on social media for stating in her manifesto that "natural marriage between a man and a woman is the fundamental building block for a successful society, and the safest environment for raising children".

According to Premier, her plight caused 42,000 people to sign a petition calling on the government to amend the Employment Rights Act 1996 to protect free speech.

Supported by the Christian Legal Centre (CLC), Martin took L&Q to court for discrimination and won a substantial pay-out at the end of April.

TEACHER FIRED FOR OPPOSING **GENDER TRANSITION**

School ignored teacher's safeguarding concerns

teacher sacked for questioning her school's treatment of an eight-year-old with gender confusion is taking legal action.

The primary schoolteacher re-ferred to as 'Hannah' (to protect her identity) not only lost her job but faces reprisals from the school that could prevent her from ever working as a teacher again.

'Hannah' objected when the school accepted that the girl wanted to be-come a boy and allowed her to use boys' toilets and changing rooms.

Supported by the Christian Le-gal Centre, the teacher followed the school's own whistleblowing procedure when a teacher feels safeguarding regulations have been breached. As her concerns were ignored, 'Hannah' then brought a claim for judicial review against the school and council.

The school allowed a girl to use boys' toilets and changing rooms

The school then fired the teacher for divulging confidential information to her lawyers and the court, reported her to the Information Commissioner for a criminal offence under the Data Protection Act, to the Teaching Regulation Agency (TRA) and the Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS). The TRA could ban her from the profession for life.

Now working in a sandwich bar, 'Hannah' is taking the school to an employment tribunal for unfair dismissal and religious discrimination.

She told Christian Concern: "From day one I believe that I acted in Child X's best interests as I had a legitimate belief that the treatment of Child X amounted to a serious safeguarding issue... Teachers are being bullied not to question trans affirming policies when evidence shows that the actual result of the approach is to put the welfare of children at serious risk.

"5G IS A NIGHTMARE"



Dr Barrie Trower, a former Royal Navy microwave weapons expert and MI5 scientist, has said that 5G is a "particularly dangerous frequency because of its high resonance", and is "mathematically so complex nobody can actually predict its harm."

Trower said that the upper end of the scale of microwaves used by 5G is very close to the frequency used by a new electromagnetic military weapon, nicknamed the 'Growler'. This sends frequencies from aeroplanes or vehicles that very quickly destroy the body's neurological and physiological systems.

It is "absolute rubbish" to claim that 5G's power is different to the Growler's, Trower said, because "with all microwaves a long low dose can be equally, even more dangerous, than a short high dose."

Moreover, he declares: "Anyone who puts 5G into a school should be locked up."

CITIZENS TAKING ACTION

Citizens' action groups are campaigning against having 5G masts put up in their area. For 5G to work, there need to be masts every 500 metres.

Two towns in Massachusetts have blocked the installation of 5G cell towers until independent research has confirmed the new high-powered technology is safe. The US's Federal Communications Commission (FCC) has not acted on court orders issued in 2019 and 2021 to review its health and safety guidelines for RF (radiofrequency) exposure. In the 2019 ruling, the FCC was told to follow the National Environmental Policy Act guidelines and conduct an environmental impact review on 5G technology, and the court issued a fresh mandate in 2021 that requires the FCC to review all the scientific evidence about the safety of RF radiation on people and the environment.

The rulings follow a challenge by the non-profit Children's Health Defense after the FCC had refused to update its safety guidelines issued in 1996. In the UK, 5G Action groups connect via Facebook and advise on applications for masts so that residents can oppose them.

PRECAUTIONS TO PROTECT YOURSELF

Retired GP Dr Alistair Montgomery listened to a seminar on 5G from the Live Better Group in Northern Ireland

I have heard more scientific presentations on the history of EMF (electro-magnetic frequency) radiation and the science behind it, but the presenter did recommend two books though which would be worth reading: 'EMF-*D' by Dr Joseph Mercola and 'Radiation Nation' by David T Debaum and Ryan P Debaum.

- My take-home messages from the two plus hours were:
- EMF is everywhere and can cause depression, fatigue, cancer, lower immunity to infection, and many other illnesses through cell toxicity and mitochondrial health.
- The onus is on us to protect ourselves.
- The safety standards for EMF radiation were set in 1996 based on studies done in the 1980s when mobile phones were using G1 (Generation 1) and G2 and their power output was a fraction of what they are now.
- The industry has not carried out any safety studies on the effect of 5G.
- Modern cell phones like the iPhone 11 and Samsung G8 are emitting radiation 400-500 times (iPhone 7.15 watts/kilo, Samsung 8 watts/kilo) higher than the recommended rate of 1.6 watts/ kilo (this is "Specific Absorption Rate), which was based on exposure to a human whose head size was in the top 3% so bears no relation to the average human or a child.
- He showed scans of the brain heating up when a mobile phone was held to the head of an adult, child, and young child a child's skull is much thinner than an adult's, so heat penetrates deeper.
- In China pregnant women are encouraged to wear protective EMF aprons, France bans wi-fi in primary schools, and the WHO classifies EMF as a class 2 carcinogen risk, along with tobacco. In Israel cell phones come with a warning that they can damage children's health.
- He claims children using cell phones have a 400% higher risk of brain tumours and leukaemia and EMF exposure in pregnancy causes reduced fetal head and chest size. No references were given, although a fact sheet was going to be sent out.
- EMF is everywhere, in mobile phones, cordless home phones, microwave ovens, smart meters, smart watches, Alexa and any Bluetooth device, fridges, electric blankets, baby monitors, fluorescent light bulbs, smart TV's. Your fridge is one of the biggest EMF emitters in your home.
- 5G is in a different league and should be resisted. Apparently, with G1 it would take four months and 27 hours to download a Star Wars film; 5G would take 1.5 seconds.
- 5G also brings the capability of the State to monitor everyone's movements and purchases, identify them using facial recognition and control them through central digital currency and social credit scores as in China.
- The link between 5G and Covid is speculative, but if the immune system was weakened by 5G then you would be more susceptible to becoming ill on exposure to a virus. Wuhan had a high 5G coverage which may have weakened the population's immunity.
- Elon Musk wants to put thousands of 5G satellites into orbit that will 'fry' us.
- Protecting oneself is through reducing your exposure time and increasing the distance between you and a source. The power falls off as the inverse square of the distance. He advises hard-wiring your house with ethernet cables, and turning off wi-fi (and keep your router in a different room to your bedroom). You can get USB to ethernet cables for laptops without an RJ45 socket.
 Put your phone on aeroplane mode overnight.

The seminar ended with some expensive products for sale that could, in theory, protect you from EMFs. However, there was only anecdotal evidence for their effectiveness!

Dealings with other statesmen and nasty neighbours -Netanyahu's biography teaches us much about modern Israel's recent history

Bibi, My Story

t is important for Christians, in these end days, to understand the Jewish people and the state of Israel and this autobiography of Israel's longest serving prime minister will be on many people's wish list, because it will teach you so much about events from Israel's rebirth in 1948 till now.

Although 723 pages long, it is easy to read. Netanyahu's nickname since childhood has been Bibi, hence the title. Just don't expect anything negative written about Bibi and his achievements in his autobiography. Humility is not one of his attributes.

Really it is many stories in one book, beginning with how Bibi's parents and grandparents pushed for the establishment of the state of Israel and were involved in its founding. Netanyahu writes about his army experiences and covers the tragic death of his brother Yoni, when Israeli commandos, including Bibi and Yoni, stormed a plane holding Jewish hostages in Entebbe, Uganda.

Then the book moves on to Bibi's career, seeing him become Finance Minister, then Prime Minister.

Despite the pressures of being PM, Netanyahu tells us he studied the Torah portion with his son, Avner, every week until he was 12. He writes: "As war broke out, Sara (Bibi's wife) would not let anything interfere with these sessions. She guarded those private times with our boys as a lioness guards her cubs".

When re-elected Prime Minister in 2009, the family decided, like other Jewish families, that Friday night dinner together was sacrosanct, "a tradition we kept throughout my years in office", he writes. Previous Israeli Prime Ministers had held a Bible Study group in the Prime Minister's office and he continued the practice.

He describes the encouragement Christians gave him as he had difficult negotiations with the likes of Presidents Clinton and Obama.

Writing of the challenges of dealing with Israel's Middle East neighbours,

Netanyahu refers to an occasion when he was speaking at the United Nations General Assembly in 2009. It was soon after Iran's then President, Mahmoud Ahmadinejad, had declared the Holocaust was a lie.

As Netanyahu spoke, he held up a document from the official Wannsee Conference in which Nazi officials planned the final solution. "Is this a lie?" he asked.

Producing the original building plans for Auschwitz, signed off by Hitler's deputy, Heinrich Himmler, he asked, "Is this a lie too?"

He commended the delegates who had walked out on Ahmadinejad and attacked the delegates who stayed. "How could they not call him out on this monstrous lie? Have you no decency? Have you no shame?"

He tells us that to this day, Iran still holds an annual denial festival, and is dedicated to the extermination of the six

million Jews who live in Israel. What makes the book so interesting are the anecdotes he shares of his meetings with world leaders. When Margaret Thatcher attended a Knesset dinner in 1998, there was a long line of distinguished speakers for the dinner guests to listen to, before they could enjoy their meal.

At last Mrs Thatcher rose to speak. She said, "I have never lost an election and that is because I can read a crowd. This crowd (referring to the people attending the dinner) is hungry. As a woman and a mother I say, 'Serve dinner'. She sat down and the people cheered."

If you are like me, there will be much to cheer in this book!

Published in March 2023, 'When Church Hurts' comes from the first-hand experience of ordained pastor Colin Mason, who trained as a counsellor and has worked voluntarily with adult survivors of sexual abuse.

'When Church Hurts' will not be for everyone. But if you are someone who has suffered at the hands of church leaders, or you know of someone who has, I recommend this book to you. Helpfully, Colin Mason starts by taking us through what godly leadership should look like. He backs up everything he writes with Scripture. Then he contrasts it with ungodly leadership. I had not realised how much

the Scriptures had to say on the subject. In chapter four, titled 'Twisted Scripture', he writes: "A leader may either ignorantly misinterpret the Scripture because they do not have the correct understanding, or purposely use it to manipulate others for their personal agenda."

From his counselling experience, he highlights specific Scriptures which are often 'twisted' to subjugate others, such as Philippians 2:12, Psalm 105:15, Numbers 12:1-11, and many more. He writes: "Twisting and manipulating the Scripture is not a new phenomenon but something that has happened over the centuries". He shows how slave owners used the Scriptures to subdue slaves.

The next chapter highlights sexual exploitation by leaders, including Sunday school teachers, house group leaders, even choir directors. He examines the story of King David, considers the temptation, the lust, the sin, and the consequences.

He particularly draws out how sin by the

leader is what God condemns, rather than the other person's sin. He highlights how adults who have been sexually victimised by a beloved priest, pastor, minister, rabbi or other clergy will remain the "silent majority of clergy sexual abuse victims, suffering in their shame and self-isolation."

Before Colin Mason finishes, he shares his own story. I won't spoil the book by telling you what he wrote, but I sat with my mouth wide open as I read of his own experiences as a child and teenager.

This is one book that is so important for the Church today. There is no condemnation for the victims, but it might open the eyes of abused people to understand how they have been manipulated and used by church leaders. If you know someone who has suffered at the hands of church leaders, I encourage you to buy a copy and pass it on to them in love.

When a book arrives and the author is unknown to me, I look to see who has written the foreword. In this instance it was written by Clive Urquhart, Senior Pastor of Kingdom Faith Church.

He says he has known Sarah for 35 years and, "At the heart of Sarah's life has been a strong desire to know Jesus ... to live out what she is spurring us on to live, through what she writes in these pages".

Sarah gives us glimpses of her life: married for 30 years, she loves working with the teens and 20s. As a young believer who had joined a ministry full-time, she saw a powerful move of God with hundreds of predominantly young people committing their lives to Christ.

say. Take 'The Orphan Spirit' chapter. Sarah shares her personal journey of feeling abandoned as a child and brings out how Joseph in the Old Testament must have felt loneliness and rejection when his brothers sold him, and he ended up in prison.

She maintains that many in today's Church today feel like orphans, starved of love, care and affection. "It is time to let those who are orphaned know that there is a worldwide family waiting to embrace them!"

As Sarah reminds us, Esther 4:14 says: "Yet who knows whether you have come to the kingdom for such a time as this?"

onfined to the spare bedroom while I dealt with Covid, my wife felt I should be entertained by Francine Rivers. The fact is, I've become a bit of an addict for her novels. Blame it on the feminine side of my nature.

But 'The Lady's Mine' is more than a romantic novel. It tackles serious current issues such as homelessness and caring for the needy, especially orphans and widows. And, as usual, with a strong sense of biblical correctness.

Set in a late 19th century mining town in northern California (where the author lives), this story will have you turning pages faster than you can blink an eye. All of which is great credit to this brilliant writer, who brings delightful humour, along with profound skill and depth of insight, into her many extraordinary characters and plots.

Francine Rivers demonstrates how just one person can make an amazing difference to a community, with God's help and direction of course. And redemption is always on offer to whatever situation seems hopeless.

The plight of women - without votes or rights - is the key theme here. And its heroine, Kathryn Walsh, single-handedly challenges the assumption that women can't run newspapers - or mines for that matter.

Delightful humour, along with profound skill and depth of insight

Though portrayed as the most beautiful young woman ever seen on the west side of the Rockies, and outnumbered multiple times over by the male species digging for precious metal, she is determined never to marry – because it would be relinquishing what few rights she has. But she is up against a very patient man - clearly the nicest saloon owner in the Sierra Nevada mountains.

For me, the story's most intriguing and inspiring aspect was Kathryn's feisty journalistic efforts. After resurrecting the newspaper founded by her late father, she uses it in the best possible way - to expose unrighteous work practices and encourage support for the dispossessed.

It's a heart-warming story that is also honouring to the Lord, edifying and challenging. A literary work of art. And set in the Wild West! Who needs a movie?

An evil manifesto

Susette McLachlan's letter effectively justifying Russia's aggressive and genocidal war against Ukraine reads like a manifesto of evil.

On 15 March 2023 the Supreme Court handed down a judgement in the case of The Law Debenture Trust Corporation plc v Ukraine [2023] UKSC 11, directing a trial of the facts.

In 2013, Ukraine issued Eurobonds with a nominal value of US \$3 billion and carrying interest at 5% per annum to Russia, repayable in December 2015; but Ukraine failed to repay the Eurobonds when they matured on 21 December 2015.

The Claimant issued proceedings against Ukraine in the English courts, claiming the sums due to Russia. Ukraine filed a defence that it was entitled to void the Eurobonds because of duress arising from Russia's unlawful and illegitimate threats to Ukraine's territorial integrity and independence.

Ukraine pleaded that Mr Sergei Glazyev, an Advisor to the President of the Russian Federation, on 22 September 2013, threatened that if Ukraine signed the Association Agreement with the European Union, Russia could no longer guarantee Ukraine's status as a State.

If these facts are admitted or proved at trial, then it will be conclusive that Russia threatened Ukraine with the use of armed force as early as September 2013, thereby giving Ukraine just cause



for the use of force against Russia. This establish would that Russia's use of armed force against Ukraine from February 2014 amounted to the supreme international crime of waging aggres-sive war.

The cardboard cut-out Church

As a Christian businessman (quantity surveyor) and pastor for 60 years, I am deeply troubled at the general state of the Church.

We seem to be too silent in graciously exchanging our biblical views against the current trends and legislation being freely imposed on society and family values.

One thing burdening my mind is the domination exercised by church leadership in opposition to the priesthood of all believers.

Recent visits to speak at or just attend churches have confirmed my suspicion that the structure of the Church as a whole is so insecure and fragile as to be built out of cardboard and out of date. Equally with being run by one man or woman, the congregation just sit like cardboard cut-outs waiting to be fed, entertained or bored.

The biblical concept of the equal priesthood of each believer is subjugated by authoritarianism; the concept is that one leader carries the anointing and divine authority. We are in the age of the personality and the theological degrees with no room for the common man or woman.

The apostle Paul is explicit, though, that every believer should know the Lord and know God's Word as fully as the teacher or pastor (1 Corinthians 12, Ephesians 4:12-13). Jesus said HE would build his Church, not men; ownership belongs to God alone.

The ocean is a mysterious and wonderful place, and scientists are regularly discovering new sea creatures, many of which are weird and even bizarre.

This makes it more and more difficult to believe that the amazing variety of sea life was produced by a process of gradual evolution from a common ancestor.

Around 97% of living creatures are invertebrates (animals without an internal skeleton or backbone). Many of them have an exoskeleton — hard parts on the outside of their bodies.

No hard evidence for evolution of fish

Fish, however, are vertebrates (creatures with a backbone), and all living fish can be classified in three groups: cartilaginous fish such as sharks and rays, jawless fish like lampreys and hagfish, and bony fish.

SEA – AND WONDER...

What we observe in sea creatures is what we would expect to find if the Bible account is true

But according to evolution theory, first fishes the evolved from some kind of invertebrate. This would have meant that, somehow, they lost their external skeleton and developed an internal Evolutionists believe one. that some kind of worm-like creature was the ancestor of all the vertebrates, but there is no agreed candidate.

According to Wikipedia, "The evolution of fish began about 530 million years ago during the Cambrian explosion. It was during this time that the early chordates developed the skull and the vertebral column."

there However. is no hard evidence for this, and can't evolutionists even agree on a candidate for the common ancestor of the vertebrates. According to Encyclopedia Britannica online. "The ancestral vertebrate (protovertebrate) has been sought for more than 100 years, and the likelihood of finding it today is not much greater than in the past. It can be assumed that the protovertebrate was small and soft-bodied, two factors that suggest the improbability of finding a fossilised form

in a recognisable condition." Yet numerous soft-bodied creatures, such as jellyfish, have indeed been preserved as fossils!

The origin of fish is obscure

According to the British Geological Survey, "The origin of fish is obscure, but may be found in something like the invertebrate sea squirts or echinoderms" (www.bgs.ac.uk). However, the fossils of a true fish known as 'Metaspriggina' have been found in the same (Cambrian) rocks as fossil sea squirts, supposedly "500 million years old." Incidentally, living sea squirts, like those in the photo, show no evolution from their fossil counterparts. Variety within fish types is often presented as evidence of evolution. Two examples are guppies — popular aquarium fish — and cichlids. Guppies (see photo) come in a vast array of patterns and colours, and more than 1,000 species of cichlid fishes are found all around the world.

But is this really "evolution in action"? The Bible tells us that God created the creatures of the sea "according to their kinds" (Genesis 1:21).

What we observe is what we would expect to find if the Bible account is true. There has been no evolution from one kind to another, just variation, and all the species in each kind can interbreed.
